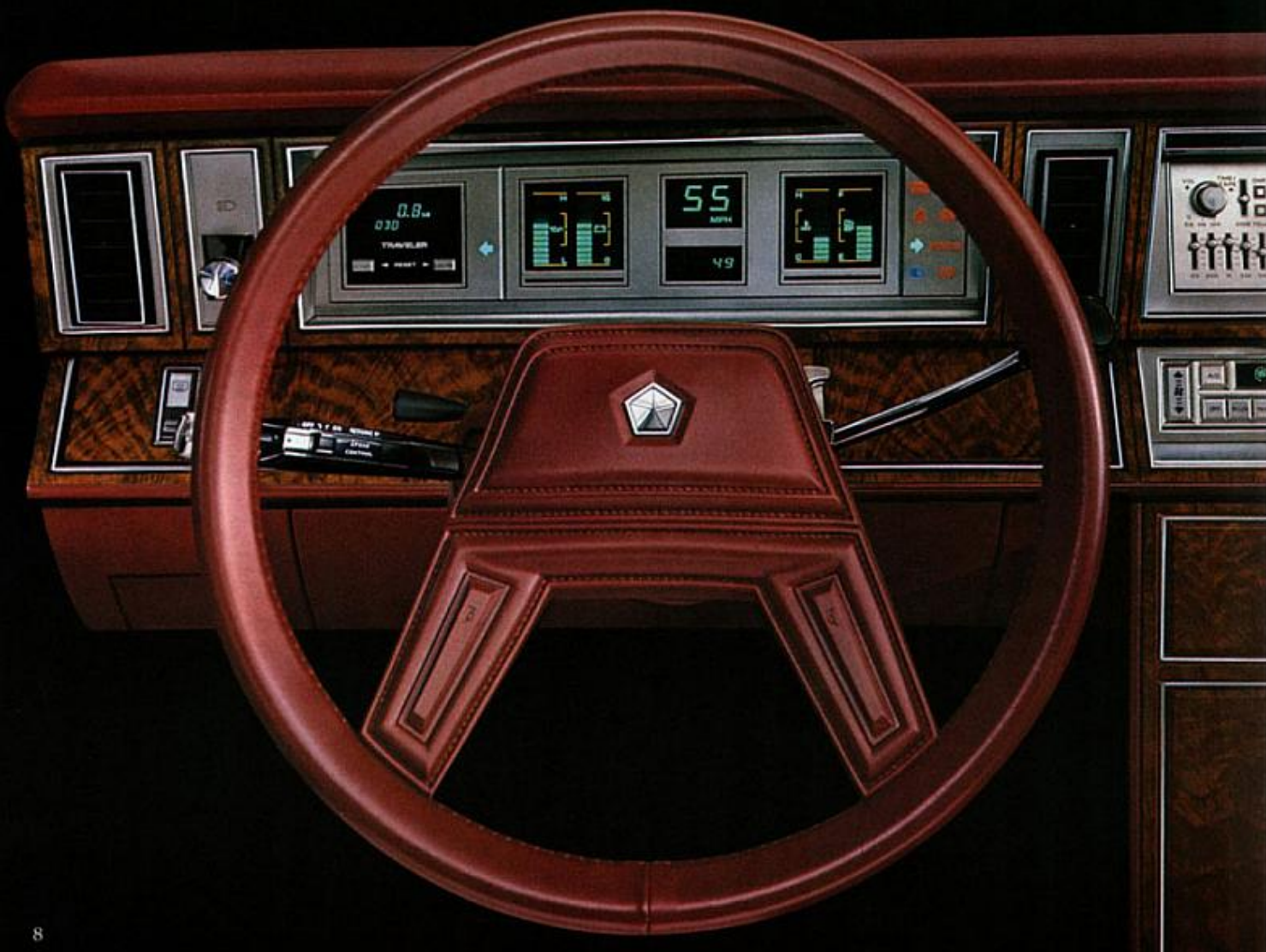
Appointments well taken.

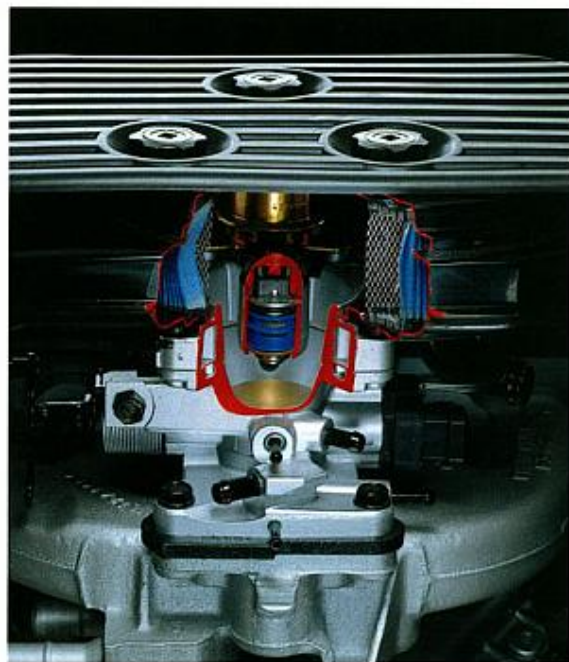
Technology. Take it to the limits.

THE CHALLENGE: Design a new engine that approaches the limits of the technologically possible. A high-torque engine that can power Chrysler's larger cars... with the smoothness usually found only in a larger engine.

THE RESPONSE:

Chrysler Corporation's new standard 2.5-liter engine with electronic fuel injection (EFI) that not only meets the criteria for power and smooth performance—but also improves New Yorker's fuel economy.*

The new efficiency is the result of two design features: a new Chrysler/Bosch single-point electronic fuel injection system that operates at low system fuel pressures, and a "fast-burn" cylinder head design that effects more rapid and more complete fuel combustion. Vibration has been virtually eliminated by the use of two counter-rotating balance shafts that offset the reciprocating forces within the engine. Chrysler's 2.2-liter EFI turbo engine, available as a New Yorker option, improves performance and boosts acceleration and passing power.

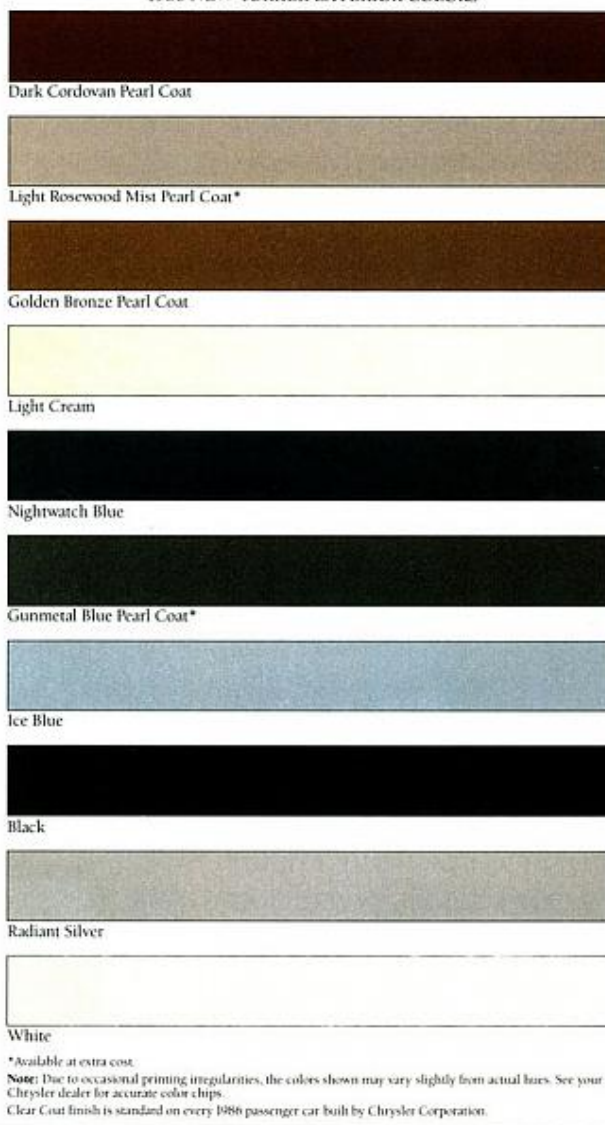
