## Benefits of using transit

**Environmental benefits:**

- Transit reduces greenhouse gas emissions
- On average, one passenger-kilometre traveled on transit produces 76 grams of CO2 whereas one person-kilometre traveled by an urban automobile produces 254 grams, or more than 3 times as much
- Transit reduces air pollution, thus contributing to better health
- On average, each automobile emits 4 tonnes of pollutants each year, while buses emit significantly fewer nitrous oxides, volatile organic compounds and carbonyl monoxide per passenger-kilometre compared to a car

**Economic benefits:**

- Transit reduces traffic congestion
- Based on average occupancy level: a single bus replaces 40 cars and one commuter train replaces 15 lanes of traffic
- Transit positively affects the value of nearby residential property
- Transit supports rational land-use planning by balancing density and green spaces
- Transit contributes to the international competitiveness of our cities and communities, by being a crucial link in inter-modal transportation

**Social benefits:**

- Transit is one of the safest ways to travel in our cities with the lowest injury and fatality rates of any urban transport mode
- Transit fosters social inclusion by contributing to the physical mobility of disadvantaged groups, young or elderly people and those with physical or economic challenges
- Transit promotes creative development by providing high quality access and mobility in inner-city neighbourhoods where cultural activities are concentrated

## Sports and Recreation

Our city has a proud history of sporting and recreation, and that legacy speaks to why Brantford is known as the "Tournament Capital of Ontario." World-class facilities provide the perfect spot for tournaments for sports such as hockey, soccer, lacrosse, swimming and more. The Wayne Gretzky Sports Centre has been the primary sports and leisure facility in Brantford for over 40 years and welcomes over a million visitors annually. With over 70km of natural trails to hike, run or bike along the Grand River and Carolinian landscape, Brantford is the Hub of Ontario Trails. Well-maintained rail trails connect you with Brant, Hamilton, Port Dover, Cambridge and beyond, making Brantford the perfect home base for your next trail adventure. On any given weekend throughout the year, athletes and sports fans alike will find many sports-related events and recreational activities taking place in the area.

Courtesy Seating is intended to provide additional seating for customers who will benefit from having a seat near the front of the vehicle including seniors, expectant mothers, adults traveling with infants or small children, or any other passenger who may benefit from a seat closer to the front of the bus. If you are sitting in one of these designated seats, please respect its purpose and give up your seat to those who are in greater need of it.

## Arts, Culture and Heritage

Experience Brantford's vibrant arts and culture scene, where past and present meet to create endless possibilities.

A walk through the Brant Avenue Heritage District offers a tour of several public art monuments including "Hope" at the Children's Memorial Garden in St. Andrew's Park. Head downtown for the Joseph Brant Monument (1886) that features bronze figures representing each of the Six Nations, the Bell Memorial (1917) that honours the work of Alexander Graham Bell, and the Brant War Memorial (1933) that pays tribute to those who served in WWI, WWII, the Korean War, and in Afghanistan. Visitors to the Wayne Gretzky Sports Centre will enjoy "The Great One" sculpture, which features a young Wayne with his parents looking up at an adult Wayne hoisting the Stanley Cup, followed by a visit to the Brantford & Area Sports Hall of Recognition. History buffs will love a visit to one of the many area museums and galleries including the Canadian Military Heritage Museum, Glenhyrst Art Gallery of Brant, Woodland Cultural Centre, Bell Homestead National Historical Site, and more.
