Agency History:

Harris County, in its ongoing efforts to scrutinize numerous permit applications for hazardous waste facilities, filed suit in the 331st Judicial District Court in Travis County, Texas, against the Texas Water Commission for its issuance of a permit for Houston Chemical Services, Inc. Houston Chemical Services, Inc. applied to the Texas Water Commission to construct and operate a commercial hazardous and industrial waste incineration facility in a previous Quaker Oaks plant off Fairmont Parkway near the City of La Porte in East Harris County. The Hearings Examiner recommended that the permit application be denied based on design problems, siting problems, waste analysis problems, operating financial assurance uncertainties, and uncertainties about air emissions. Harris County Attorney Mike Driscoll, an advocate for clean air, saw issues with air pollution not addressed in the original application. The hearing began on October 11, 1988, and concluded on February 9, 1990. The Texas Water Commission granted approval for the permit on October 10, 1990, with the recommended revisions to the application. A joint motion for rehearing was filed by Harris County and the City of La Porte on November 6, 1990. The motion was denied and the original ruling stood.
