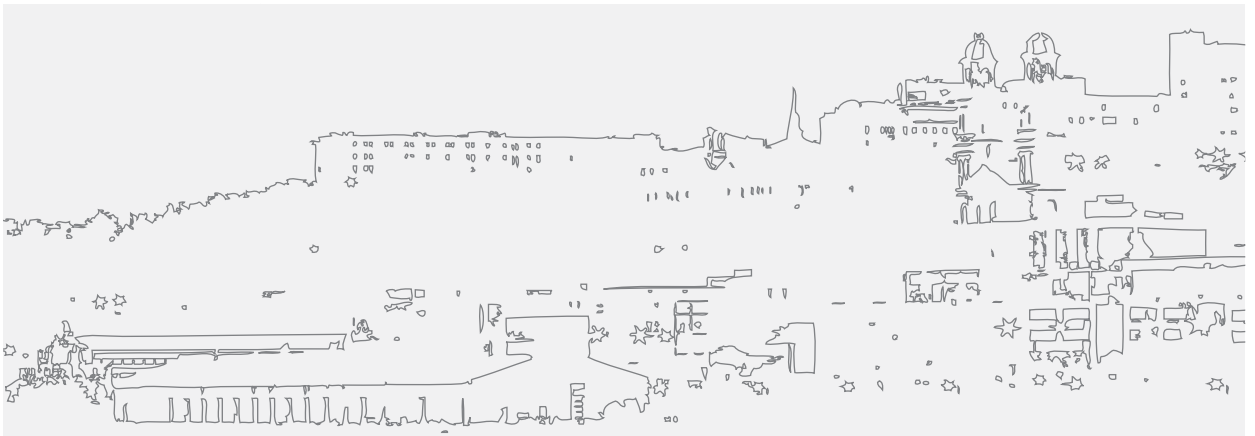

BY FOOT

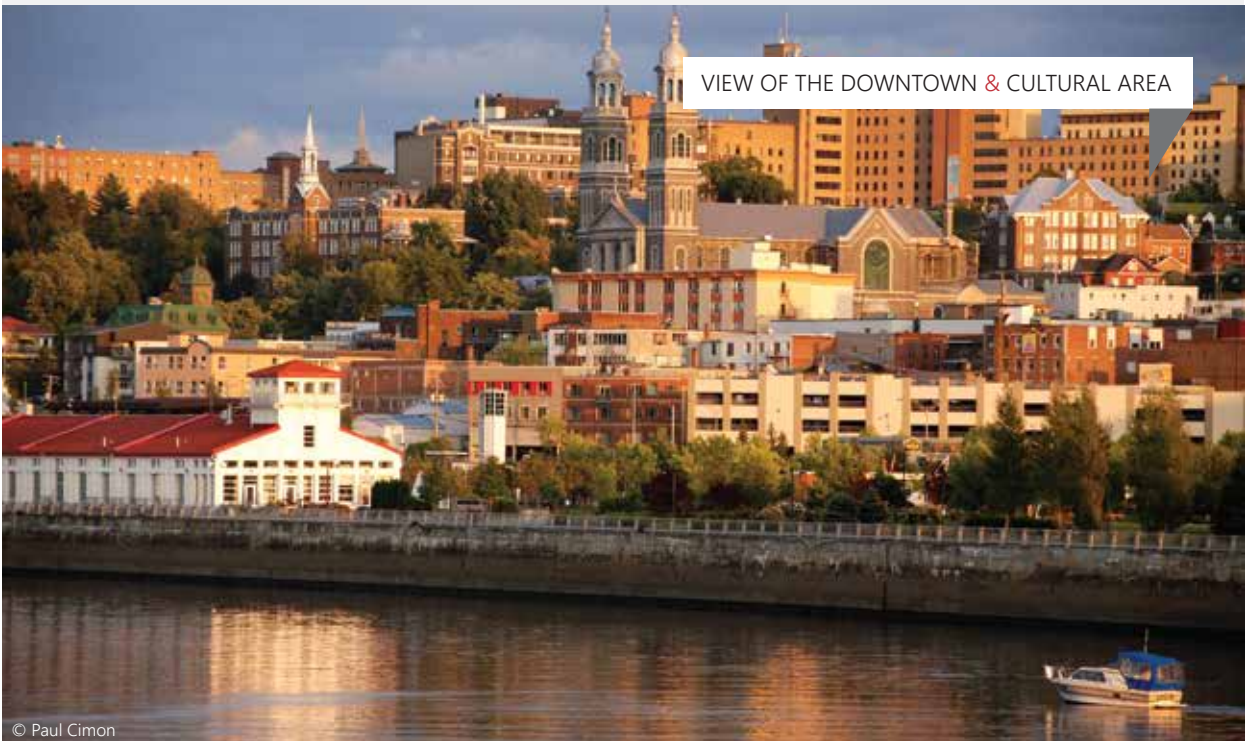

FJORD MUSEUM AREA

SAGUENAY (LA BAIE)

This area includes numerous sites and close-by must-see attractions. A few meters away from where the first settlers arrived, you will have privileged access to dive into the heart of the fjord with a visit to the museum.



MUST-SEE ATTRACTIONS

1 LE MUSÉE DU FJORD (FJORD MUSEUM)

Musée du Fjord unveils the captivating underwater world of the Saguenay Fjord. On the program: a giant aquarium, 3D multimedia presentations, a variety of exhibitions and an educational touch tank where you can interact with a variety of marine species.

2 TOUVERRE – GLASSBLowing AND GEMSTONE CUTTING ECONOMUSEUM

In the workshop of artist Giuseppe Benedetto, magic is all around you; whether it is when he blows stunning pieces from his blowpipe or, when polishing Québec gemstones. Attend a glassblowing demonstration and visit his boutique where you will be captivated by the beautifully colored works of art for sale!

3 VIEW ON THE SAGUENAY FJORD

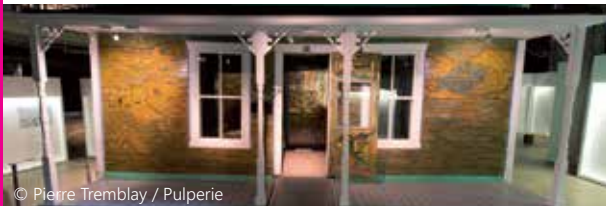

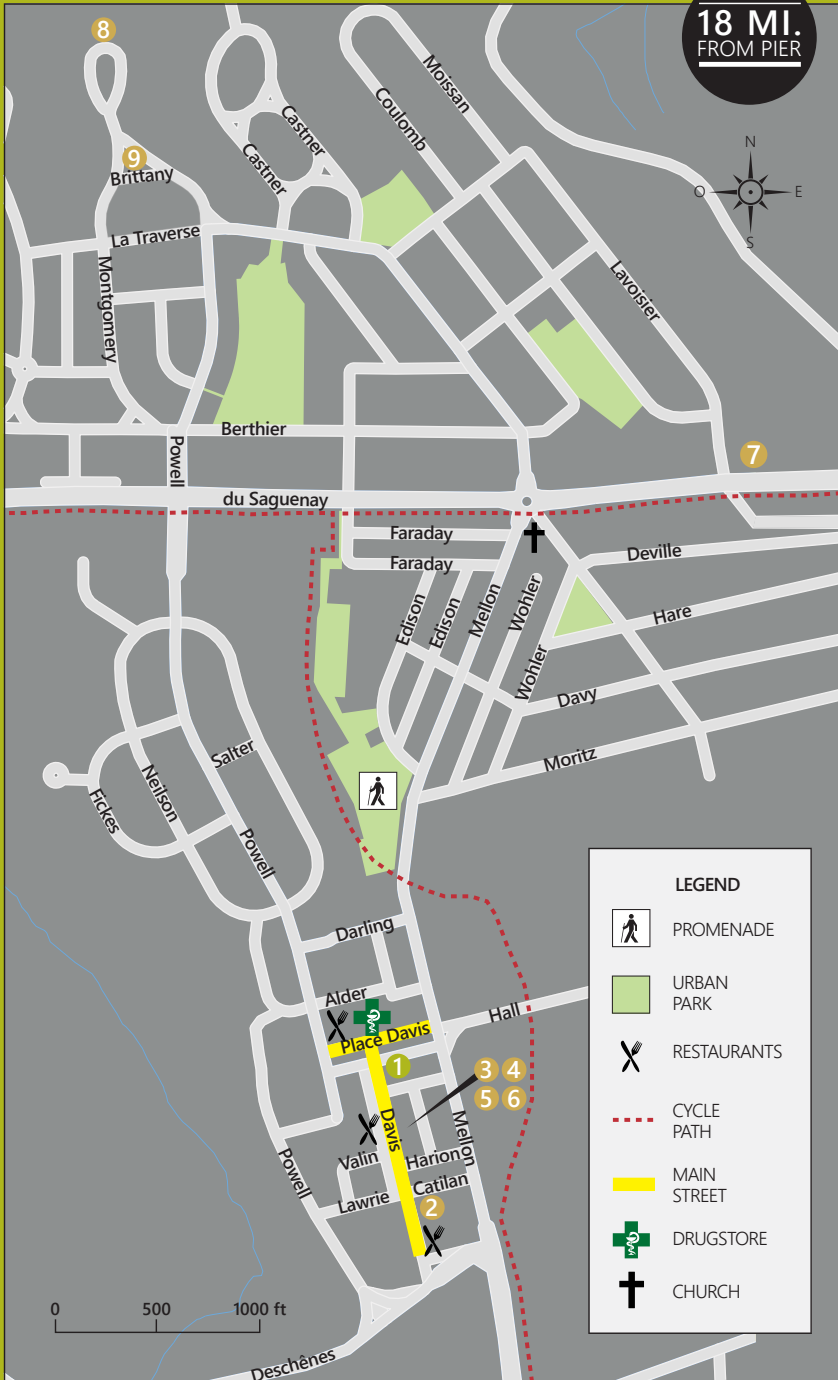

Called "The Little Washington of the North" and labelled National Historic Site of Canada, Arvida is worth the detour. Whether you're looking for a leisurely stroll or some shopping, you will be delighted by this city-town entirely built in 135 days.

1 CARRÉ DAVIS

Friendly and historical, Carré Davis offers boutiques, an awesome coffee shop and a fine grocery. A unique atmosphere created by the original facades and vintage signs. A true lesson of architecture!

When Arthur Vining Davis selected Saguenay as the location for his aluminum plant, this plaza was developed as a city center in the town now known as Arvida. In 1926, the entire company town was built in only 135 days.

Workers at Alcoa, now Rio Tinto Alcan, were fortunate to live in an environment that was specially designed for them and to work in one of the most productive aluminum manufacturing plants in the world.

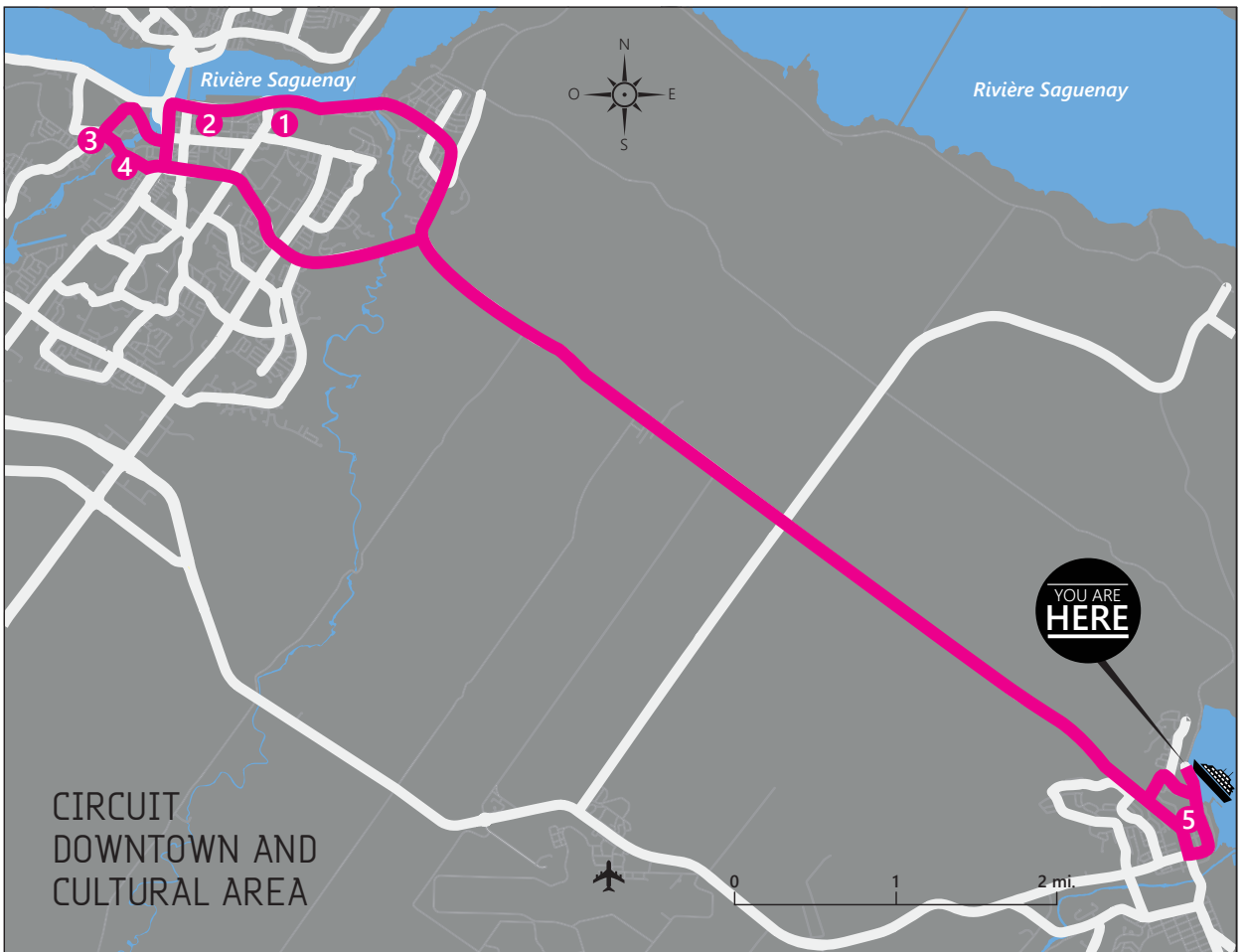
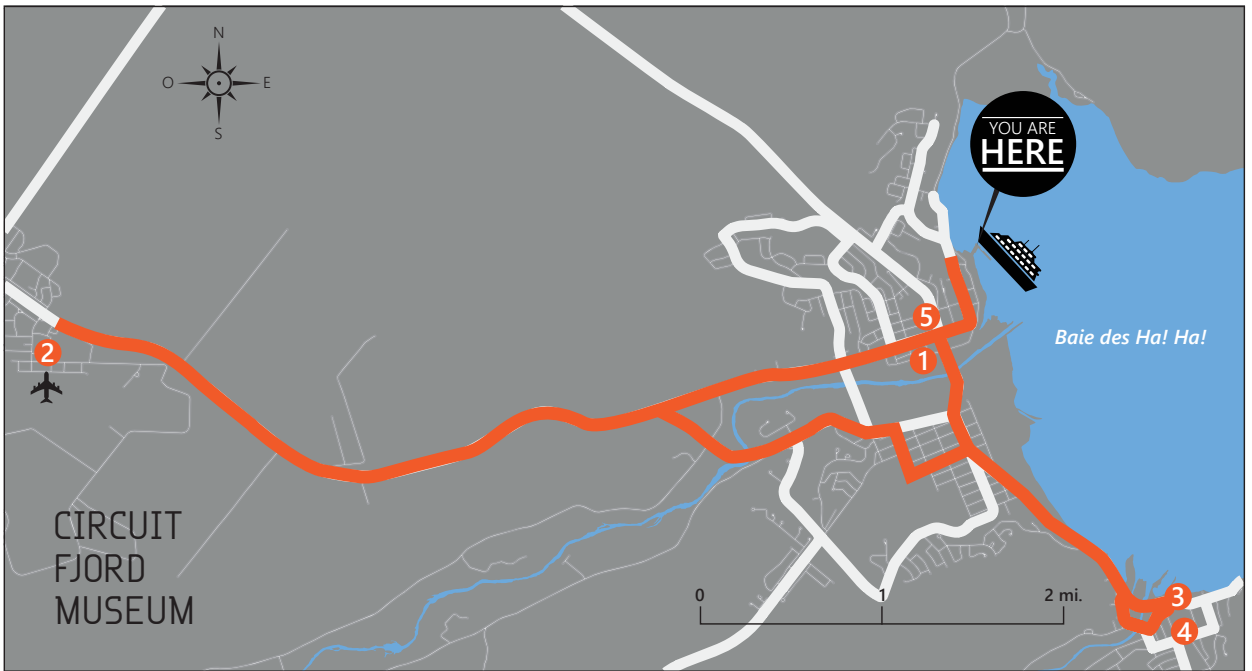

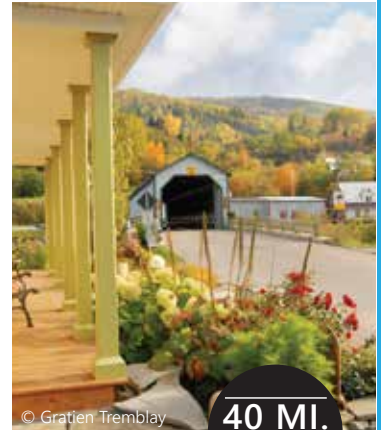

1 FJORD-DU-SAGUENAY NATIONAL PARK

Explore the paths for a short or long hike in the heart of nature with breathtaking viewpoints on the Saguenay Fjord. What about hiking up to the trail's peak to see the Notre-Dame-du-Saguenay statue? Discover the park's interpretation center and gift shop.

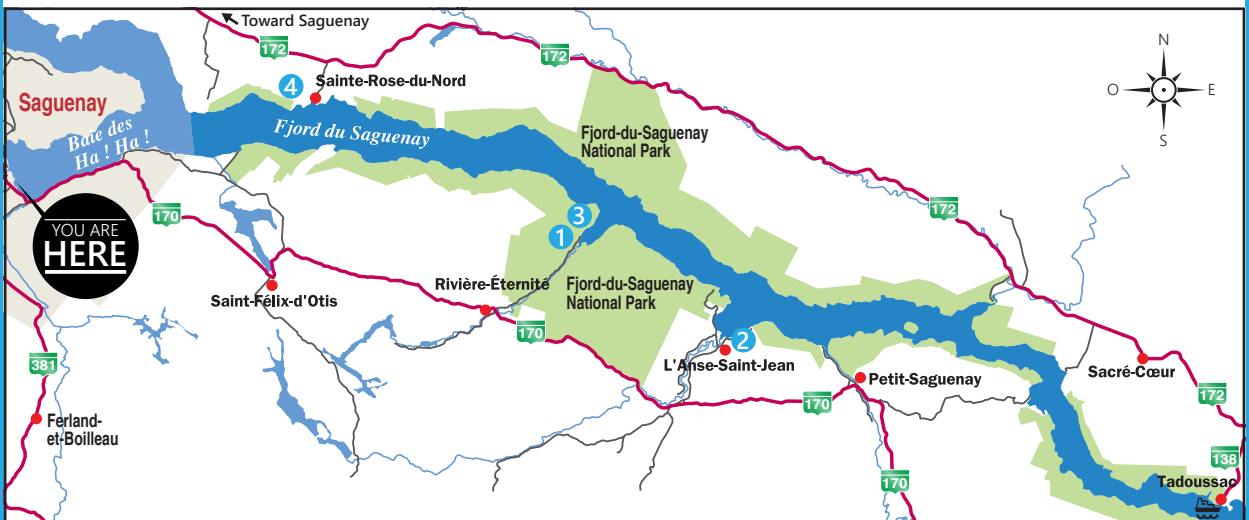
2 VILLAGE OF L'ANSE-SAINT-JEAN

Nestled between the fjord and the mountains in the back country, L'Anse-Saint-Jean is recognized by the Association des plus beaux villages du Québec (the association of the most beautiful villages in Québec). It shines throughout its historic heritage, which includes its famous covered bridge found on \$1,000 notes in the 90's. The viewpoint from L'Anse-de-Tabatière is worth the detour in itself.

There are so many ways to admire this magnificent statue towering over the fjord since 1881. By helicopter or seaplane, you can fly over the cliffs on which she stands. For the more daring types, a hiking excursion of 3 to 4 hours in the Fjord-du-Saguenay National Park will bring you at her feet. On your way back, while navigating on the fjord, be on the lookout, you will surely see her from her perch high above!


4 VILLAGE OF SAINTE-ROSE-DU-NORD

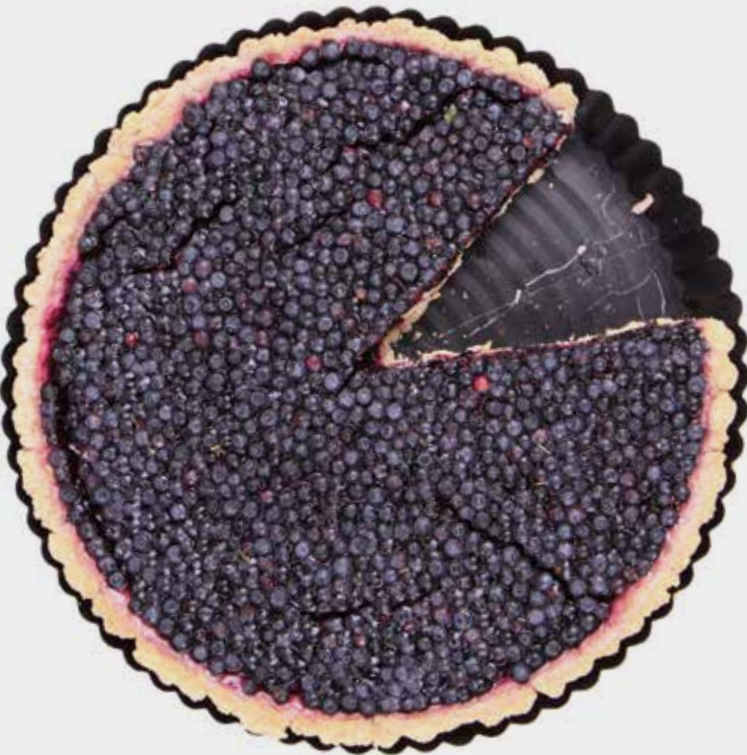

BLUEBERRY

INGREDIENTS

- 4 cups fresh Saguenay–Lac-Saint-Jean blueberries
- ½ cup water
- ⅔ cup sugar
- 2 tbsp corn starch mixed in an equal amount of water
- 1 baked 9-inch pie crust
- 1 tbsp lemon or orange zest (optional)

DIRECTIONS

Add ¾ cup fresh blueberries, ½ cup water, sugar and zest to a medium saucepan. Bring to a low boil.

Add corn starch and cook until mixture has thickened. Add the remaining 3 ¼ cups of fresh blueberries, taking care not to crush the berries.

Slowly pour mixture into a baked 9-inch pie crust.

Refrigerate for at least 2 hours.

Serve with Chantilly cream or lemon sorbet.
