Just a few bits about Dad. He purchased his first Harley in 1943, it was a 1923 model, and so started quite a collection of bikes and cars over the next 67 years.

A total of 49 cars, 15 Harley's, 25 Caravans, 10 Trailers and a couple of boats. Yes he left a detailed list in order of purchase, cost price and sold price. (Dad should have been an Accountant)

Listed below are some of the classic's he has had in his stable at some time. (Not in purchase order)

'26 Packard Sedan, '27 Morris Cowley Roadster 13.9, '27 Cowley Tourer 11.9, '28 Chev Tourer, '28 Fiat Sedan, '28 Essex Super 6 Buckboard, '29 Reo Sedan, '34 Fiat Coupe '34 Chev Roadster, '35 Chev Master Tourer, '35 Oldsmobile Sedan, '37 Morris 8/40 Sedan, '37 Chev Sedan, '37 Austin 7 Coupe, '39 Dodge TC Ute, '40 Ford 10-10 P/Van, '40 Morris 8/40 Roadster, '47 Vauxhall Sedan, '50 Anglia Sedan, '51 Anglia Tourer, '52 Austin A40 Devon Sedan, '52 Prefect Sedan, '52-53 Hudson Sedan, '56 Dodge Sedan.

There were also many Holden's, Commodore's, a Valiant or two and a couple of Toyota's.

At the end Dad still had his original 1955 FJ, which he purchased brand new, His '27 Essex Tourer, handed down by the original owner in 1963 and used in original trim in the first Bay to Birdwood and his '42 WLC Harley outfit purchased in 2001. Dad used them all on a regular weekly outing subject to the weather.

Dad's life revolved around his family and his uncanny ability to see a dollar and a lot of fun collecting these cars over the years doing them up and then turning them into a profit to help support his family along the way. As a family we had many an enjoyable moment and memorable trips in some of these vehicles over the years.

Dad's health started to decline in 1995 and I honestly believe that if it were not for his love, interest and involvement in his cars, bikes and the AAA Club he would not have lasted as long as he did.

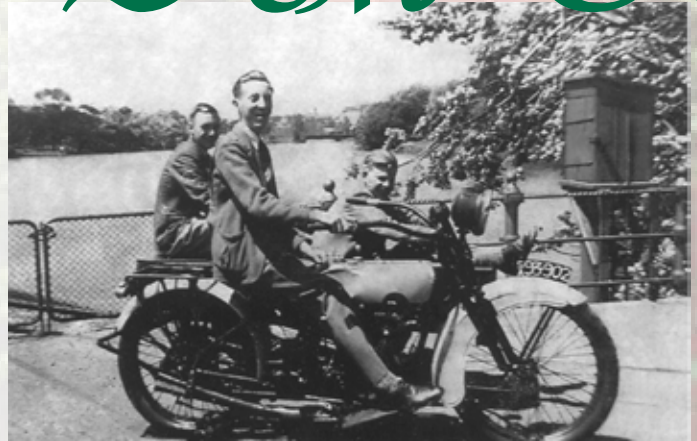

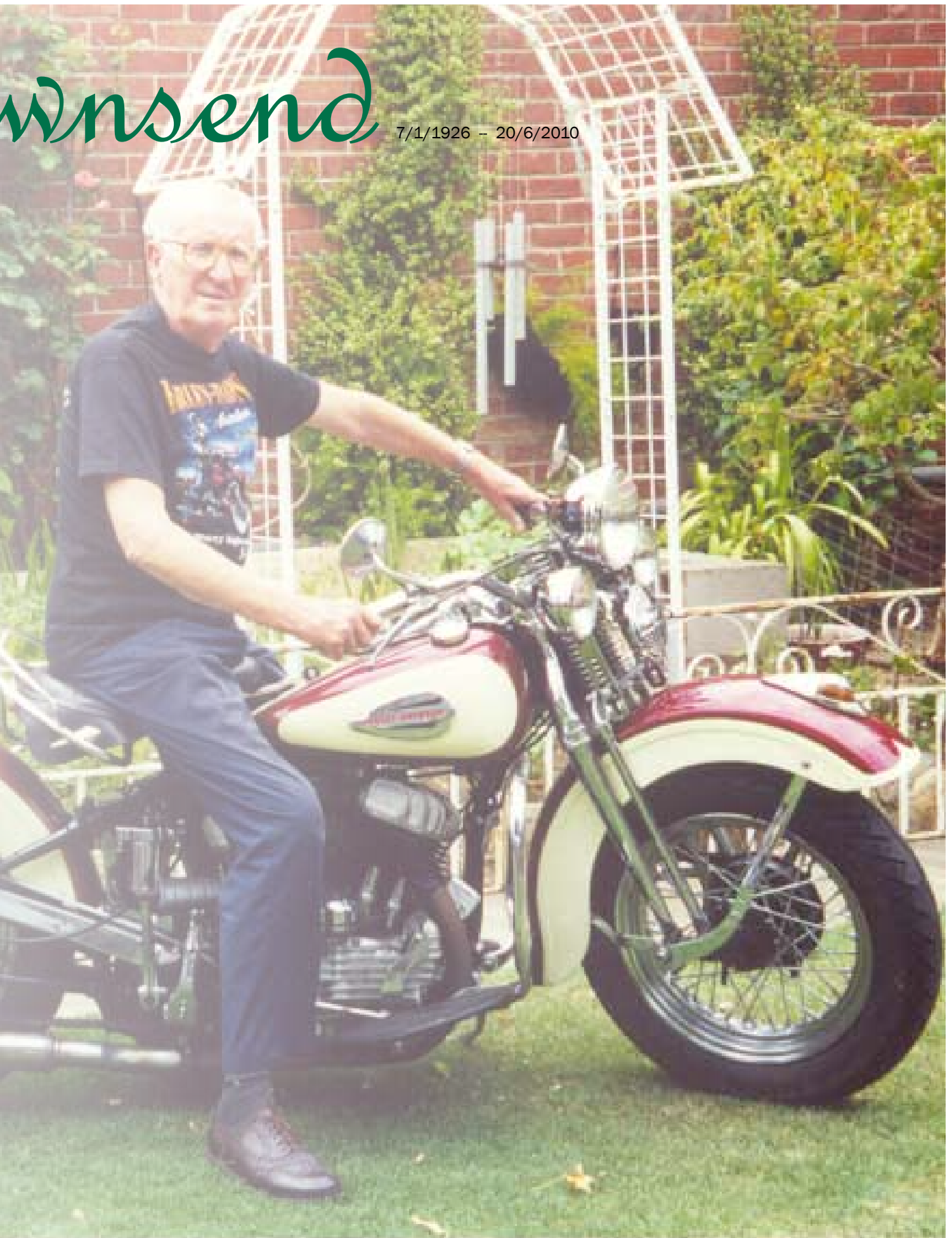

Child Restraint Laws

The new laws will require children to be appropriately restrained in a motor vehicle in a suitable approved child restraint from birth up to the age of seven.

Specifically, the new laws will require children:

- up to the age of six months to be restrained in a rearward facing child restraint (e.g. infant capsule)
- from six months until the age of four to be restrained in either a rearward or forward facing child restraint (e.g. child safety seat)
- from four years until the age of seven to be restrained in either a forward facing child restraint or booster seat restrained by a correctly adjusted and fastened seatbelt or child safety harness.

The new laws also deal with the issue of children sitting in the front seat of a vehicle.

- Children up to four years of age must be restrained in the rear of the vehicle (where the vehicle has two or more rows of seats)
- Children aged between four and seven years will not be permitted to sit in the front seat unless all other seating positions are already occupied by children under seven.

Bus drivers

Exemptions

Bus drivers will continue to be exempt from ensuring passengers under 16 years of age are restrained.

Under the Australian Road Rules, a “bus” is defined as a motor vehicle designed to carry over 12 adults (including the driver). If the vehicle involved is designed to carry 12 adults or less (including the driver) it is not a bus and the driver is not exempt from ensuring all passengers are appropriately restrained.

Taxi drivers

Taxi drivers are not required to provide child restraints or booster seats. Taxi drivers are exempt from responsibility for passengers under 1 year old but must ensure children over 1 year old are seated in the back seat with a properly fastened seatbelt if no child restraint is available.

Taxi drivers will continue to be responsible for ensuring passengers between the ages of 7 and 16 are appropriately restrained.

Other exemptions include:

- Motorcycles.
- A person who can present on request a certificate signed by a medical practitioner.
- A person who can present on request an exemption issued by the Minister for Transport.
- **A person travelling in a historic vehicle that is registered and driven in accordance with the conditions of registration.**

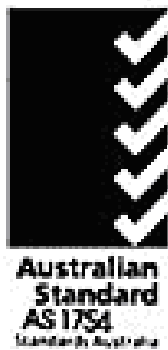

New child restraint laws in South Australia effective 1 July 2010

The Australian Road Rules currently require that children less than 12 months of age must be restrained in a suitable approved child restraint. However, children between 12 months and 16 years of age must be restrained in an approved child restraint or a properly fastened seatbelt, where one is available.
