B. Executive Session

At 5:33 pm Mr. Mayo, President, made a motion for Executive Session for discussion of pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Dr. Watson, Mr. Hotaling, Mrs. Miaski and Ms. Ahearn.

C. Public Session

At 6:32 pm Mr. Mayo called the regular meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

D. Public Input on agenda and non-agenda items non-action items

II. Non-Action Items

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A. TMS Principal's Presentation - I. McShane

Mr. McShane starts off by thanking the Board for all the support they have given the building, including the restructuring of their administrative team. Mr. McShane reviews the 2018-19 TMS ELA and Math assessment results. Modest gains were made in both ELA (2%) and Math (3%) this year. ELA showed modest gains over all grade levels: Grade 6 (2%), Grade 7 (2%) and Grade 8 (3%). The Math results also showed gains throughout the grade levels: Grade 6 (2%), Grade 7 (4%) and Grade 8 (2%). Mr. Carmello reminds everyone that although these are modest gains, the state scores in ELA only increased 0.5% and Math increase 2%. Mr. McShane accredits this to the teachers hard work.

Mr. McShane turns the presentation over to Sabina Dinardo, Hope Debevoise, Ashley Kenyon and Anna Schwartz to speak about the culture of literacy at the middle school. Literacy skills are the basis of everything; reading, writing, critical thinking and problem solving. All content area teachers will be using the same writing targets to increase literacy. Data feedback strategies will continue to be used to monitor the progress. Dr. Ken Newman, Assistant Principal, explains in more depth about the usages of data feedback strategies by monitoring the data. The data can help us to catch students before they fall to make sure they do not fail. They have implemented early warning systems for attendance, discipline, academics. The middle school is very excited to support our students to be very successful.

Mrs. Harvin thanks the middle school for all of their hard work.

B. Financial Reports (June) - S. Schweizer

Ms. Schweizer reports on the June 2019 financial report. The transfers in June were mostly related to end of year expenditures and cleanup for the audit. Revenues increased due to state aid and miscellaneous payments from the city. Expenditures increased related to the interfund transfers that were approved from the capital fund for the roof project. Final expenditure reports have been submitted for all grants and we should receive final payments within the next few weeks. All bank accounts have been reconciled.
