## Crash kills Pickering woman

Ajax woman injured

PICKERING -- A Pickering woman is dead and an Ajax woman in stable condition after a horrific two-car crash here Thursday afternoon.

Visitation Lidon, 54, was killed after her Dodge Spirit travelling northbound on Glenanna Road was hit in the intersection at Hwy. 2 by an east-bound Cadillac around 3 p.m., Durham Regional Police report.

The lone occupants of the two vehicles were taken to Ajax-Pickering General Hospital where Mrs. Lidon was pronounced dead on arrival.

Police say it appears she had stopped at a red light and proceeded on the green when her vehicle was hit. A GO Transit bus turning into the intersection may have sustained minor damage when struck by one of the cars in the initial collision.

Mrs. Lidon was wearing a seatbelt but the driver of the Cadillac wasn't, police report.

Judy MacFadyen, 48, was listed in stable condition with serious injuries at press time Thursday.

Police continue to investigate.

## Things looking up for Daniel Burton

**Pickering boy home for first time in two months after life-saving bone marrow transplant**

**AJAX-PICKERING** — Daniel Burton is home at last.

The 10-year old student of Ecole

Catholique Notre-Dame-de-la-Jeunesse in Ajax returned to his Pickering residence for the first time in two months last Friday, after receiving a life-saving bone marrow transplant Dec. 1.

Though there is always a danger his leukemia will return, the transplant has been a success.

"His marrow is very strong and his counts are good," says his

father, Dave Burton. "He's in good shape."

But there are tough times ahead for Daniel, who has been left with some neurological problems as a result of all the chemotherapy and radiation he has had to undergo to battle his leukemia and to destroy his own marrow in preparation for the transplant. The treatments resulted in some "insult" to Daniel's brain,

explains his father, and he now has problems with his co-ordination and speaking.

"His speech is very limited and he tends to repeat things. He's not Daniel right now — the Daniel we know. He realizes he's not himself and he can't do the things he used to do."

Daniel has been so shaken by what has happened to him that he was a little reluctant to leave the hospital where he felt secure and

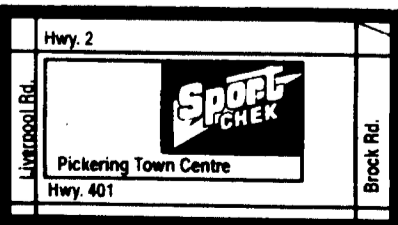

# GTA-wide police force could be too costly: top cop

DURHAM — Creating one police force to oversee the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) might not be a good idea, says Durham's top cop.

"An issue that arises is affordability," Durham Regional Police Chief Trevor McCagherty says in reacting to one of the Golden Report recommendations for GTA reform. "I'm not sure one large service is a good idea.

"In December of last year the Solicitor-General announced a review of police services — the finance, governance and structure of policing in Ontario — and I would

assume any action on (GTA) task force recommendations would be deferred until that review is complete."

There would be "significant" start-up costs associated with a GTA-wide police service, he says.

When the Durham Regional Police Service was implemented in 1974, start-up costs were estimated at \$500,000, reports Chief McCagherty. The final bill wound up being \$4 million, he says.

"It's very, very hard to contemplate the distant future when you're fighting in the trenches today to keep an even keel," he adds.

two-and-a-half days. Leave this issue with social service, if social services really is their aim."

Says Polly of Ajax:

"I have been a taxpayer in Ajax since 1983 and I don't want them to cut junior kindergarten. I think they should stop undermining our children's education because the children are our future and I'm really upset about it."

Brian Thompson of Pickering:

"I think it's totally unfair that they're doing that without consultation with the public in the areas that are concerned. I wonder if they would like it if we had a rush vote to get rid of half the trustees in one day."

Susan Smith of Ajax:

"The decision of the provincial gov-

ernment which suggests junior kindergarten be cut or optional is one decision I agree with. There are a lot of facilities for would-be junior kindergartners — nurseries, play schemes and gym clubs.

If JK is for socializing and finding out about the world they live in, we already have the infrastructure in place. There is no need to make costly renovations to schools.

The 50 teaching positions lost will be balanced against those educators who lost their jobs at nursery schools when JK started. These people will most probably work again. I think kindergarten should be upgraded so children can learn to read and write. In the future there will be no Grade 13, so I think school boards should concentrate on the children in schools so the children can gain the credits they need."

Peter Hertler:

"First, I'm in favor of cutting junior kindergarten. One point I don't see any mention of here at all is the already overcrowded public schools. I cite Highbush Public School as one such example, a school which has no playground because of the sea of portables. Where will they put these pre-school children? On the sidewalks, perhaps? This has clearly become a question of social needs, not educational value."

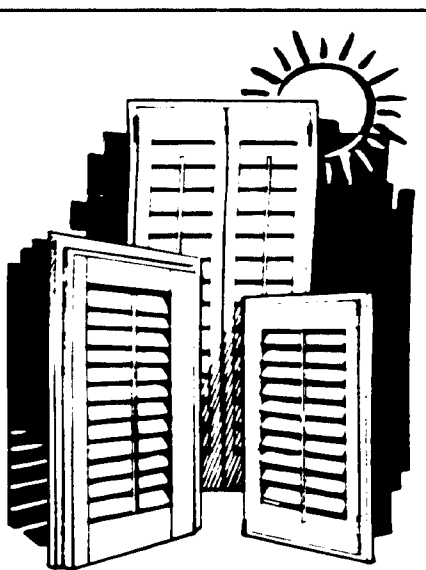

# Pickering man goes on trial for crippling basketball injury

PICKERING — A Pickering man will stand trial on criminal charges after a teenager was left a quadriplegic in a pick-up basketball game.

Hale Miller was 28 when he was charged last May with criminal negligence causing bodily harm. He will stand trial beginning May 1. It was decided at a preliminary trial

held in Oshawa last Friday.

Mr. Miller, who faces up to 10 years in prison, was charged after Scarborough teen Omari Brookes suffered a severed spinal cord in an August, 1994 game at an outdoor court at Pine Ridge Secondary School on Liverpool Road in Pickering.

Mr. Brookes, then 19, was trying to

block a jump shot when his legs were reportedly taken out from under him and he landed on his neck during the game.

When Mr. Miller was charged, Durham Regional Police Detective Keith Kritzer didn't know of any other cases involving a charge of criminal negligence in a pick-up basketball game.

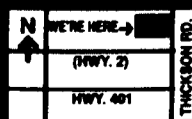

## Taxpayers simply can't afford JK

As public school board trustees toll the final bell for junior kindergarten classes, their message is coming in loud and clear: they can't continue offering the program at the expense of taxpayers.

There is little room for debate in the face of recent provincial funding cutbacks.

If the Durham Board of Education continues offering junior kindergarten to about 2,000 youngsters, it must do so at a cost of \$1.5 million a year to taxpayers. And unless it adds \$3 million for renovations, the program still wouldn't be offered at all schools in Durham.

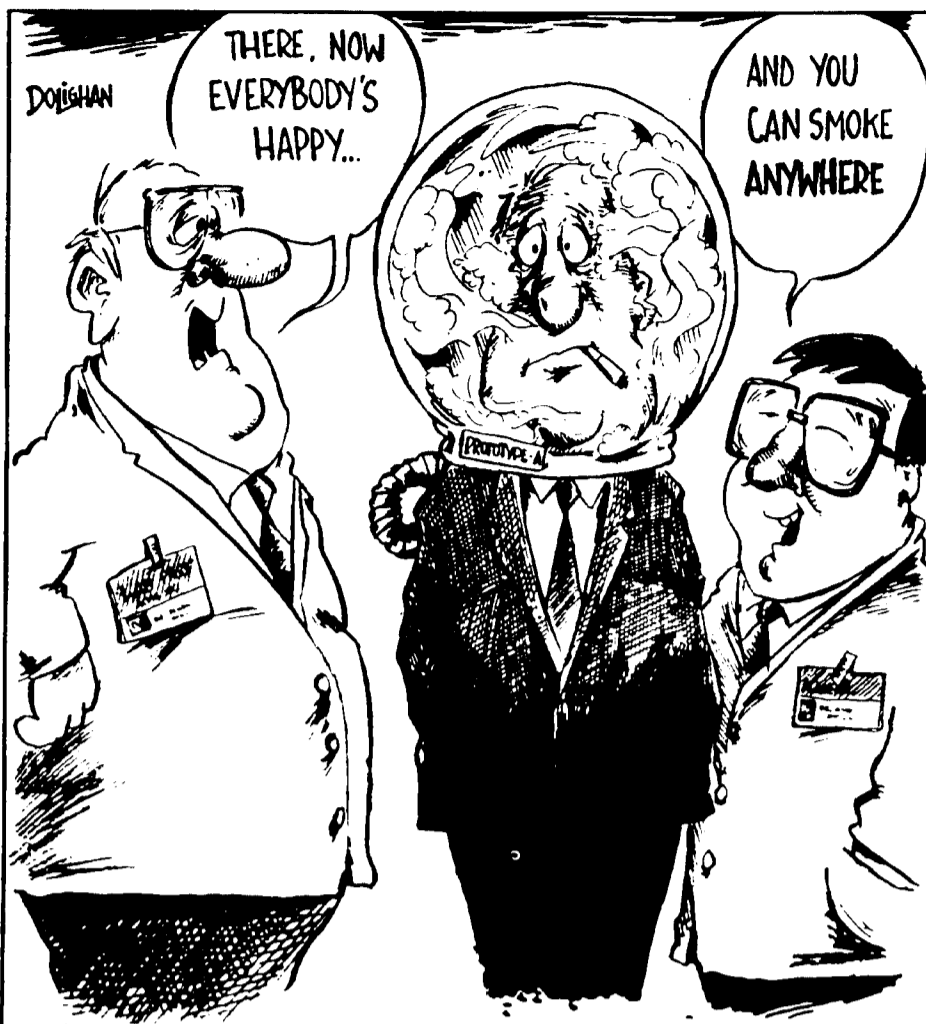
"We believe in the (educational) value of junior kindergarten, but not at the expense of other children currently in the system," notes board chairman Audrey MacLean.

Indeed, the board's decision can't rest on whether trustees believe the program has any educational and/or social value. While it could very well top any wish list, in the end it comes down to affordability and the fact that other students would be hurt in the long run.

The board must be applauded for making a tough recommendation, but it's regrettable that debate was rushed through with little warning to the public or trustees.

Though the board won't make its final decision until Monday, the meat of the debate has already taken place, leaving Oshawa trustee Mike Nicholson "ashamed and disgusted" to sit on the board.

One thing is certain: The current fiscal climate places severe limits on this board, and others across the province. Some may want the program, but none of us can reasonably afford it.

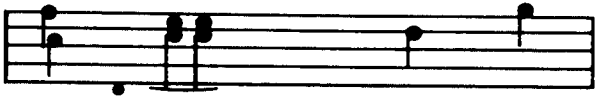
vehicle which slid off the road while going over a hill. An ambulance responding to the accident also lost control over the hill and hit the second vehicle. Minor injuries were reported.

# Daniel now started on long road to recovery

had made many friends, explains his father. But now that he's at home he's looking forward to seeing his old friends, and a bit worried about how they will react to the changes in him. He's also looking forward to doing kid things again. When Daniel came home Friday, says his dad, "he wanted barbecued hamburgers for supper and he wanted to go bowling." The burgers were put on the menu but bowling will be out of the question for a while.

Daniel isn't allowed to go any place where there are a lot of people, including school, because the new immune

system he received through the transplant is not yet ready to handle any infections he may pick up. His visitors have to be screened carefully to make sure they don't have any illnesses they can pass on to him.

There are other restrictions as well. Daniel is on a special low-bacteria diet that forbids fresh fruit, vegetables and take-out foods. His home has had to be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected, and the family had to give up their two cats. Some toys such as stuffed animals have had to be removed from his bedroom. And

Daniel is still on "all kinds of different drugs", notes his father, including cyclosporine, an anti-rejection drug to prevent his new marrow and his body from fighting each other.

Daniel can go outside to play but a lot of sports are impossible for now because his balance and co-ordination aren't good enough. But he will be going to the hospital three times a week for physical, occupational and speech therapy and the doctors say they are certain he will improve, though they don't know how much.

"We fully expect that eventually he'll come back with therapy," says Mr. Burton, adding his family sees "little flashes" in Daniel that indicate to them that he will be his old self again in time.

Daniel has been in a battle for his life since January 1995 when it was found his leukemia had returned after a three-year remission and he needed a bone marrow transplant.

Near the end of April, by which time no suitable marrow donor had been found in the existing files of bone marrow registries, Daniel's parents issued a public plea asking people to have themselves tested to see if their marrow could save Daniel's

life. In late July, just after learning Daniel had relapsed again after a six-month remission and was unlikely to survive, the Burtons were





told a donor had been found and chemotherapy was started again.

He went into remission for a time but the leukemia

returned before the transplant scheduled for Oct. 4. Doctors advised against further treatment but Daniel wasn't ready to give up and

asked for more chemotherapy, which brought another remission and made it possible to proceed with the Dec. 1 transplant.

## Don't forget other kids who need transplants, pleads Daniel's dad

AJAX-PICKERING -- Despite all he's been through, Daniel Burton is among the lucky ones.

He now has a chance at life because someone cared enough to have themselves tested and registered as a potential bone marrow donor. But for every Daniel, there are lots of other kids for whom no life-saving donor can be found.

"We met them every day at Sick Kids (the Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto)," says Daniel's father, Dave Burton.

Even though Daniel has had his transplant, Mr. Burton wants to make sure everyone doesn't forget those other kids, and urges us all to have ourselves tested and our names placed on a bone marrow registry.

All it takes is a phone call to the Toronto Red Cross Bone Marrow Registry Unit at 416-593-2257. The Red Cross will provide the dates on which registry information sessions will be held in this area (usually in Oshawa or Scarborough), and/or will provide information on how you can join the registry. All that's required to join is for you to give a blood sample, which can be tested to determine your bone marrow type. Marrow is only taken if you actually become a donor.

Between the time the Burton family started their campaign in January 1995 urging people to register and a match was found for Daniel in July, 17,000 people added their names to the Canadian registry, bringing the total to 107,000, according to Mr. Burton. The campaign reached into the U.S. as well, and that's where a donor was eventually found.

The Burtons have been told the donor is a female from the U.S. west coast, and that she joined the U.S. registry during their campaign.

## Ruby the jewel of teen television in India Former Ajax resident finds fame on music station

**AJAX --** Ruby Bhatia has gone 'Bollywood'.

The former Ajax resident is a popular Veejay on a Bombay, India music television network that's as big in that country as MuchMusic is here.

"I never anticipated it would become so big," says 22-year-old Ms. Bhatia, who won a Miss India Canada contest in 1993, which carried a first prize of a round-trip to India.

Ms. Bhatia left for India in January, 1994 to "explore the possibilities in Bombay", recognized as the 'Hollywood of India'. "We were on vacation. I decided to hang around and I got a job. I was very excited. It's a brand new field for a 20-year-old," says the former philosophy student at the University of Toronto.

Ms. Bhatia is a well-known personality on Channel V.

Her favorite part of the job is "talking to people. It's very fun-oriented." She interviews prominent personalities, introduces songs and travels across the country.

"The irregularity is getting to me," admits Ms. Bhatia. "I get up at 5 or 6 a.m. if I'm shooting, spend one hour in hair, one in make-up and briefing and one hour travelling time. I'm living in rented places and going back and forth in taxis. When I'm rich I can buy a big place and settle in," she laughs.

Ms. Bhatia won the Onida Pinnacle Award in November as best hostess on Channel V. "It was a big boost. I never perceived I'd win an award, or people on the street would recognize me. I'm very honored when it happens."

Her popularity has many people calling her a 'teen icon'. "I hope (the viewers) learn about the real me. I don't use drugs or drink and I'm not all about fashionable clothes and funky lingo. Our channel pumps us up to be role models and kids think I'm really cool."

The graduate of Archbishop Denis O'Connor Catholic High School in Ajax was actively involved in both the Indian and Canadian communities in Canada. "It was hard to leave Canada and all it stands for -- multi-culturalism, the school system and opportunity, but I'm using my skills from Canada in India. In Canada it was 'in' to be ethnic, but in India I'm identified as a Canadian. My personality took off because of my international appeal and Cana-

dian accent."

Although she left behind people she loves in Ajax, Ms. Bhatia says, "I'm very close to my parents. We have an excellent relationship, so it never felt that I was leaving them."

Her father Prem and mother Saroj are "very proud of each and every one of Ruby's achievements," says Mrs. Bhatia. "She's very ambitious, hardworking and she never wasted

time."

Ms. Bhatia was a gifted child throughout school and became involved in politics at an early age. "I've always been interested in making changes instead of having them dictated to me. My early memories of Ajax are of elections when my Mom and I would deliver flyers."

Ms. Bhatia attended a Liberal leadership convention in 1990 when she voted for the first time. "I voted for Jean Chretien for leader of his party and when he became Prime Minister I felt like I was part of the future. I was always the baby in the constituency."

She also has a special memory of meeting former Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau. "I really admired him. I kissed him on the cheek and it couldn't have been better if it was Tom Cruise," she chuckles.

Looking into the future, Ms. Bhatia says, "I wouldn't go into politics for the sake of power. I want to make changes and politics is just a way of doing it."

She also enjoys dancing, public speaking, reading and keeping a personal journal when she's not busy travelling. But, she'd be happy to be home. "I can never do without Canada. I haven't seen snow in two years. I miss the environment and fresh air, things we take for granted."

Since leaving Canada, Ms. Bhatia reports, "I've changed a lot. I've made a transition from a private person to a public one. I think being popular makes me more genuine when I meet people. I make sure I am what I am on the inside."
