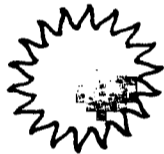

## Provincial cuts startle Pickering

Councillors struggle to keep Town tax hike below 15%

PICKERING Councillors are faced with the daunting task of cutting about \$2.25

million out of Pickering's 1996 budget to avoid raising Town property taxes by 15 per cent.

The councillors got the bad news Thursday morning at Pickering's first budget meeting for 1996. They already knew Town staff had drawn up a budget which would require a 12-per cent tax increase to maintain operations at existing levels.

But that was topped off by the startling news received from Queen's Park late Wednesday afternoon that provincial grants to Pickering were being cut in 1996 by \$907,873 or 42.5 per cent. Town officials had been expecting a reduction of 10 to 20 per cent and had based their budget on that

## Pickering wonders if economic boom to continue

PICKERING The first half of this decade has been good for Pickering from an economic point of view, but the new year may not be so rosy.

From 1991 to 1994 there was a net increase here of about 500 jobs annually and approximately 30 new companies have moved to town each year. Town co-ordinator of economic development and promotions Joan Alfrey expects the job and business growth figures for 1995 to be similar, though they're not yet available.

"Through the recessionary years we still had very good growth," she explains. "I think Pickering benefited from the high prices in the Toronto area. We benefited from Toronto's initial downfall because we had the sense to keep our taxes low and didn't take advantage of the boom years (by increasing expenditures

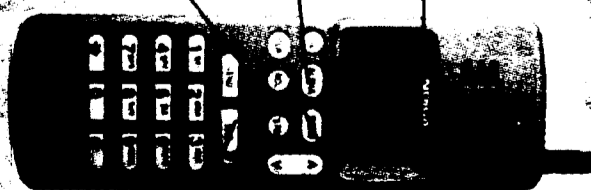

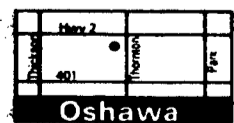

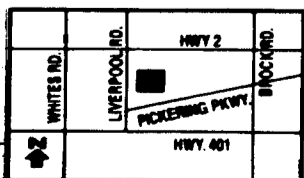

# No clues found in helicopter search for Pickering man missing a week

PICKERING — A helicopter search here Thursday failed to turn up any clues into the disappearance of a Pickering man missing more than a week. But the air search will help Durham Regional Police as they undertake a foot search Friday (today) of the Seaton Hiking Trail to look for 38-year-old Derrick Francis.

"It gave us a better idea of the terrain we're facing," Detective Jamie Grant says of Thursday's search using an Ontario Provincial Police heli-

copter from Orillia. "We'll be hitting some dense areas."

Mr. Francis, a Longbow Drive resident, was last seen by his wife leaving home for work the morning of Dec. 28. He never arrived at his Scarborough office and hasn't been heard from since.

His 1995 red Acura was found on Forest Stream Trail in north Pickering near Seaton Hiking Trail on Saturday around 5:30 p.m. There were no obvious signs of a struggle in the car, according to

police, who were unable to find a trail of footprints leading from the car.

Searches were carried out that day with dogs, snowmobiles and people on foot. Helicopter searches were called off Wednesday morning due to poor visibility.

Mr. Francis is described as black, 6' tall, 175 pounds, with short black hair and brown eyes.

## Quiet year end for cops

DURHAM — Durham Regional Police are calling this Christmas and New Year's holidays one of the most quiet in recent memory.

New Year's Eve and the first day of 1996 were especially quiet for police, says Staff Sergeant Sandy Rylie.

"We normally have 19 or 20 pages of occurrences a day, but we only had seven or eight pages over New Year's," says Staff Sgt. Rylie.

"We can safely say it was quiet. There were very few major incidents."

The quiet end to 1995 wrapped up a year in which crime in general was down, says Staff Sgt. Rylie.

Durham Region only had one slaying

in 1995, a Port Perry murder-suicide, compared to five homicides in 1994. The number of murders continued to decline in the region from an all-time high of 13 in 1991, when Durham was the per-capita murder capital of Canada.

Police statistics compiled through to the end of October indicate other major crimes were also down.

Crimes against people, which include murder, sexual assault, assault and robbery, decreased 3.8 per cent through the first 10 months of 1995, compared to the same period in 1994.

Crimes against property dropped 1.4 per cent during the same time.

"We like to credit some of the reduction to improved policing methods, but it's also a cyclical type of situation," says Staff Sgt. Rylie.

There were 2,118 assaults in Durham through the end of October last year, compared to 2,196 for the same period in 1994.

The number of reported sexual assaults dropped off to 461 last year, compared to 524 in 1994.

Robberies fell marginally to 195 last year, compared to 200 in 1994.

Impaired-driving related charges laid through regular patrols (not including the RIDF program) were down 12 per cent last year, police say.

Despite the overall downward trend, the number of car thefts and break and enters is on the rise.

Vehicle thefts increased 1.3 per cent last year, with 1,812 in 1995, compared to 1,789 in 1994.

Break and enters jumped six per cent, with 3,573 commercial properties and residences hit last year, compared to 3,346 in 1994.

before the recession hit). Pickering should continue to benefit from its low taxes for some years to come, according to Ms. Alfrey, because other municipalities will take years to reach a competitive level even if they cut their taxes to match. But there are dangers ahead. One is that the Province may take some action to even out municipal taxes across the Greater Toronto Area — as is rumored to be recommended by the Golden Task Force on GTA reform, which is expected to release its report this month. "If they do it that would definitely take away one of our advantages. I'm not expecting it and I sincerely hope it doesn't happen. It would be a

major challenge. We don't know what the private sector will do if they homogenize the GTA tax base." Another danger ahead is the continued globalization of the economy. Pickering's economy is no longer intertwined only with that of the GTA but with the rest of the world, according to Ms. Alfrey. And it is a world where corporations move around in search of efficiency, new ideas, new consumers and new locations. "The jobs are disappearing from Canada and going to other countries. It's still happening and it will probably be happening for at least another couple of years." But Pickering has done all right so far in the global economy. Among

estimate. Pickering will receive about \$2.46 million from the Province this year, compared to approximately \$3.5 million last year. Town manager Tim Sheffield explained Pickering is facing a number of increased costs this year which account for the possible 15-per cent tax increase councillors will wrestle with.

Those increased costs include covering the deficit incurred in 1995 by the Town's fights to prevent the opening of a new dump here and force the closure of the existing Brock West landfill; contributing money to the Town's capital reserve fund which will be empty by mid-year if it is not replenished; setting aside funds to provide for the end of the provincially-imposed social contract this spring and for the three union contracts the Town needs to negotiate with its staff this year.

Budget deliberations were originally scheduled to begin Thursday but will now start Feb. 15 in order to give Town staff time to deal with the provincial cuts and with a direction from councillors to have each department come back with a budget totalling 90 per cent of its 1995 budget. It will also give Council a chance to appoint some-

one to fill the Ward 2 Regional council seat left vacant by the recent death of David Farr, so that the budget can be considered by a full complement of councillors. Final budget recommendations are now expected to go before Council for approval by mid-March.

the local companies which have led local economic growth are Clearnet Communications, Simmonds Technologies, Lenbrook Industries, Alderbrook Industries, Exal Aluminum, Peg Perego, Eco Tec, Yorkville Sound and Howard Martin Co. The battle ahead is to keep the list growing, and to keep the local retail and commercial sector thriving as well. The Town's economic development staff — Ms. Alfrey and one other person — are focusing on making sure Pickering is out there in the market when businesses are looking for a place to locate. Pickering's major strategies have included advertising, keeping in touch with businesses to monitor their needs, and tracking vacant office, retail and industrial space in the town. "We've tried to enable the real estate sector to use us as a one-stop office." Pickering is now also connected to a World Wide Web site run by the Ontario government, municipalities, real estate companies and investors which lists properties available for business development. "This type of searching by interna-

tional investors will become more popular as time goes by. We wanted to get in on the ground floor." Despite the Town's efforts, Ms. Alfrey expects it may be tough going for Pickering in 1996 because provincial and national economic indicators are so far suggesting a sluggish year. "I think it will just be stagnant again. I don't think we're going to have any huge leaps and bounds," she says, noting the economic atmosphere is still very uncertain. "It's anyone's guess what's going to happen in 1996. I just have a gut feeling it's not going to be as good as 1995."

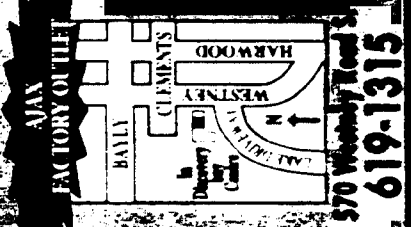
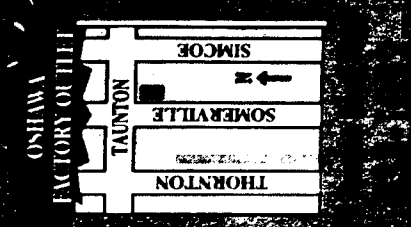

# Christmas brightened by one man's kindness



Pickering's Kelly Matijcio had her Christmas Day brightened through the kindness of a stranger. She recounts her story here.

### To the editor:

On Christmas Day I was struck by the kindness of a stranger. I have no idea who he was or even what his name might be.

I was scheduled to work on Dec. 25 from early morning to mid-afternoon. The convenience store in which I work part-time is busy and I'm sure most, if not all, of Pickering has visited me at one time or another.

Christmas day comes but once a year. Like every other year my family, especially my mother, have gone out of their way to make it a happy, memorable occasion.

Despite such efforts, I have been feeling alone and unhappy with the circumstances surrounding my personal life.

Unable to hide my sadness, many of my more attentive cus-

tomers were aware and cheerfully wished me a Merry Christmas and offered friendly smiles. One in particular shone above all the others. He was about my age, early 20s (my guess). He sympathized with me and briefly spoke of his own experience of Christmas this year as somewhat disappointing as well.

At the closure of this three-minute conversation, he picked up his purchases and said "Maybe things will be better for both of us in 1996."

I watched as he left the store, climbed into his car and drove away. Thinking little more of it, I grimly returned to my duties at hand.

No more than 10 minutes later he returned. I looked up and immediately recognized his face. "You're back," I said and smiled.

As he walked toward me he raised his hand and in it were a dozen long-stem roses, held out to me. My eyes, I'm sure, were wide with shock and disbelief as I struggled to say "My God, how sweet." As I watched he turned to walk out of the store, stopping by the door a few feet away, and turned to me.

"You just can't leave," I stammered. "Give me your phone number." I was lost for two simple words -- thank you -- wondering how I could repay him for his thoughtfulness. He looked at me and said, "No one deserves to be unhappy at Christmas time." With that he turned and once again, I watched as he drove away.

For the remaining hour of my shift, I stared back constantly at those roses lying on the counter

behind me. It was almost as if I was unsure they were really there. I felt filled by the kindness shown to me by a man I had never met. I remain in awe at the simplicity of his thoughtfulness, this gift and the person who so generously shared it with me.

Even now as the disappointment and sadness begins to haunt me once again, I need only to glance at these beautiful roses to be filled with the warmth that makes Christmas a special time of year.

I know that my memory of this day will always be of a stranger's kindness and not of the circumstances I face at this unfortunate time.

For this I am forever grateful to you, whoever you are.

# Regular patrols beat R.I.D.E. in charging drunk drivers in Durham

□ Twelve people charged with impaired driving after being stopped by patrol units

DURHAM — Only one person stopped by Durham Regional Police's holiday R.I.D.E. program last week failed the breathalyzer. A dozen others were captured by regular patrols.

Police R.I.D.E. spotchecks stopped 3,500 vehicles in the week ending Jan. 1 and 16 drivers were

checked on the roadside tester. Four drivers were issued 12-hour suspensions, one person failed the test and was arrested for driving over the legal limit of 80 milligrams.

Police on regular patrols arrested 12 people for impaired driving.

So far this holiday season, 27,250 vehicles have been stopped by the R.I.D.E. program and police have administered 129 roadside tests. Police have issued 36 12-hour suspensions and have charged nine people with drinking and driving offences.

# Teen students make improvements, tests show

**□ But there's a danger in comparing one school to another: public board**

DURHAM — Young public high school students are improving their reading skills, while their writing is slightly worse, last year's provincial Grade 9 tests reveal.

And though the board has released individual results of schools which took part in the reading and writing tests, along with its own Grade 12 writing review, they come with a warning about the dangers of comparing one school's performance against another.

"If I believed the rankings reflected only the performance of a principal and teacher, that would be one thing, but they don't," explains Durham Board of Education superintendent Dave Snodden.

"Outside factors have a far greater influence on those rankings," he says, pointing to such things as a child's social and economic environment.

"We don't have the ability yet to track the other factors," though students who took the tests were asked if English was their first language.

The test results "are just a snapshot," adds English program facilitator Jane Crosbie. They don't take into account, for example, "students who may have a joy of learning and who will continue to work hard" though they may not have fared as well in the test as other students.

She fears the results "sort of pit one

(school) against another" and admits she "would be hard-pressed to find benefits to listing individual school results."

(The results must be released under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.)

Instead, schools will be encouraged to use the findings — along with data from feeder schools and individual school surveys on methods of instruction and what types of

teaching students find relevant — to determine how they can improve.

"We will be acting as a coach, rather than an umpire," notes Mr. Snodden, who believes "what you do with the results is more important than the results themselves."

Overall, the percentage of Grade 9 students in Durham who performed at or above the expected standard for reading increased from 91 per cent in 1993-94 to 97 per cent in

1994-95.

Across the province, 90 per cent of students performed at the expected standard in 1993-94, while 94 per cent achieved that level in 1994-95.

(Students who achieved levels three to five are considered to be within the expected achievement range for their grade. Students in levels one and two were not at the expected level, while those in level six achieved beyond the expected level.)

The percentage of Grade 9 students performing at or above the expected standard for writing decreased from 96 per cent in 1993-94 to 93 per cent in 1994-95.

Meanwhile, the Durham board took part in an independent Grade 12 writing review last year along with boards in Halton, Lakehead and North York.

It followed a review conducted by the Ministry of Education and Training in 1991-92 and was carried out in an attempt to monitor changes in student writing skills.

Overall, the percentage of advanced-level students who performed at or above level four — the expected standard — increased from 63 per cent in 1992 to 74 per cent in 1995.

The percentage of Durham students performing at or above level four increased from 62 per cent in 1992 to 76 per cent in 1995.

The percentage of general-level students in the four-board consortium who performed at or above level three — the expected standard — increased from 68 per cent in 1992 to 78 per cent in 1995.

The percentage of Durham students performing at or above that level increased from 72 per cent in 1992 to 83 per cent in 1995.

## How Durham schools fared

DURHAM — Realizing the temptation to compare how schools performed in provincial tests will be hard to resist, the public board notes "the differences are quite subtle."

"People will make comparisons at the end of the day," admits Durham Board of Education superintendent Dave Snodden.

While there are many ways of comparing schools, such as the percentage of students in accepted levels and which schools improved over previous years, the following is a list of the top local schools in the Grade 9 reading test:

□ O'Neill Collegiate and Vocational Institute in Oshawa, with seven per cent of its students achieving level six.

□ Sinclair Secondary School in Whitby, Port Perry High School and Uxbridge High School each had six per cent of its students at that level.

The top local schools in the Grade 9 writing test:

□ Sinclair walked away with four per cent of students performing at the top end of the scale.

□ Exeter High School in Ajax and Cartwright Secondary School in Blackstock each had three per cent of its students performing at level six.

In the four-board Grade 12 writing review, three per cent of Durham's advanced-level students achieved level six. Top schools were:

□ O'Neill Collegiate and Vocational Institute in Oshawa with 7.7 per cent of its students at level six.

□ R.S. McLaughlin C.V.I. in Oshawa had 4.4 per cent of its students achieve that level, while 3.8 per cent of students at both Pickering High School in Ajax and Cartwright hit that mark.

In that writing review, seven per cent of Durham's general-level students achieved level five. Top schools were:

□ Ajax High, with 17.5 per cent of its students achieving level five.

□ R.S. McLaughlin with 12.2 per cent of its students at that level, while 11.1 per cent of students at Dunbarton High School in Pickering achieved that level.

## Ajax flautist gets Behind the Mask

It's the 'best album I've ever done'

AJAX — An Ajax musician weaved more magic with his flute during the making of his latest musical offering.

Ron Korb released his fourth solo effort entitled Behind The Mask in December. The CD, recorded at Quest Studios in Oshawa and released on the Oasis label, took two years from conception to completion.

The 34-year-old flautist notes Behind The Mask uses influences as diverse as Caribbean, Celtic and Chinese styles, employing such instruments as the dizi (Chinese buzz flute), the suling (Indonesian recorder) and the erhu (Chinese two-string violin) which add to the rich sounds which envelop the music.

"It's definitely the best album I've done," says Korb, who's been playing

the wind instrument professionally for the past 15 years.

"I wanted to venture out into Indonesian, Middle Eastern and Spanish music. I wanted to do it in a soundtrack form and bring in exotic influences."

The inspiration for the new CD came, oddly enough, when Korb saw television news reports of the Desert Storm war that allied nations fought against Iraq while he was living in Japan.

"I thought it would be

neat to write an allegory for this and set it far back in the past," he says, adding there are many layers of symbolism throughout the work.

Korb used the talents of the nine-member Kappa Band, all of whom are multi-instrumentalists, on Behind The Mask. Korb and his bandmates played on CITY-TV's Breakfast Television last month in support of the album and also plan to do a number of Toronto nightclub dates, including a show at the Rivoli on Queen Street West on Jan. 23.

Korb's fascination with the flute knows no bounds, as he's travelled the world in search of unique sounds and instruments in the flute realm. After finishing his musical studies at York University and the University of Toronto, Korb began a two-year stay in Japan where he studied with several Japanese musicians on a number of different Oriental woodwind instruments.

Since 1990 he's released three albums on the Oasis

label — Tear of the Sun, in collaboration with Donald Quan; Japanese Mysteries, a suite of 13 tracks recorded by Korb and a number of Japanese traditional, classical and jazz musicians; and Flute Traveller, which featured instruments from India, the South Pacific, the Orient, Europe and South

and North America.

Besides his album work, Korb has also served as a flute instrumentalist on such Canadian movie soundtracks as Exotica and Johnny Mnemonic. He's also been involved in soundtrack work for television shows like The Road to Avonlea.

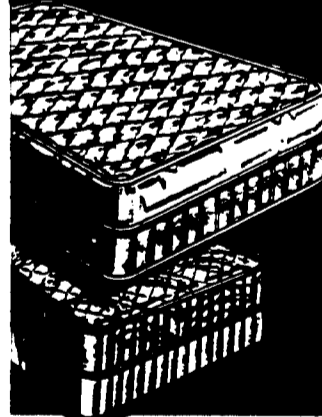

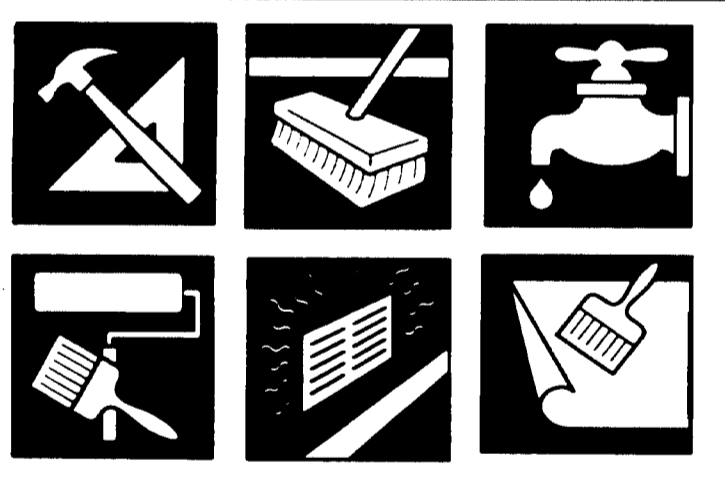

Working with wood whether you do it for a living or a hobby is not only a challenge but also an enjoyable pastime.

Rates for using the shop are very reasonable. You can use the facilities for \$8.00 per hour and \$7.00 an hour for seniors over 55.

For those who want further savings, you can become a member of The Carpenter's Square for \$199 per year and pay only \$4.25 per hour during the day and \$5.00 an hour on evening and weekends.

Professionals and very serious do-it yourselfers can also purchase blocks of time from 8 to 40 hours with discounts of 10 to 30% depending on the amount of time purchased.

The fees include the use of all of the facilities, tools and accessories and you can store your projects on site. For membership holders there's a discount on all seminars, workshops and courses.

"We are also available to give people assistance and for those that want us to do their project for them, we charge a very reasonable labour fee of \$20 per hour," says Jeff.

You can also buy supplies at The Carpenter's Square including sandpaper, nails, screws, glue, saw blades, etc for more than 50% less than you'd pay at a retail outlet.

"We also want to get the community involved by inviting local woodworking and carving clubs to hold meetings here," says Jeff. "We want to promote the fun and enjoyment that people can get from working with wood."

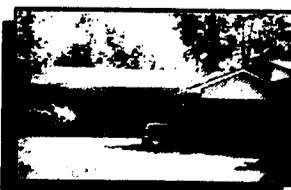
