**Food Assistance Program (FAP) Employment & Training (E&T)**

FAP recipients face employment barriers that are similar to those of other refugees and immigrants receiving services from ORIA, including limited English proficiency (LEP); lack of education or knowledge and skills in navigating American work culture; gaps in work history due to displacement; practical barriers, such as transportation; and temporary and insecure housing. This employment and training program seeks to provide employment readiness opportunities for State Food Assistance (FAP) recipients, helping eligible individuals prepare for work, as well as obtain and maintain employment. Participation in FAP E&T is voluntary and there is no participation hour requirement.
