Out of the Spanish Civil War comes a story of love, hatred, adventure, for the most dramatic situation of today. With the roar and screech of cannon fire exploding on Spanish soil as the background, "Blockade" deals with an espionage ring and enemies who were in love.

Walter Wanger gave the directing job to William Dieterle, director of the best picture in 1937, according to the Motion Picture Academy of Arts and Science, "The Life of Emile Zola." In setting up his lavish sets of strife-torn Spain, Dieterle was careful in not showing favoritism to either side. His air raids, attacks and counter-attacks, description of the suffering and the disrupted life spread throughout the nation carries to the audience the feeling of waste and futility of war.

Torn away from their peaceful life, Norma Basil (Madeleine Carroll) and Marco (Henry Fonda) become enemies for no other reason than the madness of war. Out of this theme, the motion picture awaits word from the box-offices to go ahead with more plays based on the strife of a nation.

Edgar Bergen's home town, Decatur, Mich., will remember him by erecting a statue of Charlie McCarthy, his companion. A committee now is at work preparing to honor their famous citizen.
