


Chevrolet Dealership Timeline

- May 1931 Roger Boyd opens the Chelmsford Centre Chevrolet Co in the ground floor of Central House with former stables in the rear serving as a garage
- May 1941 Tenth anniversary of Chelmsford Centre Chevrolet Co.
- Feb 1942 Roger Boyd rents 20 Chelmsford Street from Octavia Sweetser and moves operations there
- Sep 1946 Roger Boyd, Inc. is operating the Chevrolet dealership and a Sunoco service station at 40 Chelmsford Street
- Jul 1952 The Town of Chelmsford proposes then rejects 40 Chelmsford Street as a new school building site
- Aug 1952 Roger Boyd purchases 40 Chelmsford Street from Ralph and Mabel Emerson
- Feb 1954 The Boyd Building opens at 36 Chelmsford Street, with the Newsweekly as a tenant in May
- Oct 1961 Roger Boyd, Inc. celebrates its 30th Anniversary
- Dec 1964 Roger Boyd transfers the property title to Roger Boyd, Inc.
- Jun 1968 Howard Brown starts doing business as Howard Brown Chevrolet
- Feb 1969 Gabby Monroe starts doing business as Monroe Chevrolet, Inc.
- Oct 1969 Gabby Monroe advertises as Monroe Chevy Town
- Dec 1970 Peter Hallissy is doing business as Hallissy Chevrolet Co.
- May 1975 Hallissy Chevrolet becomes Colonial Chevrolet
- Nov 1976 Roger Boyd dies on Nev 21
- Jan 1977 Peter Hallissy was granted a variance for an auto salesroom on the other side of Chelmsford Street
- Dec 1978 Roger Boyd Inc. transfers the property title to Roger's brother Ronald Boyd of Greenwich, CT
- Jun 1979 Larry Cunningham is doing business as Colonial Chevrolet
- Mar 1980 Peter Hallissy is doing business as Hallissy Subaru at 620 Middlesex Street in Lowell
- Jul 1980 Peter Hallissy now also operates Toyota and Chevrolet dealerships at 777 Rogers Street in Lowell
- Sep 1980 Larry Cunningham jumps ship and goes to Hallissy Chevrolet at 777 Rogers Street in Lowell
- Sep 1980 Walter Sullivan is doing business as Walter Sullivan's Colonial Chevrolet
- Nov 1982 Peter Hallissy invites former Colonial Chevrolet customers to visit Hallissy World of Cars in Lowell for all their automotive needs
- Jan 1983 Ronald Boyd sells the 34-48 Chelmsford Street property to Charles Parlee for commercial redevelopment
- Mar 1995 Charles Parlee transfers the property to J & C Management Co.
- Dec 1996 J & C Management Co. transfers the property title in trust to William Whitehouse (Charles Parlee's son-in-law)
