Re: Rose Hill Landfill Superfund Site - Notice of Removal

Dear Mark:

Waste Management of Massachusetts, Inc. ("WMMA") submits this response to EPA's Notice of Removal Activity, Notice of Potential Liability, And Invitation to Perform or Finance Proposed Activities (the "NOR") at the Rose Hill Landfill Superfund Site in South Kingstown, Rhode Island (the "Site"). For the reasons set forth below, WMMA respectfully declines EPA's invitation to perform or finance the proposed removal activity, and requests that EPA withdraw the NOR issued to Waste Management of North America, Inc.¹

1. EPA Has Failed to State A Claim Against WMMA

In the NOR, EPA states:

EPA has evaluated evidence gathered during investigations of the Site. Based on this evidence, EPA has information indicating that Waste Management of North America, Inc. is a potentially responsible party under Section 107(a) of CERCLA with respect to the Site. Specifically, EPA has reason to believe that Waste Management of North America, Inc. (Goditt & Boyer, Inc.) transported some of the hazardous substances found at the Site.

¹ Furthermore, WMMA reiterates that it, not Waste Management of North America, Inc. is the proper corporate entity to whom EPA should address its communications concerning Goditt & Boyer. As stated in the response which Waste Systems, Inc. submitted in May, 1989 to EPA's Request for Information, and as set forth at Paragraph 1 of the Affidavit of David S. Brask (hereinafter the "Brask Affidavit") which is submitted herewith, Goditt & Boyer was a subsidiary of Waste Systems, Inc., and both companies were acquired by WMMA on January 1, 1988, and merged into WMMA in 1990.

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EPA's statement omits an essential element of the government's case against a transporter under CERCLA. The statute provides, in unambiguous terms, that a transporter of wastes to a Superfund site is only liable if he selects the site for disposal of those wastes. 42 U.S.C. § 9607(a)(4). EPA's own published guidance provides:

Issuance of notice letters to transporters is appropriate only when information obtained indicates that the transporter may have selected the site or facility. Similarly, enforcement actions (whether administrative or judicial) would be brought under § 106 or § 107 only under the same circumstances. As a matter of policy, EPA will bring action only against transporters where information is available which indicates that the transporter selected the site or facility.

U.S. EPA (OSWER) Policy for Enforcement Actions Against Transporters Under CERCLA, Dec. 23, 1985, at 2 (emphasis added). The case law emphasizes that "site selection" is a necessary element which EPA must prove in order to state and sustain a claim against a transporter under CERCLA. As one federal district court has stated recently, "[u]nder the unambiguous terms of Section 9607(a)(4) and well-settled case law, a person cannot be liable as a transporter unless that person actually selects the site." U.S. v. Peterson Sand and Gravel, Inc., ___ F. Supp. ___, 1992 W.L. 293328, 10 (N.D. Ill. Oct. 7, 1992) (emphasis added). Accord Alcatel Information Systems, Inc. v. Arizona, 778 F. Supp. 1092, 1096 (D. Az. 1991); United States v. Western Processing Co., Inc., 756 F. Supp. 1416, 1420 (W.D. Wa. 1991); United States v. Hardage, 750 F. Supp. 1444, 1458 (W.D. Okl. 1990); United States v. South Carolina Recycling and Disposal, Inc., 653 F. Supp. 984, 1005 (D.S.C. 1984), aff'd in part, rev'd in part on other grounds, 858 F.2d 160 (4th Cir. 1988), cert. denied, 490 U.S. 1106 (1989). See also R.M. Eddy & D.T. Riendl, Transporter Liability Under CERCLA, 16 Env. L. Rep. 10244, 10251-52 (Sept. 1986).

EPA does not allege that WMMA (Goditt & Boyer) selected the Site for disposal of wastes, and thus fails to state a cause of action under CERCLA against WMMA. Furthermore, despite WMMA's oral and written requests, EPA has not produced any evidence linking Goditt & Boyer to the Site other than the materials submitted in conjunction with the 104(e) responses of Peacedale Processing Company, Inc. ("Peacedale Processing") and Peacedale Processing's related companies Coated Sales, Inc. and Kenyon Industries, Inc. These responses do not contain any information that Goditt & Boyer selected the Site. Indeed, they indicate that Peacedale Processing selected the Site for the disposal of its wastes. Thus, WMMA hereby renews its request to EPA to produce to WMMA information, if any, it has, indicating that Goditt & Boyer did select the Site. If EPA has any such information, WMMA is entitled to an opportunity to confront any such evidence.

2. Goditt & Boyer Did Not Select the Rose Hill Landfill as a Disposal Site

The following facts were derived from the affidavits of David J. Brask and Bruce Buffington (hereinafter the "Brask Affidavit" and "Buffington Affidavit"), which are submitted herewith, as well as a review of the 104(e) responses received by EPA and the Town of South Kingstown's records. These facts reveal that Goditt & Boyer's only connection to the Site was as a transporter of non-hazardous trash for Peacedale Processing, and that Peacedale Processing, not Goditt & Boyer, selected the Site for disposal of its wastes.

a. Goditt & Boyer's Connection to the Site

Goditt & Boyer was in the business of transporting municipal solid waste ("MSW") and non-hazardous residential, commercial and industrial waste similar in nature to MSW. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 2. The geographic area in which Goditt & Boyer generally collected and disposed of non-hazardous trash and MSW was southeastern Massachusetts and sometimes Rhode Island. Id. Goditt & Boyer never had a permit to dispose of wastes at the Site, nor did Goditt & Boyer ever select the Rose Hill Landfill as a disposal site. Brask Affidavit, at ¶¶ 5, 10. Town of South Kingstown records confirm that Goditt & Boyer was never invoiced for using the Site.

In 1978, Goditt & Boyer entered into an agreement with Peacedale Processing. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 11; Buffington Affidavit, at ¶ 6. The agreement was that Goditt & Boyer would collect Peacedale Processing's non-hazardous trash one to three times a week. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 3.² Goditt & Boyer subcontracted the Peacedale Processing job to Bruce Buffington ("Buffington"). Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 4; Buffington Affidavit, at ¶¶ 2, 3.

Buffington would routinely call Goditt & Boyer each night to receive instructions as to which customers he (or one of his drivers) should collect trash from the next day. Buffington Affidavit, ¶ 2. At some point in the late 1970's, Buffington

² Indeed, as the Peacedale Processing waste summaries for 1978 and 1979 (Exhibits "B" and "C" hereto) show, Peacedale Processing segregated its wastes into "chemical wastes" (hailed by South County Sanitation Cesspool Service), "waste adhesives" hailed by Luscha Trucking, and "general trash" which was hailed by Goditt & Boyer.

received instructions to collect trash from Peacedale Processing.³ On Buffington's first trip to Peacedale Processing, he was instructed by Peacedale Processing to take the wastes he collected there to the Rose Hill Landfill, where Peacedale Processing had a permit for disposal of its wastes. Buffington Affidavit, at ¶¶ 3, 4.

Buffington observed that the trash which he collected at Peacedale Processing consisted primarily of cloth and cardboard tubes. Buffington Affidavit, at ¶ 4. All the trash that Buffington and his drivers collected from Peacedale Processing (or its affiliate Kenyon Piece Dyeworks) consisted of trash, and they transported it in a compactor truck to the Site, at Peacedale Processing's direction.⁴ Buffington never observed drums in the trash he collected at Peacedale Processing, and he did not combine any other generator's wastes with those of Peacedale Processing. As a roll-off, the Peacedale Processing job was a "dedicated load," and was never mingled with other wastes prior to disposal. Buffington Affidavit, at ¶ 5. Buffington never took any wastes to the Rose Hill Landfill other than the trash he collected from Peacedale Processing. Buffington Affidavit, at ¶¶ 4-6.

Peacedale Processing's 104(e) response, as well as that of Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc., confirms that Goditt & Boyer only serviced Peacedale Processing as a non-hazardous trash hauler. The waste summaries submitted with those responses (submitted herewith as Exhibits "A" and "B") establish that

³ The document entitled "Peacedale Processing Co., Inc. 1978 Waste Removal Costs," contained in Appendix 1 to the 104(e) response submitted by Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc. to EPA on May 2, 1989, indicates that Goditt & Boyer started to perform what is referred to as "trash removal" for Peacedale Processing in June 1978. Copies of this document and the document setting forth Peacedale Processing's 1979 waste removal costs are submitted herewith as Exhibits "A" and "B."

⁴ Buffington's use of a roll-off truck is further evidence of the non-hazardous nature of the wastes he hauled for Peacedale Processing. Peacedale Processing had its waste adhesive taken to the Site in barrels, and the liquid nature of the adhesive would have precluded its transport in a compactor truck. Pages 11 and 17 of Appendix I to the RI/FS Statement of Work in the Administrative Order (submitted herewith as Exhibit "C") confirm that prior to and during 1979 Peacedale Processing was depositing barrels containing its liquid waste, sometimes labelled "slop glue," at the Site, and that on at least one occasion Peacedale Processing transported such waste to the Site in its own truck. Buffington never hauled such wastes.

Peacedale Processing segregated its waste streams and used a different hauler for each type of waste.

The summaries show that Peacedale Processing used South County Sanitation Cesspool Service to transport its chemical wastes, Luscha Trucking to transport the waste adhesives allegedly containing trichloroethylene, and Goditt & Boyer to haul its non-hazardous trash.⁵ The narrative contained in Exhibit "C" hereto indicates that EPA also has information that, on at least one occasion, Peacedale Processing hauled its own adhesives to the Site.

b. Peacedale Processing, Not Goditt & Boyer, Selected the Site for Disposal of its Wastes

Buffington states that on his first trip to Peacedale Processing he was instructed by Peacedale Processing to take the trash he collected there to the Site. Buffington states: "I did not hold a permit for the Rose Hill Landfill, and I did not select that landfill as the site for disposal of Peacedale Processing's trash. I disposed of Peacedale Processing's wastes at the Rose Hill Landfill pursuant to the express directive of Peacedale Processing." Buffington Affidavit, at ¶ 7.

Similarly, David Brask ("Brask"), the President of Goditt & Boyer, states: "Goditt & Boyer did not hold a permit for the Rose Hill Landfill [and] did not select the site at which Peacedale Processing's trash was disposed." Brask Affidavit, at ¶¶ 5, 7. Brask explains that it was the customary business practice of Goditt & Boyer to only select a site for disposal if it held a permit for disposal at that site. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 6. Brask asserts that neither he, nor Goditt & Boyer, ever selected the Rose Hill Landfill as a disposal site. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 10.

Furthermore, Goditt & Boyer's business records also reflect that the Landfill did not bill Goditt & Boyer for disposing of wastes at the Site. As Brask explains in his affidavit, "If Goditt & Boyer selected the site to which a customer's wastes were transported, it was customary business practice for Goditt & Boyer to receive a bill from the landfill owner or operator for the disposal of those wastes," although such a billing would not necessarily indicate site selection by Goditt & Boyer. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 8. Goditt & Boyer would then bill the customer for the waste transport and for a disposal fee. In such a situation,

⁵ Peacedale Processing also use Luscha Trucking to haul its general trash until mid-1978. From mid-1978 on, Peacedale Processing states that it used Luscha Tucking alone to haul its waste adhesives to the Site, and Goditt & Boyer to haul its non-hazardous trash.

the customer would generally not be billed directly by the landfill. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 8. Goditt & Boyer was not invoiced by the Landfill for its disposal of Peacedale Processing's trash, and so Goditt & Boyer did not pass along any such fee to Peacedale Processing. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 9.

An analysis of the records of the towns of South Kingstown and Narragansett (joint operators of the Site) further supports WMMA's determination that Goditt & Boyer did not select the Site for disposal of Peacedale Processing's wastes. The town records reflect that Peacedale Processing had a permit from South Kingstown to use the Site, whereas neither Goditt & Boyer nor Bruce Buffington had such a permit.⁶ In addition, all the dump tickets issued by the Town of South Kingstown reference Peacedale Processing, not Goditt & Boyer.

In its response to Request No. 12 of EPA's information request, Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc. admits that "Peacedale Processing may have arranged for disposal or treatment, or arranged for the transportation for disposal or treatment of materials at or to the Site." The correspondence between Peacedale Processing and South Kingstown officials (submitted in conjunction with Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc.'s information response) does expressly reflect that Peacedale Processing selected the Site for disposal of its waste adhesive. See letters submitted by Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc. with its Response to EPA's Information Request.

Furthermore, Peacedale Processing states, in its response to EPA's information request, that not only did it send its waste adhesive to the Site for a period of time, but it sent its non-hazardous wastes there as well. Specifically, Peacedale Processing states that it hired Goditt & Boyer because the latter could compact the trash it took to the Site and thus enable Peacedale Processing's wastes to "take up less space [there]."⁷

All the documentary evidence, as well as the affidavits of Brask and Buffington, indicate that Goditt & Boyer did not select the Site for disposal. Site selection is an element of the government's case against a transporter under CERCLA. In the absence of evidence of site selection by Goditt & Boyer, EPA cannot sustain a claim against WMMA.

3. Goditt & Boyer did Not Transport Peacedale Processing's Hazardous Wastes to the Site

The only wastes that Goditt & Boyer transported to the Site were from Peacedale Processing. Buffington Affidavit, at ¶ 6. Buffington describes these wastes as consisting primarily of "cloth and cardboard tubes." Buffington Affidavit, at ¶ 4. The documents submitted in conjunction with the information response of Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc. indicate that Goditt & Boyer was not the hauling company Peacedale Processing used for the transport of its hazardous wastes.

Peacedale Processing's specific narrative responses to EPA's information request, the summaries of its waste removal costs for 1978 and 1979 (Exhibits "A" and "B" hereto), EPA's own Statement of Work for the RI/FS at the Site, and the newspaper articles submitted with the response of Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc., considered together, confirm that Peacedale Processing segregated its waste streams and that it was Luscha (or Luschka) and South County Sanitation Cesspool Service, not Goditt & Boyer, who hauled Peacedale Processing's hazardous and chemical wastes. The following facts are illustrative:

(1) As EPA notes in its draft Statement of Work for the RI/FS (Exhibit "C" hereto), in 1970 Peacedale Processing was sending its urethane adhesive in drums to the Site on a daily basis where it was disposed of "by dumping it onto other wastes that had been deposited there that day to take advantage of the absorptive characteristics of this material."

(2) In 1971, the State Division of Solid Waste Management notified the South Kingstown Town Manager that liquid waste from Peacedale Processing was being improperly disposed of at the Rose Hill solid waste landfill. The letter stated that the liquid should be spread over the surface of the Site to allow absorption. See Exhibit "C."

(3) Goditt & Boyer did not start hauling any wastes for Peacedale Processing until 1978, at which time Goditt & Boyer was hired to haul non-hazardous trash to the Site. Brask Affidavit, at ¶ 3. Buffington collected this trash in a roll-off truck, and was instructed by Peacedale Processing to take it to the Site. Buffington Affidavit, at ¶ 4.

(4) Peacedale Processing's waste summaries confirm that the company segregated its waste streams, and used a different hauler for each type of waste. South County Cesspool Service hauled Peacedale Processing's "cesspool (chemical wastes)" for both 1978 and 1979. Luscha Trucking hauled Peacedale Processing's "trash" for 5 months of 1978 and its "adhesive" for all 12 months

of that year.⁸ In 1979, Luscha Trucking hauled Peacedale Processing's adhesive to the Site for only 8 months. See Exhibits "A" and "B" submitted herewith.

(5) Goditt & Boyer hauled Peacedale Processing's trash from June of 1978 through November 1981.

(6) Peacedale Processing states in its information response that it disposed of its waste adhesive at the Site until 1979, at which time the Town of South Kingstown "became concerned about the composition of th[e] solid adhesive waste."

(7) Local newspaper articles reflect that in September 1979 the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Protection ("RIDEM") ordered Peacedale Processing to stop dumping its adhesive at the Site.

(8) Despite notice from RIDEM in December 1979 that it could resume disposal of adhesive at the Site, Peacedale Processing did not resume such dumping, deciding instead to send all of its adhesive waste to the Central Landfill in Johnston, Rhode Island (see Peacedale Processing information response).

(9) As Exhibit "B" shows, Peacedale Processing paid Luscha Trucking for only 8 months of 1979, reflecting the cessation of transport of adhesive to the Site in September 1979.

(10) Goditt & Boyer, which only hauled Peacedale Processing's non-hazardous trash, was paid for all 12 months of 1979, and Goditt & Boyer continued to haul for Peacedale Processing through November 1981 (more than 2 years of trash disposal after Peacedale Processing ceased sending any waste adhesives to the Site.

(11) Peacedale Processing states in its information response that it switched from using Ben Luschka as a general trash hauler to using Goditt & Boyer because the latter had compacting capabilities which would cause Peacedale Processing's wastes (not adhesive waste) to take up less space at the Site. This explains

⁸ As the correspondence between the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management ("RIDEM") and Peacedale Processing (submitted in conjunction with the 104(e) response of Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc.) shows, it was Peacedale Processing's waste laminating adhesive, which contained trichloroethylene, which caused RIDEM and subsequently EPA to perform an environmental investigation at the Site.

why Luschka was only billed for 5 months of hauling trash in 1978 and Goditt & Boyer was billed for 7 months.

4. Goditt & Boyer Was, At Most, A De Minimis Hauler of Hazardous Wastes to the Site

South Kingstown invoices for disposals of waste at the Site, which were provided to EPA in conjunction with the Town's information response, indicate that a total of 302,626,146 lbs. of waste were disposed of at the Site between 1/7/72 and 10/5/83. Peacedale Processing's waste comprised 6,128,919 (or approximately 2 percent) of this total. WMMA's investigation reveals that Goditt & Boyer was only a transporter for Peacedale Processing from approximately June 1978 through November 1981. The town's invoices reflect that during this period Peacedale Processing disposed of 2,383,585 lbs. of waste at the Site. Peacedale Processing's waste summaries indicate that Lusha Trucking hauled Peacedale Processing's adhesives to the Site during this period, so some portion of the 2,383,585 lbs. must be attributed to Lusha Trucking.

These facts indicate that Goditt & Boyer must have hauled less than 1 percent of the waste disposed of at the Site between 1972 and 1983. Thus, even if EPA characterizes the wastes which Goditt & Boyer hauled to the Site as containing "hazardous substances," it is beyond dispute that the volume transported by Goditt & Boyer was a de minimis amount.

Significantly, the Town of South Kingstown invoices reflect that the following entities hauled more waste to the Site than the entire amount sent there by Peacedale Processing (including the wastes hauled by Lusha Trucking) during the years it used Goditt & Boyer as a general trash hauler:

EPA never even sent information requests to some of these entities, including South County Sanitation Service, Smith's Rubbish Removal Co., Wright Away Rubbish Removal, Pier Trucking Company, Mr. Winters B. Hames, III, and Tidy-Up Inc.

The records that are available reveal the de minimis nature of Goditt & Boyer's involvement at the Site, the much more substantial involvement certain other entities appear to have had there, and the inequity of EPA's failure to issue Special Notice and the NOR to these other entities.

For example, Truk-Away of Rhode Island, Inc. (formerly Sanitas Waste Disposal of Rhode Island, Inc.) hauled over thirty-five million pounds of waste to the Site - at least 15, and probably 20 times more than what Goditt & Boyer hauled there - and EPA has no specific information as to what was contained in all that waste. Unlike WMMA, which has documentation of its customer's segregation of waste streams, Truk-Away cannot provide this information about its primary customer, URI.

As Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA suggests, a PRP is "de minimis," when the amount of hazardous substances contributed by that party to the facility is minimal in comparison to other hazardous substances at the facility, and when the toxic or other hazardous effects of the hazardous substances brought by the party to the facility are minimal in comparison to those of other hazardous substances at the facility. In light of the uncontroverted evidence that Goditt & Boyer was merely a general trash hauler, not a hazardous waste hauler, for Peacedale Processing, and transported a relatively minimal amount of waste to the Site, Goditt & Boyer should be deemed to be no more than a de minimis PRP at the Site.

5. WMMA (Goditt & Boyer) Is Not A Proper Target for EPA's NOR or Issuance of A Unilateral Administrative Order

In light of the fact that Goditt & Boyer did not select the Site and was, at most, a de minimis hauler of hazardous substances to the Site, WMMA is not an appropriate target for EPA's NOR, or for issuance of a unilateral administrative order ("UAO"). EPA's 1990 Guidance on the Issuance of UAOs for Remedial Designs and Remedial Actions ("RD/RAS") (OSWER Directive No. 9833.0-1a) provides

relevant information as to whom EPA should issue a UAO.¹⁰ Although the Directive pertains to RD/RAs, it is instructive because the principles it sets forth are equally applicable to either an RD/RA or a removal situation.

Specifically, EPA states that a UAO should be issued "based upon adequate evidence of the PRP's liability," and that evidence sufficient to support the liability of each PRP named as a respondent "needs to be in EPA's possession." OSWER Dir. No. 9833.0-1a, at 14. In the absence of any evidence that Goditt & Boyer selected the Site, EPA does not have "adequate evidence" of Goditt & Boyer's liability at the Site.

Furthermore, the Guidance states that "the Agency should consider naming the largest manageable number of parties" as respondents to the UAO, and should consider each "PRP's contribution to the Site (volume and nature of substances)" when evaluating whether to name that PRP as a respondent to the UAO. Id. at 15. This language suggests that EPA should have named numerous respondents to its NOR, and should not have selected Goditt & Boyer, at most a de minimis hauler, as one of the handful of recipients of the NOR.

In fact, EPA's own interim CERCLA municipal settlement policy, OSWER Directive #9834.13, provides that EPA's policy is to not notify as PRPs generators and transporters of municipal solid waste, unless the Region "obtains site-specific information that the MSW contains a hazardous substance;" and "the Region has reason to believe that the hazardous substance is derived from a commercial, institutional or industrial process or activity." OSWER Directive #9834.13 at 10. Generators and transporters of trash from commercial, institutional or industrial entities will not generally be notified as PRPs if they can demonstrate that:

- (a) none of the hazardous substances contained in the trash are derived from a commercial, institutional, or industrial process or activity; and
- (b) the amount and toxicity of the hazardous substances contained in the trash does not exceed that which one would expect to find in common household trash.

OSWER Directive #9834.13 at 12, 13.

¹⁰ EPA informs us that it has not yet published the document entitled "Guidance on the Issuance of CERCLA Section 106(a) Administrative Orders for Removal Actions" which is referenced in OSWER Directive No. 9833.0-1a.

EPA has not produced to WMMA site-specific evidence, if there is any, that the MSW hauled by Goditt & Boyer to the Site contained hazardous substances. WMMA submits that there is no evidence that the MSW hauled by Goditt & Boyer to the Site contained hazardous substances derived from a commercial, institutional, or industrial process or activity, and that there is no evidence to suggest that the amount and toxicity of hazardous substances (if there were any) contained in the trash hauled by Goditt & Boyer to the Site exceeded that which one would expect to find in common household trash.

Therefore, WMMA (Goditt & Boyer) is not a proper target for EPA's NOR or for issuance of a Unilateral Administrative Order.

5. EPA Should Be Seeking Information and Participation At the Site From Numerous Other Entities and Individuals

A review of the 104(e) responses provided to EPA for the Site, in conjunction with the Town of South Kingstown records, reveals serious deficiencies in EPA's investigation. In particular, EPA has failed to seek information from, and in some cases pursue, many other entities and individuals who appear from the evidence to have liability at the Site. At least some of these parties ought to be recipients of the NOR and any UAO issued by EPA at the Site. These entities and individuals fall into specific categories, as outlined below:

(a) Entities Licensed By South Kingstown To Use The Site To Whom EPA Did Not Send Information Requests

The Town of South Kingstown licensed sixty-one entities to use the Site for various times during the period 1967-1983. However, EPA only sent information requests to five of them. The entities from whom EPA never sought information include some companies whose names **actually appear in the Town of South Kingstown invoices as having disposed of wastes at the Site.** Such companies include Banks & Son, Betty Everett, Butler's Rubbish Removal, Byron W. Duffin, Jr., Charlestown Disposal Service, Daniel Turcotte, David P. Browning, Edmond O'Brien, Joy Cleanup, Francis Goodness, Kenneth Standeven, Pier Trucking Company, Richard Clark, Ron Rand Complete Home & Lawn, Salt Pond Marine Railway, Shovels and Rakes, Smith's Rubbish Removal Company, Total Service Cleaning Company, and South County Sanitation Service.

The failure to send a 104(e) request to South County Sanitation Service is particularly perplexing in light of the fact that the latter hauled 39,801,940 lbs. of wastes to the Site (approximately twenty times what Goditt & Boyer hauled), and was identified as a transporter by Palisades Industries, Inc. (a dying

and finishing company), Carbon Technology, Inc., and South County Hospital. Furthermore, South County Sanitation "Cesspool Service" was identified by Peacedale Processing as its hauler of "chemical wastes." These pieces of information warranted further investigation.¹¹

A complete list of entities who were licensed to use the Site but to whom EPA never sent information requests is submitted herewith as Exhibit "F." It is inequitable and improper for EPA to ignore all these entities and proceed against a de minimis transporter who did not select the site.

(b) Entities Licensed By Narragansett To Use The Site To Whom EPA Did Not Send Information Requests

EPA also neglected to send information requests to twenty-one entities who were licensed by the Town of Narragansett to use the Site. A list of these entities is submitted herewith as Exhibit "G." As with the entities licensed by South Kingstown, these parties should be required to provide EPA with information as to what they may have taken to the Site and from whom they collected it.

(c) Entities Invoiced By the Site To Whom EPA Did Not Send Information Requests

Not only did EPA fail to seek information from numerous entities and individuals who held licenses or permits to use the Site, but it even failed to seek information from eighty entities and individuals whom Town of South Kingstown invoices reveal disposed of wastes at the Site. The list of these entities and individuals is submitted herewith as Exhibit "H."

The record reflects no apparent basis for EPA's decision not to send 104(e) requests to these parties. EPA has neglected to follow its own guidances by not seeking to include these parties in its investigation, and has placed Goditt & Boyer in an unfair position. WMMA hereby requests that information requests be directed to all those entities and individuals listed in Exhibits "F," "G" and "H."

¹¹ An investigation at the Rhode Island Secretary of State's Office into South County Sanitation Service's corporate history reveals that South County Sanitation Service, Inc. was incorporated by Stephen A. Macera and Barbara Macera on 4/30/81 and had its name changed to S & M Disposal, Inc. on 6/22/81. On 12/28/84, S & M Disposal Inc. was merged into Macera Disposal, Inc., which was later merged into M & C Enterprises, Inc. Assets of M & C Enterprises, Inc. were sold to Browning-Ferris Industries of Rhode Island, Inc. on 7/17/87.

(d) Entities Identified in Information Responses

One of the most troubling gaps in EPA's investigation is its failure to send information requests to parties identified in other entities' information responses as PRPs. For example, Peacedale Processing's sister companies Coated Sales, Inc./Kenyon Industries, Inc. stated that South County Cesspool Service hauled their "chemical wastes," but EPA never sought information from South County Cesspool Service. Furthermore, all the Peacedale Processing entities told EPA that Peacedale Processing used Ben Luschka, or "Luscha Trucking" to haul their solid waste adhesive (which has been proven to contain trichlorethylene) to the Site, but EPA never sought information from Ben Luschka or Luscha Trucking.

In addition, South County Hospital, in its response, states that it does not believe it took hazardous substances to the Site, but does acknowledge having generated hazardous waste. The hazardous waste manifests submitted with the Hospital's Response indicate that it was generating xylene, and that after 1984 the xylene was sent to "Norlite Corp." The Hospital does not state where this material went prior to 1984. According to EPA's files, there is xylene at the Site.

Furthermore, hauler invoices submitted with South County Hospital's response indicate that it used South County Sanitation Service, Steve Macera's South County Sanitation, and Steve Macera and Sons, Inc. for disposal services. South County Sanitation Service and Macera Brothers both were invoiced by Rose Hill for disposing of wastes there. As noted above, South County Sanitation Service was never even sent an information request. Finally, in its response, the Hospital states that BFI, R.S. Liquid Disposal and DECOM Medical Waste Systems might be able to provide more detailed or complete responses to EPA's questions. Apparently, EPA never attempted to find out.

Once again, WMMA submits that EPA has an obligation to perform an adequate investigation, and that it has failed to do so. WMMA requests that EPA obtain the missing information, reassess its case, and amend its NOR accordingly.

(e) Entities Whom EPA Should Have Pursued On The Basis of Their Information Responses

In addition to South County Hospital, there are three entities whose information responses should have triggered supplemental information requests, at the very least, from EPA. It appears likely that supplemental responses, in conjunction with these parties' original responses, would have provided EPA with a basis

for issuance of Special Notice, and the NOR, to them. These parties are:

1. University of Rhode Island ("URI")

In its information response, URI admitted that it generated hazardous wastes, and expressly offered to provide EPA with manifest records indicating where its hazardous wastes were disposed. EPA appears not to have requested them. URI stated that its haulers were Truk-Away, Fox Trucking and Macera Brothers. Rose Hill Landfill invoices do reflect that Truk-Away of Rhode Island, Inc. hauled 35,203,732 lbs. of waste to the Site, and Macera Brothers hauled 384,540 lbs. there.

Unlike WMMA, neither URI, nor any of its transporters, provided evidence that URI segregated its waste streams and that only non-hazardous wastes went from URI to the Site. The South Kingstown records reflect that URI was invoiced for the disposal of 58,499,250 lbs. of waste at the Site (more than 25 times what Goditt & Boyer hauled to there), and the records reflect no basis for concluding that that waste was not hazardous.

EPA appears to have never followed up on URI's information response. That failure, as well as the failure to issue Special Notice to URI, appears to be without justification.

2. Carbon Technology ("Carbon Tech")

Carbon Tech states in its 104(e) response that it generated carbon and carbon dust, and does not know where it was disposed. Although carbon is not a hazardous substance, many carbon compounds are. EPA did not follow up with Carbon Tech to ascertain exactly what carbon compounds the latter may have generated. Since South County Sanitation Service hauled for Carbon Tech, and disposed of its wastes at the Site, EPA should have sought additional information.

3. Sherman Sanitation Service, Inc. ("Sherman Sanitation")

In its information response, Sherman Sanitation (a transporter) states that it might have transported hazardous substances to the Site. The President of the company states that Sherman Sanitation likely transported wastes including photocopy machine chemicals, household cleaning products, containers with residues and possibly petroleum or other flammable materials to the Site. In light of the fact that the Rose Hill Landfill invoices reflect that Sherman Sanitation disposed of over 2 million lbs. of wastes at the Site, EPA should have pressed the company for additional information.

(f) Non-Respondents

EPA sent 104(e) requests to the following eight entities or persons who never even bothered to respond to the information requests: (1) Dennis Jalbert Rubbish Removal; (2) Richard Drugin; (3) Thomas J. Ready; (4) Shoreline Realty Investment; (5) Thunberg Industries; (6) R & R Excavation; (7) Kingston Turf Farm; and (8) Jennings Brothers, Inc. EPA must have had a basis for sending these parties information requests in the first place, and there is no indication that that basis has been eliminated in any principled way.

Indeed, the South Kingstown invoices indicate that Dennis Jalbert Rubbish Removal hauled 4,754,410 pounds of waste to the Site and there is no information as to the generator of that waste, much less the nature of it. Similarly, Thunberg Industries was invoiced for disposing of 160,900 pounds of waste at the Site, and Richard Drugin (or Drugan) for disposing of 94,100. Unlike WMMA, none of these entities have volunteered information as to what wastes they disposed of at the Site and there appears to be no reason for their exclusion from the small group of recipients of Special Notice and the NOR. These parties ought to be pressed for information and participation, not rewarded for ignoring their obligation.

6. Conclusion

EPA's failure to state a claim against WMMA, in conjunction with the uncontroverted evidence that Goditt & Boyer did not select the Site for disposal, warrant the immediate withdrawal of the NOR that EPA issued to Waste Management of North America, Inc.

In the event that EPA declines to withdraw the NOR, WMMA requests that EPA amend its NOR to add all those entities and individuals who are identified in the Town of South Kingstown invoices as having disposed of wastes at the Site. Not only is there substantial evidence that EPA has not pursued numerous entities and individuals who appear to have disposed of more waste at the Site than Goditt & Boyer did, but there is evidence that certain entities whom EPA has not pursued, such as URI, South County Sanitation Service, and Luscha Trucking, disposed of hazardous wastes at the Site, unlike Goditt & Boyer. If the EPA insists that Goditt & Boyer -- a de minimus trash hauler that did not select the Site -- participate in the remediation, there is no conceivable excuse for not requiring these other parties to participate in the remediation of the Site.

The inadequacy of EPA's investigation has now given rise to an arbitrary and discriminatory exercise of enforcement by EPA. If EPA is going to go after non-hazardous trash haulers such as



Goditt & Boyer at the Site, it has an obligation to treat all such similarly situated haulers in a non-discriminatory, uniform manner. See United States v. Cannons Engineering Corp., 899 F.2d 79 (1st Cir. 1990).

At the very least, all those parties who were invoiced by South Kingstown for having disposing of more wastes at the Site than the amount hauled there by Goditt & Boyer ought to be recipients of the NOR. None of the 18 entities and individuals who fall within this category (see supra at Section 4), with the exception of the Town of Narragansett, were recipients of Special Notice or the NOR. This selective enforcement by EPA is inappropriate due to the uncontroverted evidence that Goditt & Boyer's involvement at the Site was as a de minimis hauler who did not select the Site.

WMMA will not volunteer to participate at a Site where EPA has not articulated a basis for WMMA's liability, and where the undisputed evidence indicates that WMMA has no liability at the Site.

1.5.2 Facility Operations and Waste Disposal Practices

Table 3 provides a chronology of activities affecting the landfill operations. At various times from 1967 to 1983, domestic and industrial wastes were disposed of at the Rose Hill Regional Landfill. In February 1973, the Towns of South Kingstown and Narragansett entered into an agreement for joint use of the solid waste disposal and sanitary landfill facilities at the Site.

The three disposal areas at the Site were closed 10 years later in 1983, but during this year, a transfer station for municipal refuse was located on the Site. It is currently active. At the transfer station, refuse is unloaded from collection trucks and transferred to vehicles which transport it off-site to the Johnston Landfill. Figure 2 shows the three disposal areas and transfer station of the Rose Hill Regional Landfill.

Waste handling procedures for Rose Hill Regional Landfill were set by state regulations and town ordinance. The waste handling practices conducted at Rose Hill included the disposal of municipal refuse as well as industrial refuse including the disposal of industrial wastes, containing hazardous substances, at the Site. The exact quantity and location(s) of hazardous substances disposed on-site throughout its operation is unknown.

In 1967, as activity at the landfill officially commenced, a court order prohibited the disposal of combustibles at Rose Hill. Later, in 1978, that decision was amended to allow the disposal of combustibles in the bulky waste area. In 1979; the State of Rhode Island ordered cities and towns to establish facilities for the collection of waste oil. It is reported that a waste oil collection facility was established during this time.

A known waste handling problem concerns the disposal of liquid waste from the Peacedale Processing Company, Inc., specifically a urethane adhesive. A letter dated January 8, 1970, transmitted from an engineer of the State Division of Solid Waste Management to the South Kingstown Director of Public Works, put into writing an agreement on the disposal method for liquid waste from the Peacedale Processing Company. The two authorities came to an understanding that the drummed waste would be disposed of daily by dumping it onto other wastes that had been deposited

there that day to take advantage of the absorptive characteristics of this material.

A year later, on March 16, 1971, correspondence sent from the same state office notified the South Kingstown Town Manager that liquid waste from Peacedale Processing was being improperly disposed of at the Rose Hill solid waste landfill. The communication reiterated that the liquid waste should be spread over the surface of the Site to allow it to be absorbed by the fill, if acceptance of such waste were to continue.

In 1979, a resident observed and reported to the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management the dumping of a number of barrels, with the lids intact, on the solid waste landfill slope within a few feet of Rose Hill Road. The truck transporting these drums on this occasion was reported to be labeled "Peacedale Processing". The resident further reported at least one barrel was labeled "slop glue". The drums were buried intact with the exception of one. It was further observed that the barrel's contents was at least in part liquid.

On December 6, 1979, the State Division of Solid Waste Management wrote to Kenyon Piece Dyeworks (a subsidiary of Peacedale Processing) to confirm an analysis of the waste adhesive procured from the Peacedale plant on November 19, 1979. The analysis revealed that the sample contained trichloroethylene at 29 parts per million (ppm), toluene (0.4 ppm), and tetrachloroethylene at 4 parts per billion (ppb). An analysis of the waste itself revealed that it contained trichloroethylene in the amount of 0.35%. Based upon the analyses, the solid waste adhesive produced at the plant was deemed not hazardous as defined by [Rhode Island] regulations and could be disposed of at any licensed solid waste management facility. The State added that the waste adhesive is to be in a solid form when taken to the landfill, exposed to the air at least a week prior to its disposal. At the same time, Kenyon Piece Dyeworks had contacted the State that the company had suspended shipment of the above-mentioned waste to the Site pending further investigation of its environmental reactivity.

Peacedale Processing notified the Environmental Protection

AFFIDAVIT OF BRUCE BUFFINGTON

I, Bruce Buffington, make the following statements upon personal knowledge:

1. I did business as "Bruce Buffington Trucking" in the 1970's and 1980's, hauling municipal solid waste ("MSW") and non-hazardous residential, commercial and industrial waste similar in nature to MSW. I hauled primarily in Rhode Island and sometimes in Massachusetts.

2. I started hauling as a sub-contractor for Goditt & Boyer, a Massachusetts hauling company, in December 1971. It was Goditt & Boyer's customary business practice to issue instructions to its sub-contractors each night, telling us from whom we should collect trash the next day. I would follow these instructions, and Goditt & Boyer paid me for this work, by the load.

3. At some point in the late 1970's I received instructions from Goditt & Boyer to collect trash from Peacedale Processing Company, Inc. ("Peacedale Processing"). Goditt & Boyer did not instruct me as to where I should dispose of Peacedale Processing's wastes.

4. On my first trip to Peacedale Processing I was instructed by Peacedale Processing to take its trash to the Rose Hill Landfill. I observed that the trash which I collected at Peacedale Processing (and Kenyon Piece Dyeworks) consisted primarily of cloth and cardboard tubes. I never observed drums in this trash. We transported the trash in compactor vehicles vehicle to the Rose Hill Landfill.

5. I did not combine any other generator's wastes with those which I transported from Peacedale Processing to the Rose Hill Landfill. As a roll-off, the job was what is known as a "dedicated load," and was never mingled with other wastes prior to disposal.

6. I did not take any wastes to the Rose Hill Landfill other than the trash I collected from Peacedale Processing.

7. I did not hold a permit for the Rose Hill Landfill, and I did not select that landfill as the site for disposal of Peacedale Processing's trash. I disposed of Peacedale Processing's wastes at the Rose Hill Landfill pursuant to the express directive of Peacedale Processing.

8. Because I did not hold a permit for disposal at the Rose Hill Landfill, and because I disposed of wastes there only at the direction of Peacedale Processing, neither I nor Goditt & Boyer was billed by the Rose Hill Landfill for these disposals.

I declare under the penalties of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed on November 18, 1992.

AFFIDAVIT OF DAVID J. BRASK

I, David J. Brask, make the following statements upon information and belief:

1. I was the President of Goditt & Boyer, Inc. ("Goditt & Boyer") a Massachusetts corporation incorporated on September 30, 1965. Goditt & Boyer became a subsidiary of Waste Systems, Inc. ("Waste Systems"), a Massachusetts corporation of which I was the Treasurer, in 1984. Waste Systems and Goditt & Boyer were acquired by Waste Management of Massachusetts, Inc., a Massachusetts corporation, on January 1, 1988.

2. Goditt & Boyer and Waste Systems were in the business of transporting municipal solid waste ("MSW") and non-hazardous residential, commercial and industrial waste similar in nature to MSW. The geographic area in which Goditt & Boyer and Waste Systems generally collected and disposed of such wastes was southeastern Massachusetts and sometimes Rhode Island.

3. Apparently, (after checking records), in 1978, Peacedale Processing Company, Inc. ("Peacedale Processing") entered into an agreement with Goditt and Boyer pursuant to which Goditt & Boyer would collect Peacedale Processing's non-hazardous trash one to three

times a week, and transport that trash for disposal at the Rose Hill Landfill in South Kingstown, Rhode Island.

4. Apparently, (after checking records), Goditt & Boyer sub-contracted the Peacedale Processing Job to Bruce Buffington, an individual doing business as Bruce Buffington Trucking.

5. Apparently, (after checking records), Goditt & Boyer did not hold a permit for the Rose Hill Landfill.

6. The customary business practice of Goditt & Boyer was that it would only select a particular site for the disposal of a customer's wastes if Goditt & Boyer held a permit allowing it to dispose of wastes at that particular site.

7. Goditt & Boyer did not select the site at which Peacedale Processing's trash was disposed.


8. If Goditt & Boyer did select the site to which a customer's wastes were transported, it was customary business practice for Goditt & Boyer to receive a bill from the landfill owner or operator for the disposal of those wastes. Goditt & Boyer would then bill the customer for the transport of the wastes and the costs associated with disposal at the landfill. In such a situation the

customer would generally not be billed directly by the landfill owner or operator.

9. Goditt & Boyer only billed Peacedale Processing for the transport of its wastes. As the business records of both Goditt & Boyer and the Town of South Kingstown reflect, Goditt & Boyer was not invoiced by the Landfill for its disposal of Peacedale Processing's trash, and Goditt & Boyer did not bill Peacedale Processing for such disposal fees.

10. Furthermore, neither I, nor Goditt & Boyer, ever selected the Rose Hill Landfill as a disposal site.

I declare under the penalties of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct upon my information and belief. Executed on November 19, 1992.
