



Volkswagen engineers are always striving to make a good thing even better. So like its predecessors, the 1981 Rabbit brings with it a number of refinements and improvements that help make it even more engaging to own.

For openers, Rabbit's front and rear bumpers are now made of aluminum instead of steel, to make them even more efficient. And inside you'll find a redesigned interior and a whole new instrument panel with newly designed speedometer, fuel gauge, and seven-digit odometer. A quartz crystal chronometer is included with our L and LS models.

You'll find Rabbit's full-size spare stowed out of the way in its own special compartment beneath the floor of the spacious cargo area. You can substantially increase the cargo space by folding down the rear seatback.

For added safety, both our four-door Rabbit L and LS are equipped with special rear door locks. When you're traveling with children, simply flip a lever concealed in the door frame, and the rear doors can only be opened from the outside. To reduce weight and increase Rabbit's fuel efficiency, VW engineers designed a cross-flow aluminum radiator. And to save power, the electric fan is thermostatically-controlled. That means it runs only

when needed, permitting faster warm-ups in winter.

Every detail in Rabbit's design represents a thoroughly researched development. The best way to appreciate Rabbit's engineering is to drive Rabbit yourself. Then you'll understand why The Original is better than ever. Inside and out!



Consider VW's innovative passive restraint system — one of many original features found on Rabbit "LS" models. It's quick and easy to use. Comfortable as you drive. And most important, it's effective.

An original feature found on all Rabbit models is our huge glass area for clear visibility in all directions. Rabbit has more glass area than many larger cars. So there's less engine compartment and more passenger compartment. For responsiveness and quick handling, Rabbit has rack and pinion steering. And to soak up road irregularities, there's four-wheel independent coil spring suspension.

These original features and many more can best be appreciated by driving Rabbit yourself. In fact, we suggest you drive both the Diesel and the gasoline-powered Rabbits to help you choose the one that's best

for you. And while you're checking out our Rabbits, notice the standard operating vent windows on Rabbit "LS". The electric rear-window defroster standard on all Rabbit models. And discuss the benefits of "negative steering roll radius" with one of your dealership's knowledgeable salespersons.



In fact, our Rabbit Convertible is quite unlike anything else you can own.

The top is three layers thick and made virtually by hand. And insulated to help keep out heat, cold, noise, and water. And in back, the rear window is made of glass and electrically heated to keep off ice and snow. The coachwork, by the way, is painstakingly crafted by the famous old-world firm, Karmann. So the fit and finish is nothing short of superb.

For power, our convertible is equipped with a 1.7L fuel-injected overhead cam engine, matched to a

5-speed gearbox with economical overdrive ratios. And inside the car, the appointments are luxurious. From the sumptuous upholstery to the cut pile carpeting. For your listening pleasure, Rabbit Convertible comes with an AM/FM stereo cassette sound system as standard equipment—complete with right and left in-door speakers. And there are front vent windows and remote-control outside mirrors on both sides.






