1. [redacted] Comment. Ammunition shipments to the USSR. The shipment to Justerbog was reported previously by another source as consisting of 34 cars. [redacted] 25X1
2. [redacted] Comment. Connected with grain imports from the USSR to East Germany.
3. [redacted] Comment. It could not be determined whether these cars were newly manufactured equipment for the USSR or whether they were dispatched there for butter shipments to East Germany.
4. [redacted] Comment. An ammunition and ordnance depot of the First Gds Mecs Army is located at Roederau.
5. [redacted] Comment. Possibly deactivated ambulances which were returned to the USSR.
6. [redacted] Comment. This shipment is probably identical with a shipment which was reported previously by another source [redacted] 25X1
7. [redacted] Comment. Deliveries by East German hydrogenation plants to the USSR.
8. [redacted] Comment. From the [redacted] dispatching stations it is inferred that these trains carried uranium ore to the USSR. 25X1
9. [redacted] Comment. Deliveries by the hydrogenation plant in Boehlen to the large Soviet fuel depot in Velten.
10. [redacted] Comment. Probably a supply shipment to the depot of the Twenty-Fourth Air Army in Biesenthal.
