H. Winning Bids. Subject to Alex Cooper Auctioneer's discretion, the highest bidder accepted by Alex Cooper Auctioneers will be the winning bidder, and the striking of the hammer marks the acceptance of the highest bid and the entry of a contract between the seller and high bidder.
