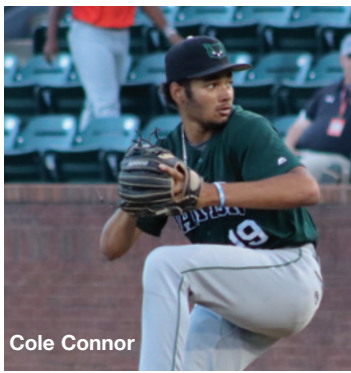

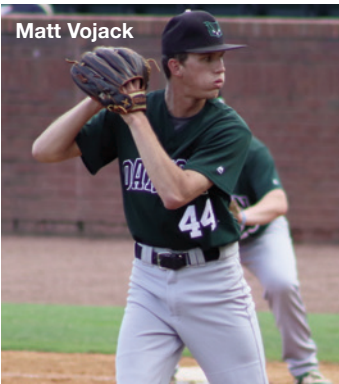

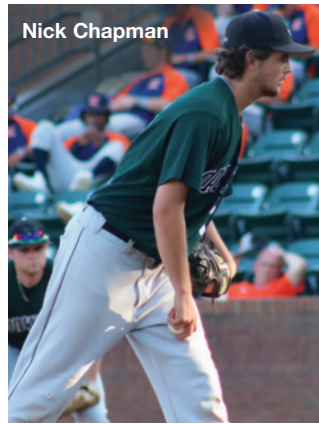

2021 Season Summary

The 2021 season the Oakton Owls (32-21) had a lot to hoot about, making the NJCAA Division III World Series for the third consecutive time, finishing 5th In the country. The Owls also won the Illinois Skyway Collegiate Conference Championship and NJCAA Region IV Championship for the third consecutive year! All of this after a year off due to the 2020 season being cancelled because of the COVID-19 epidemic that swept the country.

First baseman Aaron Vertuno led the team in hitting at .384. Christian Seegers also had a great season hitting .346 with 11 home runs and 49 RBI's and was named Illinois Skyway Collegiate Conference Player of the Year.

On the mound the Owls's were led by Nate Pardini with a 6-0 pitching record. Kyle Moore also had a great year being named to the World Series All-Tournament team. Also leading to the Owl's success was lefthander Joe Gabel who posted a 5-1 record on the mound.

The All-Region Team from Oakton consisted of first team Nate Pardini, Christian Seegers and Brandon Matias. Named to the second team were Joe Gabel and Steele Beatty. Bill Fratto was also named Coach of the Year in the Illinois Skyway Collegiate Conference and Region IV.

Oakton continued to be a team that is well known nationally as well finishing fifth in the final rankings!

As the current No. 4 ranked team in the NJCAA Division III polls, Owls baseball got off to a strong start in Florida in March posting a 5-3 record. The team wrapped up a trip to the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational where they tested their lineup against some very competitive teams from around the country. The promising start to the season is a continuation of what has been a successful program under Head Coach Bill Fratto whose team claimed the 2021 ISCC and Region IV titles, as well as a fifth place finish at the NJCAA Division III National Tournament. The Owl's ultimate season goal is to make their fourth straight appearance to the National Tournament.

Coming into the season in the outfield, the Owls return sophomore Brandon Matias (Glenbrook South), a 2021 first team ISCC and Region IV performer, as well as sophomore Brendan Holloway (Vernon Hills). Leading the infield is 2021 ISCC honoree sophomore Jack Dupuis (Glenbard South) and sophomore Quinn Meier (Glenbrook North). In addition, the pitching corps is led by NJCAA World Series all-tournament team honoree sophomore Kyle Moore (Bolingbrook), and includes newcomers Aidan Pavoris (Huntley), Sam Arnold (Maine West), and Cole Connor (Prospect).

Bill Fratto, Head Coach



Bill Fratto, who played at Oakton Community College for two seasons before graduating in 1981, boasts a 576-326 record in 17 seasons as head baseball coach for the Owls.

At the start of the 2018 season, Oakton's baseball squad sought to "return to conquer" with a goal of winning 40 games. The Oakton Owls surpassed all expectations by earning their first-ever national championship in dramatic fashion, dethroning the five-time defending champion Tyler Junior College, in the 2018 NJCAA Division III World Series.

Oakton established a school record with 44 wins in a single season, surpassing the previous record of 43 in 2012. The Owls also set single season records for innings pitched (459), besting the previous record of 454 set in 2012, and at-bats (1,887), eclipsing the previous best of 1,847 also in 2012.

Offensively, the Owls clicked on all cylinders in 2018, finishing second in the nation in runs scored (503), walks (289) and sacrifice flies (31) and third in hits (632), extra base hits (187), at-bats (1,887) and total bases (932). Oakton players tallied 425 RBI and 45 home runs while amassing a .335 team batting average.

Postseason accolades poured in for the Wheeling resident, as Fratto was named the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) and Diamond Sports National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Division III National Coach of the Year. He also was named World Series Coach of the Year after the Owl's performance.

Under his seasoned leadership, Oakton has built a winning tradition and gained national prominence. Coach Fratto prides himself on seeing his players develop personally, athletically and academically. Under his tutelage, dozens of Oakton players have advanced to compete at NCAA Division I, II and III institutions, as well as NAIA schools. His players have even advanced to the professional level, signing contracts with Major League Baseball teams including the Chicago Cubs, New York Yankees, Los Angeles Dodgers, Oakland Athletics, Houston Astros, San Francisco Giants, Washington Nationals and Pittsburgh Pirates.

Coach Fratto led the Owls to Illinois Skyway Collegiate Conference titles in 2006 (his first year as head coach), 2012, 2015 and 2016 and 2021. He also guided the Owls to NJCAA Region IV Championship appearances in 2007, 2010, 2012 and 2015, and to two Region IV Championships in 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2022.

Fratto also coaches for the Schaumburg Boomers, the 2013, 2014, 2017 and 2021 Frontier League champions.

He played baseball at Maine East High School and then for Oakton for two seasons. He continued his playing career at the University of Georgia and served as the bullpen catcher for the Chicago Cubs from 1985-1989.

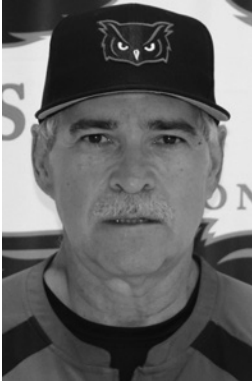

A resident of Prospect Heights, John Guarnaccia enters his 16th season with Oakton's coaching staff. The Philadelphia Phillies selected Guarnaccia in the 1972 Major League Baseball Draft in the fourth round, and he played eight years of professional baseball. He led the New York Penn League in RBI in 1973 and the

Western Carolina League in home runs in 1974. That same year, Guarnaccia also was MVP in the Western Carolina All-Star Game. A 1972 graduate of Downers Grove High School, he led the Trojans to West Suburban Conference (WSC) baseball championships in 1971 and 1972. His senior year, he led the WSC in both hitting (.500 batting average), and pitching (8-0).

CEDRIC REDMOND

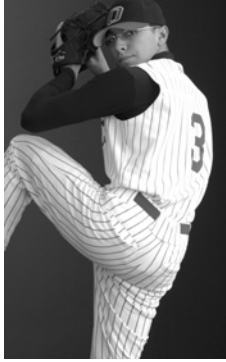
