One-to-One Teaching Policy

The Board of Management recognises that child protection and welfare considerations permeate all aspects of school life and must be reflected in each school policy, school practices and activities. The Board of Management also reaffirms its primary responsibility for the care and welfare of pupils and staff.

Provided it is deemed appropriate for an individual, one-to-one teaching will be offered. Parents or guardians of pupil who are to be involved in one-to-one teaching will be informed and their agreement sought.

Where one-to-one teaching occurs, every effort will be made to ensure that this teaching takes place in an open environment (open door/door with glass pane).

Timetabling for one to one teaching will be drawn up by the Special Educational Needs (SEN) teacher in conjunction with the class teacher. A copy of the timetable will be given to the principal and will be on display in the classroom.

Work being carried out by S.N.A.s will be carried out under the direction of the class teacher and in an open environment.

Substitute teachers are Garda vetted and therefore follow the SEN timetable and continue with one to one teaching as timetabled.
