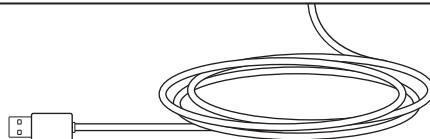
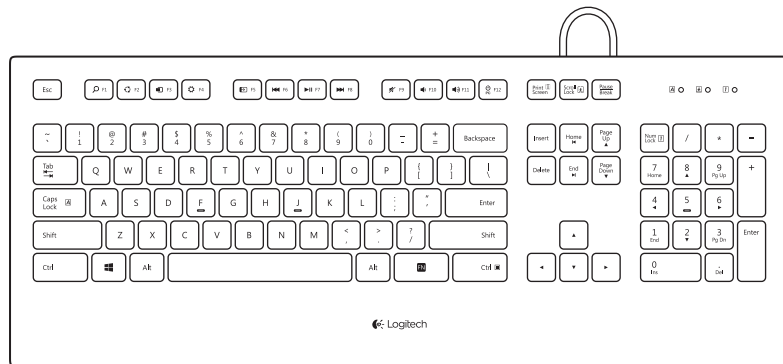

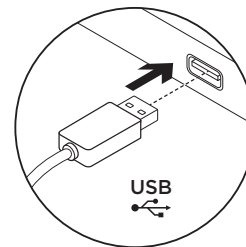

Function keys



To select a function key such as F1, press and hold the blue FN key on the bottom row of the keyboard, and then press the F-key.

To select a feature, just press the F-key. The following features are available:

- F1 = Search 
- F2 = Share 
- F3 = Devices 
- F4 = Settings 
- F5 = Switch applications 
- F6 = Previous Track
- F7 = Play/Pause
- F8 = Next Track
- F9 = Mute
- F10 = Volume down
- F11 = Volume up
- F12 = PC Sleep
