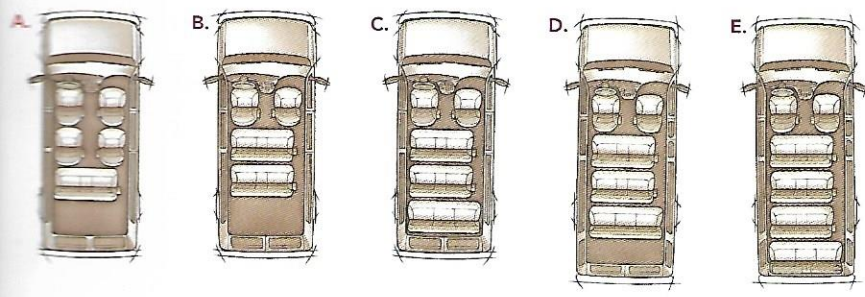
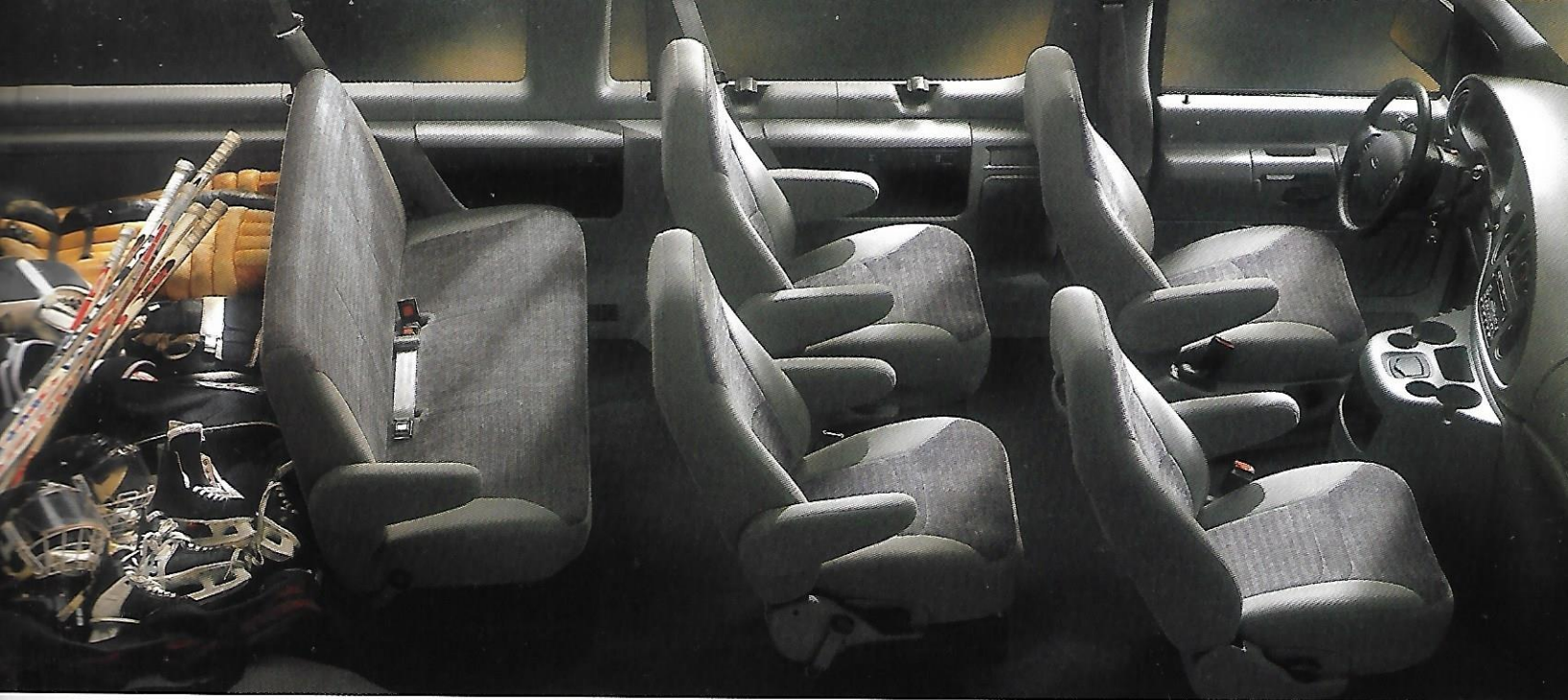

Built Ford Tough

Whether you choose a well-appointed E-150 Wagon or a more elaborate recreational luxury van, you'll be riding on a tough Ford truck chassis known for its strength and durability. It's been the solid starting point for many a family outing. After nearly 40 years of van making, we know the kind of engineering people want and expect in a vehicle that will be doing everything from taking a load of kids to the shopping center to acting as a home away from home for many, many miles.

A wide range of power

All the way from leisurely touring to heavy-duty towing, you're sure to find the right level of power to fit your situation. All Econoline engines, including the standard 4.2L V6, are capable of traveling 100,000 miles without a first scheduled tune-up (under normal driving conditions with routine fluid and filter changes). And each Econoline gasoline engine is equipped with a fail-safe cooling system to help protect itself from damage due to coolant loss.

There are three powerful Triton™ engine options to choose from when the trip calls for extra muscle: the 4.6L and 5.4L V8s, and the 6.8L V10 (a 5.4L natural-gas version is also available). They feature high-torque capability at low rpm for tenacious towing power and big payloads. These rugged Triton engines are the only overhead-cam engines available in a full-size van.

You may also choose the available 7.3L V8 Power Stroke® turbo diesel, the most powerful engine of its kind ever put into a full-size van. There aren't many things you'd want to bring along that it can't handle.

Comfortable cruising

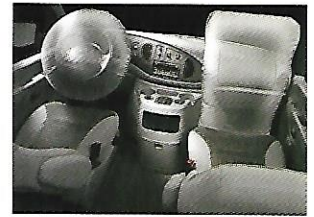
Econoline is designed for taking to the road in comfort, with conveniences like a 12-volt powerpoint, interval wipers and a selection of audio systems. The instrument panel is ergonomically designed for easy location of instruments and controls. Front safety belts are individually height-adjustable. Front air conditioning is standard. And Econoline can be outfitted with a variety of seating arrangements to suit the needs of your family.

Safety on the road

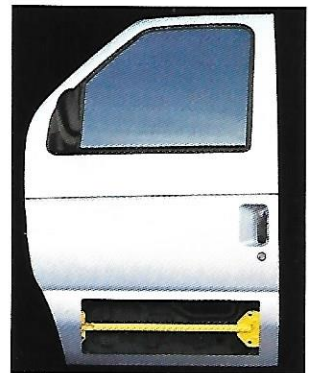
Because every day isn't sunny and every road isn't smooth, Econoline is designed to help you deal with the unexpected. An excellent view of the road is the result of the high, "command" seating position. Driver and passenger airbags and side door intrusion beams are standard occupant protection features. To help drivers avoid accidents, a four-wheel anti-lock braking system is standard on wagons and luxury vans. It provides greater steering control while braking under most conditions, even on wet or slippery surfaces. In addition, four-wheel disc brakes are standard on E-350 Super Duty Wagons to help handle extra loads like trailers. And for an extra measure of security, the available Remote Keyless Entry System includes a remote transmitter that locks and unlocks doors and turns on interior lights from a safe distance.

Luxury vans

As spacious and comfortable as the E-150 Wagon is, Econoline is also a popular choice for conversion to plush, yet practical, recreation luxury vans. Your Ford Dealer probably has a number of these specialized
