

EXECUTIVE ORDER #105

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, severe weather and heavy rainfall have caused flooding in portions of the State of Wisconsin beginning August 17 and continuing through the present; and

WHEREAS, this severe weather and flooding have resulted in substantial damage to the public and private sectors and has endangered the safety and well-being of the affected citizens of the state; and

WHEREAS, the county of Monroe has been especially affected by the severe weather and flooding;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of Wisconsin, and Section 166.03(1)(b)1, Wis. Stats., do hereby declare that a state of emergency exists in the county of Monroe and direct the Division of Emergency Government and other appropriate state and local government agencies to take whatever actions are necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of the affected citizens and to coordinate recovery activities with the above-referenced county.
