At 6:30 pm Mr. Mayo called the regular meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

D. Public Input on agenda and non-agenda items non-action items

No public comment.

II. Non-Action Items

A. Capital Project Presentation - A. Hotaling *10-2-2019 Minutes*

Assistant Superintendent for Business, Adam Hotaling, presented on the proposed capital project to improve major items at School 18 and School 16, renovate the tech wing room of the high school, install classroom walls at School 14 and addressing unit vents and windows at Carroll Hill. School 18 and School 16 need major renovations which would require "swing space" to temporarily relocate the students and faculty during the renovation. The district proposed using School 12 again for swing space, but in order to do that ALP would need to move out to a new space, hopefully the NEFF Center. The district would like to renovate the Tech Wing at Troy High School during the roof renovation to turn this into a 21st Century Learning Space for technology and manufacturing for our students. However, part of this space is currently occupied by the building and grounds department, which has been proposed to move to the School 14 pool area.

Mr. Hotaling explains that the total estimation for all of this work to take place would cost approximately \$55 million. Funding would come from the local share of our Capital Reserve (approximately \$4 million), State Aid (approximately \$23 million), bond borrowing without tax impact (approximately \$25 million) and Smart Schools funds (approximately \$5 million). This would not affect the tax levy.

The timeline for this could be an October 2nd Board presentation, the Board to vote on the proposition on October 16th, then the 45 day public notice, and finally a Public Vote on December 3rd. If the vote is approved, then the designs would be submitted to SED. Work would begin the summer of 2021 through the summer of 2024.

The Board scheduled a special meeting on October 8th at 6:00pm at School 14 to further discuss this proposal.

B. Financial Reports (July/August 2019) - S. Schweizer

District treasurer, Ms. Schweizer, reported the financials for July and August of 2019. Budget transfers for July 2019 and August 2019 were related to new budget codes being added for coding issues. The claims auditor reviewed \$8.2 in claims in July and August. Revenue was consistent with July 2018 and August 2018. Expenditures decreased simply due to timing of payments. August 31st grants will be submitted at the end of the month. All bank accounts have been reconciled.
