# **Tri-State Market continues to evolve after 30 years**

LAWRENCEBURG, Ind. — This year's fourth Tri-State Antique Market, held August 1,

sported a couple of special events, destined to help turn southeast Indiana into what show promoter Aaron Metzger believes will be the antiquing epicenter of the Hoosier state.

With thirty-plus years behind it, the Tri-State is already Indiana's largest antiques and vintage market. This round there was added fanfare with the debut of the nearby Vevay Antique and Collectible Flea Extravaganza the day before and Worthpoint's guest appearance for two days of workshops.

# Boris Karloff still scares us with his monsters

William Henry Pratt was world famous, but few people know him by that name. He was better known by his stage name — Boris Karloff. Karloff (1887-1969) was an English actor who Karloff established horfame starring as Fran- lywood genre in such kenstein's monster in films as Bride of Franthe classic 1931 horror kenstein (1935), Son of film Frankenstein.

take the starring role as the monster in Frankenstein, which, at the time, was a new direction for Karloff. But the film was a huge success, and Karloff became an overnight horror icon. For most of his acting career, gained international ror as a legitimate Hol-Frankenstein (1939), Director James Whale The Mummy (1932), and


convinced Karloff to The Ghoul (1933).

Karloff acted in 80 movies before being cast as Frankenstein's monster, and he almost was never cast for his most famous roll since Bella Lugosi, famed Dracula star, was originally cast to play the monster. Although Karloff had little to say as the monster, he found the roll physically demanding since the costume was heavy and bulky and required him to wear four-inch-tall platform

boots to elevate his height with each boot weighing 11 pounds, making walking difficult.

The best-known image of Frankenstein's monster, in popular culture, derives from Boris Karloff's portrayal of the monster in the 1931 movie Frankenstein, in which he wore makeup



vendors, it was a modest start; but the show is predicted to blossom, and the plan is to continue holding the Vevay show the Saturday before each Tri-State.

Then, there was the buzz tied to Worthpoint's visit. On Saturday, staff from Worthpoint held a three-hour eBay training at the Lawrenceburg Double-Tree hotel. On Sunday, they conducted a treasure hunt, during which participants were taught how to spot treasures at the show, buy right, and ascertain resale value.

Accompaniments like the above attest to how shows like the Tri-State are evolving to better appeal to modern audiences. The idea is to provide a "complete experience" with not only shopping, but food, activities, and sometimes even entertainment. For instance, in addition to enjoying the numerous food vendors, Tri-State goers can now sample wines and take home a bottle from

Wines. Even with the additions, the show ran slightly smaller this time, with about 180 vendors and around 3,000 shoppers in attendance. The ebb didn't appear to faze an upbeat Metzger, who, reflecting on 2020's challenges, gladly

challenges, gladly exclaimed, "We're really happy getting back to normal!"

The market certainly attracted its share of both seasoned vendors and enthusiastic firsttime sellers. One of the regulars, Jack Sparks from Louisville, Ky., has been selling at Tri-State almost since its inception. Tenure has its benefits; he was in a prime covered spot, the first vendor on the main concourse inside the gate. Out front, priced at \$375. he showcased a 15-inch museum-quality figure of a Native American planting corn. In its enclosure was a red ribbon labeled "First prize, Inter-Tribal Indian Ceremony, Gallup, New Mexico, 1970".

Adjacent to Sparks was By Design from Seymour, Ind. Promi-



Across  $_{\mathrm{the}}$ fairgrounds, another long-timer, Patrick Mayer from nearby Aurora, Ind., had parked an eye-catching motorized rickshaw. The running-condition vehicle was manufactured in the 1930s by the Mainland Carriage Company in what was then Taiwan. It was eventually brought to the U.S. and purchased by the Shriners on the southside of Chicago. Mayer eventually acquired it from an estate. Not surprisingly, it spurred a lot of discussions, even with an \$8,000 price tag.

Although a newbie vendor, George from Lebanon, Ohio, had a professionally staged booth. Centerpoint in his space, priced at \$175, was a 1950s red Formica table with leaf and four chairs that attracted plenty of attention. Atop the table were several period-correct rotary phones priced at \$35 each.

On whole, furniture was a little sparse. This was consistent with many large shows after COVID lockdowns. It seems dealers are still a bit reluctant to tote out large pieces, unsure if shoppers are ready to buy bigger items. As expected, most of the dealers with furniture paid extra to be under roof in the pavilions. One of them, Carl Lingen of Lingen's Antiquities in Cincinnati, brought a dozen nice pieces of traditional antique furniture. Among them was an oak secretary priced nicely at \$675 and a Gerstner 10-drawer dental box for





\$295.

The smaller items that made up the bulk of available merchandise ranged from the typical glassware to more unusual items like surgical tools. In a booth stocked with transportation pieces, amidst the license plates steering wheels, was a Honda motorcycle gas tank for \$35 and a Kawasaki police motorcycle cowl priced at \$225.

Mid-century lovers had plenty to consider, including a jet-age twoshelf rolling hospital cart that will likely be repurposed as a bar cart. It was in very good condition but priced assertively at \$175. On the other hand, a futurist-looking Fairfax Industries (Canada) vacuum, in working condition, was only \$35. Shoppers with tastes more 1960s than 50s had an iconic ceramic matador and bull figure set priced at \$65. And, for the most serious Age of Aquarius buyer, there was a 1967/68 Vietnam War tour jacket, restored to original condition for \$650.

An overflowing wallet was also not necessary to shop the market. Plenty of merchandise was available for \$10 and under. One toy dealer offered a Hot Wheels Rod Runner speed control and a Hot Wheels speedometer for \$5 each. Another seller had a box of Big Little Books at \$2 each, filled with popular Disney and TV show titles like Donald Duck and Lassie. Tri-State Antique shows run each first Sunday from May through October, rain or shine.



Mention Bakelite and colorful, vintage Bakelite jewelry comes to mind. Yet from the early 1900s, this synthetic, phenol-formaldehyde resin, an alternative to brittle, flammable celluloid, has played countless other roles as well.

In fact, some consider this versatile material to be one of the most important inventions of the 20th century.

Initially, due to its exceptional durability and resistance to heat, electricity, and chemical change, Bakelite was used in the emerging automotive, electrical, and electronic industries. During World War I, radio phones, and airplane propellors also featured Bakelite components. In the 1920s, the corporation cast a limited number of solid, transparent Bakelite resin blocks, known as "cast amber," as pieces of jewelry, cigarette holders, and pipe stems.

Interest in molded plastics was rising. So, the Bakelite Company began pressing resin, strengthened with dense cloth, paper, sawdust, or carbon black fillers, in molds. This resulted in inexpensive, smooth pieces that retained their shape, resisted scratches, and could be buffed to brightness. Besides, it was extremely durable.

ored material, an alternate to wood and metal, was dubbed "The Material of a Thousand Uses." Bakelite was molded into household items such as napkin rings, tongs, butter knives, cake slicers, cookware, clocks, and cabinet knobs and handles. Furthermore, companies, like Ericsson and Western Electric, produced dark, durable, molded Bakelite telephones.

After the Bakelite resin patent expired in 1927, a competing company, American Catalin Corporation. introduced an innovative, purified alternative, produced without need for strengthening, darkening fillers. Its extensive range of translucent, opaque, and marbled shades proved

beautify various household objects, like lamps, desk sets, trinket boxes, and cutlery handles.

In response, the Bakelite Corporation, experimenting with colorants and dye saturations, created hundreds of colorful, swirled, and mottled resins. Other companies, like Marblette and Opalon, soon followed suit. creating alabaster, onyx, mottled walnut, and lapis lazuli-hued resins.

During the 1930s, many companies, including RCA, FADA Emerson, and Motorola produced thousands of shiny, modern, inexpensive blue, yellow, green, and cherry-red Catalin table radios. In tune with the times, many also featured sleek, curvy shapes enhanced with Art Deco geometric adornments. Because these have sometimes been stored under extreme conditions in attics or basements, however, many have oxidized to deeper shades or become brittle. So those in prime condition, in full working order, and featuring original on/off and tuning knobs, may command well over \$1,000.

Though these highly collectible radios are traditionally called Catalin, some, though chemically similar, may have been made by Bakelite or Marblette. To add to the confusion, other products are sometimes described as Bakelite/Catalin. These days, however, Bakelite is the most popular term for all phenol formaldehyde resin products produced through the 1920s and 1930s.

The Art Deco era marked the heyday of Bakelite jewelry. Producing each piece was a lengthy, multi-step procedure. After huge factories created raw resin through

a complex chemical process, batches were delivered to design-driven companies where jewelry items were made. Then each pendant, bracelet, and bead was hand-shaped, carved, scalloped, faceted, waffled, painted, ridged, rippled, or inlaid. Finally, each piece was shone to a sheen.

Before World War II. durable Bakelite poker chips, cue sticks, gaming dice, mahjong tiles, chessmen, and domino sets were popular as well. Yet the advent of more advanced plastic technologies eventually rendered Bakelite See Bakelite page 26







# **1894 San Francisco Mint** dime sells for \$1.8 million

Who says 10 cents won't buy a cup of coffee anymore? A small silver dime made in 1894 at the San Francisco Mint has been sold for \$1.8 million.

"Mint records indicate only 24 dimes were struck at the San Francisco Mint in 1894. Today only nine of them with that date on the front and the letter S mintmark on the back are known to still exist. This was a record price for this particular example," said Laura Sperber president of Legend Numismatics of Lincroft, New Jersey. She acquired the coin for \$1.8 million on behalf of collector Bruce Morelan of Las Vegas.

"Bruce now owns the trifecta of multi-mil-

lion-dollar United States numismatics: one of the eight known original 1804 U.S. silver dollars, one of the five known 1913 Liberty Head nickels and now one of the nine known 1894 San Francisco dimes. We are looking at the possibilities of publicly exhibiting

all three together at a major rare coin show," said Sperber.

"This was the third 1894-S dime acquired for collectors by Legend since our company's founding in 1987," said Sperber.

Karloff and Lugosi, rivals for roles such as Frankenstein's monster, teamed up to star in several horror films, including The Black Cat (1934) and The Raven (1935). Lugosi starred as Ygor, along with Karloff as the monster, in the 1939

film Son of Franken-For stein.

Karloff, as the monster, appeared at a celebrity baseball game in 1940, hitting a fake home run and scaring catcher Buster Keaton so badly that Keaton fainted dead away behind home plate as the monster stomped across the plate.

By 1944 directors thought Karloff was too old to play the monster in movies, so in House of Frankenstein (1944) actor Glenn Strange played the monster while Karloff played second banana as the villainous Dr. Niemann.

Today, collectors search diligently for Boris Karloff movie posters, especially posters of his horror movies such as Frankenstein. Be aware that original, 1931 movie posters of Frankenstein are expensive. In 2015 one sold at auction for over \$385,000. Die-hard collectors also search for photographs of Karloff in makeup since it is Karloff's image on a movie poster that symbolizes the terror of Frankenstein.


Mary Shelley wrote the novel Frankenstein in 1818 when she was just 18 years old. It is the story of a young doctor, Victor Frankenstein, who reanimates a dead man, affectionately called Frankenstein's Monster. Shelley's story has become the most retold story in the horror genre, and Frankenstein's monster is the poster boy for

fear and loathing in horror. Surprisingly, many critics argue that Frankenstein is not a horror story. They argue the novel and subsequent retellings should be considered the first science fiction story ever told. It has been argued Dr. Frankenstein "makes a deliberate decision" and "turns to modern experiments in the laboratory" to achieve fantastic results. Still, when movie fans want to feel a chill of fear on a dark autumn night, they put a CD of Frankenstein, starring Boris Karloff, on their TV and turn on a light to keep dark shadows off the living room walls.

One interesting aspect to Frankenstein's monster is that the monster is often simply referred to as "Frankenstein;" however, Victor Frankenstein refers to his creation as "creature," "fiend," "the dæmon," "wretch," "devil," "thing," "being," and "ogre." Is it any




Above: Theatrical movie release poster for The Bride of Frankenstein, 1935, starring Boris Karloff.

wonder Frankenstein's monster has low self esteem? Ironically, it is Frankenstein's deadly creation that refers to himself as a "monster," thus giving himself his most famous name-Frankenstein's Monster.

For 90 years, Boris Karloff has portrayed often the monster both in film and in the minds of all horror fans. For many, Karloff's film image of the monster is truly what Frankenstein



looks like. And, today, both the monster and Karloff live on in movie poster collections all over the world.





products behind the times.

In recent years, however, fashionistas and enthusiasts find their bold, whimsical designs and retro hues fascinating.

Smooth, opaque, solid-shade Bakelite bracelets, worn singly or stacked, are perennial favorites. So are those featuring extensive carving or refined decorative touches like chrome accents, hand-painted polka dots, or gumdrop-shaped motifs. Resin-washed bracelets, featuring carvings highlighted with contrasting glazes, and transparent, lightly tinged Apple Juice, Root Beer, and Cherry Juice ones, are also appealing. Many seek bracelets featuring green-yellow, butterscotch-brown, or "Mississippi Mud" marbling. Others find "end of the day" marbled bracelets featuring odd hues apparently cobbled from random batches of leftover resin attractive.

However, some of the most collectible Bakelite bracelets, boast bright, chunky, handmade beads spaced along elastic strips or tiny, charm-like Bakelite/celluloid fruits and vegetables. But to many, items featuring multicolor, laminated, horizontal or zig-zag wedges are most alluring of all. Prices vary widely. A glowing Apple Juice belt buckle, featuring gorgeous green, orange,

butterscotch, and root beer laminated striping, for instance, may command several hundred dollars. Yet a multicolored, laminated Bakelite Philadelphia hinged bracelet, "the most desirable machineage piece of jewelry of all -- in any mode, medium or material" commands thousands more," explains Matt Burkholz, Bakelite connoisseur and owner of Route 66 West at rubylane.

Bakelite clip earrings are far more affordable. Single-shade hoops, circles, triangles, and dangles easily coordinate with bracelets of similar shades, while those resembling fruit baskets, birds, or blossoms, for instance, are more colorful. Yet elegant Bakelite teardrop clips, dazzling with diamond, rhinestone, turquoise, or metallic touches, are the epitome of Art Deco chic.

Scores of Bakelite figural pins are molded like tempting bananas, strawberries, and clusters of cherries. Others depict trendy, silver Egyptian motifs or replicate precious jade, jet, cinnabar, or ivory. Resin-washed figural pins, depicting everyday items like boats, blossoms, widebrimmed hats, or horses, however, may reflect personal pastimes or passions.

Through the 1950s, small, affordable Bakelite dress clips, ornamental pins decorating handbags, furs, and dress straps or necklines, were the fashion accessory. Many featured dramatic, deep carvings or eye-catching, articulated movements. Swanky, lightweight Bakelite square, oval, and rounded cufflinks, available in an array of colors, were also stylish. Though small, they packed a punch.


Abundantly available Bakelite buttons, likely snipped from dresses before relegating them to rag piles, also evoke yesteryear.

Other fans assemble specialized button collections. Some seek only stars, squares, triangles, ovals, or circles. Some seek carved, rippled, or ridged ones in particular shades or sizes. models. Yet figural buttons, molded into anything from giraffes, pelicans, and Scottie dogs to Tom, Tom, the Piper Son or sets of Snow White Seven Dwarves, are most charming of all. Once upon a time, however, they must have been the dickens to button up.

Gangly-jointed Bakelite toy figurines, rotund dollies, and fetching rattles were popular through the 1940s. So were toddler spoons, rabbit-shaped napkin rings, Happy Birthday candle holders, and pencil sharpeners depicting favorite Disney characters. After Tykie Toy Tales, a promotional book for the Tykie Toy Company, was issued in 1946, a series of



very collectible Bakelite crib toys illustrating its characters were introduced. These include Bobby Bear, Baby Bunnie, Eddie Egg, and Katie Kitten.

Due to its popularity, Bakelite pieces are often replicated with modern synthetics. To differentiate real from reproduction. experts recommend using all five senses Authentic Bakelite is typically heavy, lustrous, and may exhibit microscopic chips or scratches, along with wellworn patinas. Pieces also emit characteristic "clunks" when tapped together.

"If you haven't handled enough Bakelite to know it when you see it," said Madeline Colletti, at Bohemian Boutique in Georgetown, Mass, "it's best to buy from a reputable source. There are also various 'tricks' for testing Bakelite on the spot. The one I like best is to rub it vigorously on a piece of cloth and then sniff it. If it's genuine Bakelite, you should be able to detect a chemical formaldehyde or petroleum-like odor."

In addition to the authoritative, full-color volume The Bakelite Collection by Matt Burkholz, Bakelite Jewelry: Good, Better, Best by Donna Wasserstrom, and Bakelite Pins by Karima Parry, may also prove interesting.




