Cars that were painted at Zetland were distinguished by their process. Enfield cars were simply 'slipper dipped' whereas Zetland cars went through a 'rotodip' process (see 'Rotodip process'). This superior process meant that the cars were better protected against rust. If you could detect prime coat, you would notice that 'Enfield' cars were pink, whereas the 'Zetland' cars were chocolate brown.

During the initial set-up for the Mk II, there was a significant issue with painting. Areas of lead-loading blew out with the extreme heat in the paint ovens. It took weeks to redevelop the lead-loading technique to eliminate most of the beeswax from the paddling operation, use of extra heat to allow minor air bubbles to explode and finish

'63 – '69:

In the last box of the ID plate, situated under the bonnet near the radiator diaphragm: off with an epoxy filler. Original colours of vehicles were to be found in two places:



'69 – '72:

On an adhesive sticker, situated near the oil cooler:



With the early type ID plates, the colours were often shown with numerals in front of and after the colour. An explanation of these follows...

PAINT RECTIFICATION

This Bulletin supersedes Gen. 36 dated 6. 10. 61 and contains the current procedure for paint rectification on all BMC vehicles.

Acrylic lacquer is the only material that should be used for rectification of baked enamel finish as used by BMC.

Since the recommendation in late 1961, to use acrylics for this purpose, we have enjoyed freedom from complaints of loss of gloss on areas rectified by this method. Recently however, we have received complaints of a number of cases of poor adhesion with evidence of peeling indicating that the correct procedure had not been carried out.

It is emphasised that full panel respray is required for all acrylic rectification and "spotted" areas lead to further complaints of peeling and visible patches.

Acrylic lacquer must not be applied over nitro-cellulose lacquer, which, may be found if the vehicle has been previously rectified by non-approved methods. If doubt exists on the previous finish in this respect, it should be stripped completely and the panel repainted according to the recommended procedure.

NOTE: As we are using both Balm and Berger enamels in the plant, it is suggested that supplies of material for acrylic rectification be obtained from either of these companies depending upon the material used for the original finish.

PROCEDURE FOR RECTIFICATION

- 1) Panel beat damaged area if necessary; thoroughly wipe the repaired area with solvent and dry off.
- 2) Sand any rough areas to a feathered edge.
- 3) Spray a full wet coat of acrylic primer surfacer reduced according to the

manufacturers instructions and either air dry one hour or force dry for 8-10 minutes with infra-red lamps.

- 4) Apply putty or glazing compound (recommended type for acrylic repairs) to any rough areas. Allow to dry for 30 minutes then wet rub the putty and primer with 320 grit paper using water or mineral turps as lubricant.
- 5) Thoroughly sand the whole of the panel to be rectified with 400 paper using water or mineral turps. Clean down and wipe with a clean cloth and mineral spirits.
- 6) Spray two thin coats of acrylic sealer and allow to dry for 30 minutes or for 5-10 minutes with infra-red lamps. Lightly scuff with 400 paper if necessary.
- 7) Spray two double coats of acrylic lacquer reduced according to the manufacturers instructions allowing five minutes between double coats.
- 8) Allow to air flash five minutes then bake 10-15 minutes with infra-red lamps or air dry overnight.
- 9) Compound and polish.

INTERIOR REPAIRS

These may be carried out using conventional nitro-cellulose high gloss lacquer provided the gloss of the enamel is removed with 360 grit paper prior to application of the lacquer. Where shape makes sanding difficult, a prior coat of lacquer primer surfacer is necessary.

It is the responsibility of all Dealers, particularly those using sub contractors for paint repair, to ensure that the correct method of rectification be used.



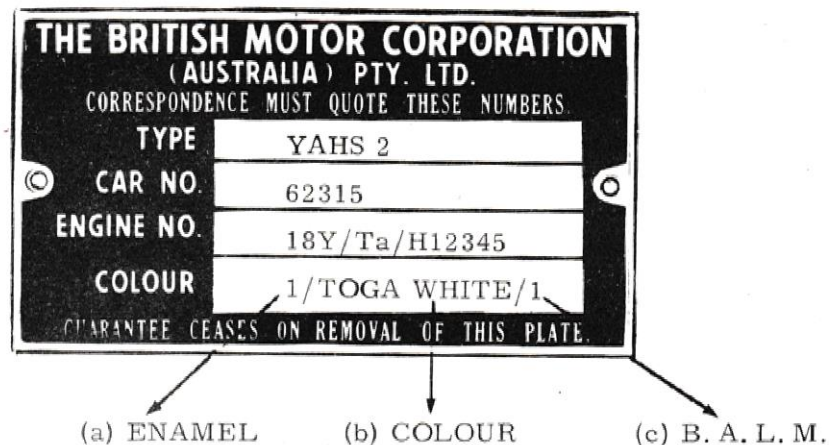

To assist in recognition of the manufacturer and type of paint used for a particular vehicle, the following code is signified on the identification plate.

- a) Paint type - prefix 1 to indicate Enamel
prefix 3 to indicate Lacquer
prefix 4 to indicate Acrylic Enamel
- b) Colour Name e. g. Toga White
- c) Paint Manufacturer - suffix 1 to indicate B. A. L. M.
suffix 2 to indicate Lusteroid
suffix 3 to indicate Bergers
suffix 4 to indicate Brolite
suffix 5 to indicate Taubman
suffix 6 to indicate Spartan

Note: Plates on Duotone cars will be stamped with both colours one above the other. The top colour on the plate will indicate the upper colour of the vehicle irrespective of the colour styling used.

John would not claim it to be 100% complete, as there were instances where a colour would be used as a test. Only a handful of these existed as they were not deemed to be popular enough.

Explanation for column headed 'FORMULA & PRICE A X E

Formula & Price relates to the type of paint, each having a different price code. These are normal DULUX codes and DULUX trade names – other brands may be different, but the type of paint remains the same.

- a. A = DULON Acrylic Lacquer
- b. X = ACNAN Acrylic Enamel
- c. E = DULUX Spraying Enamel
