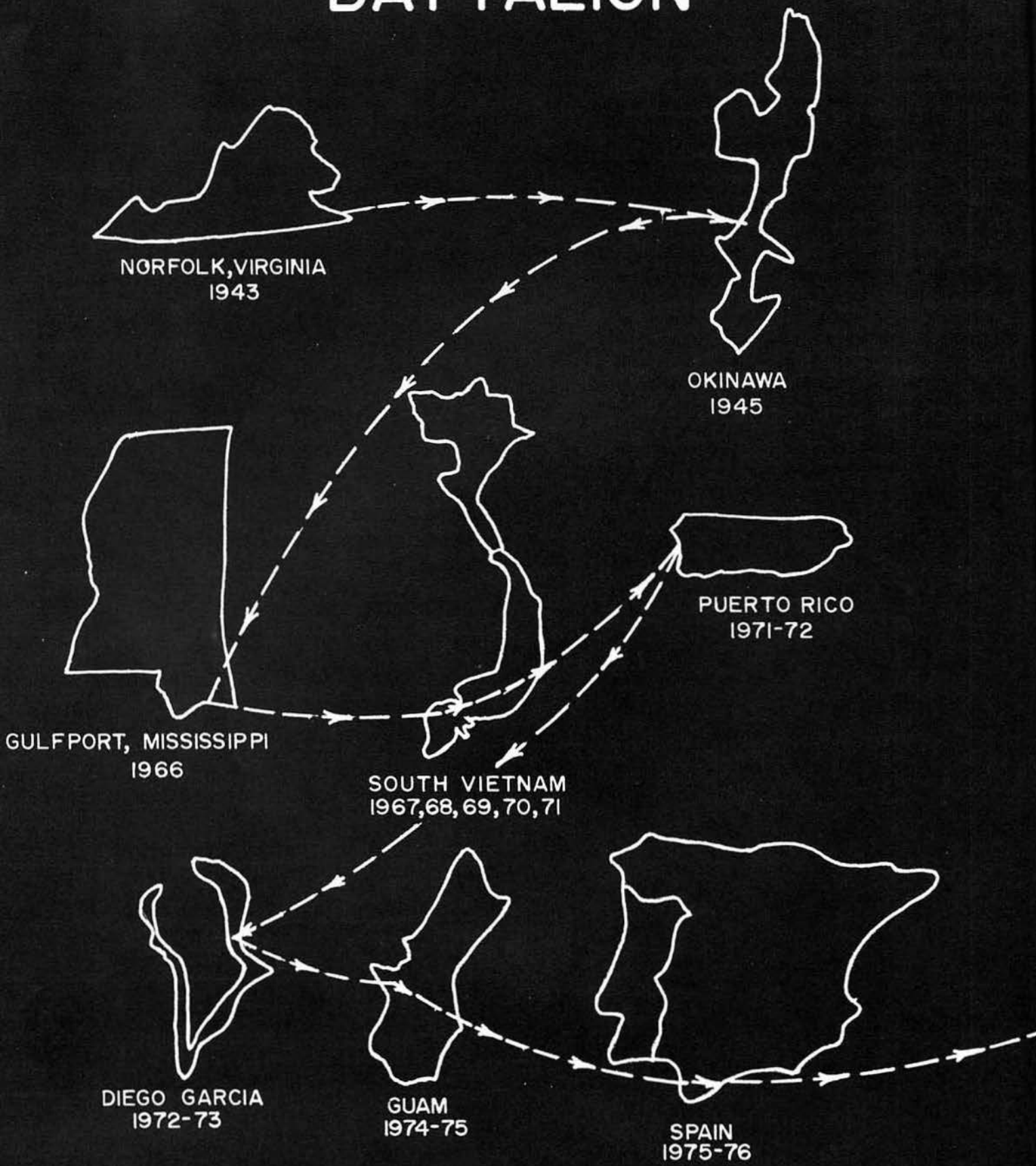

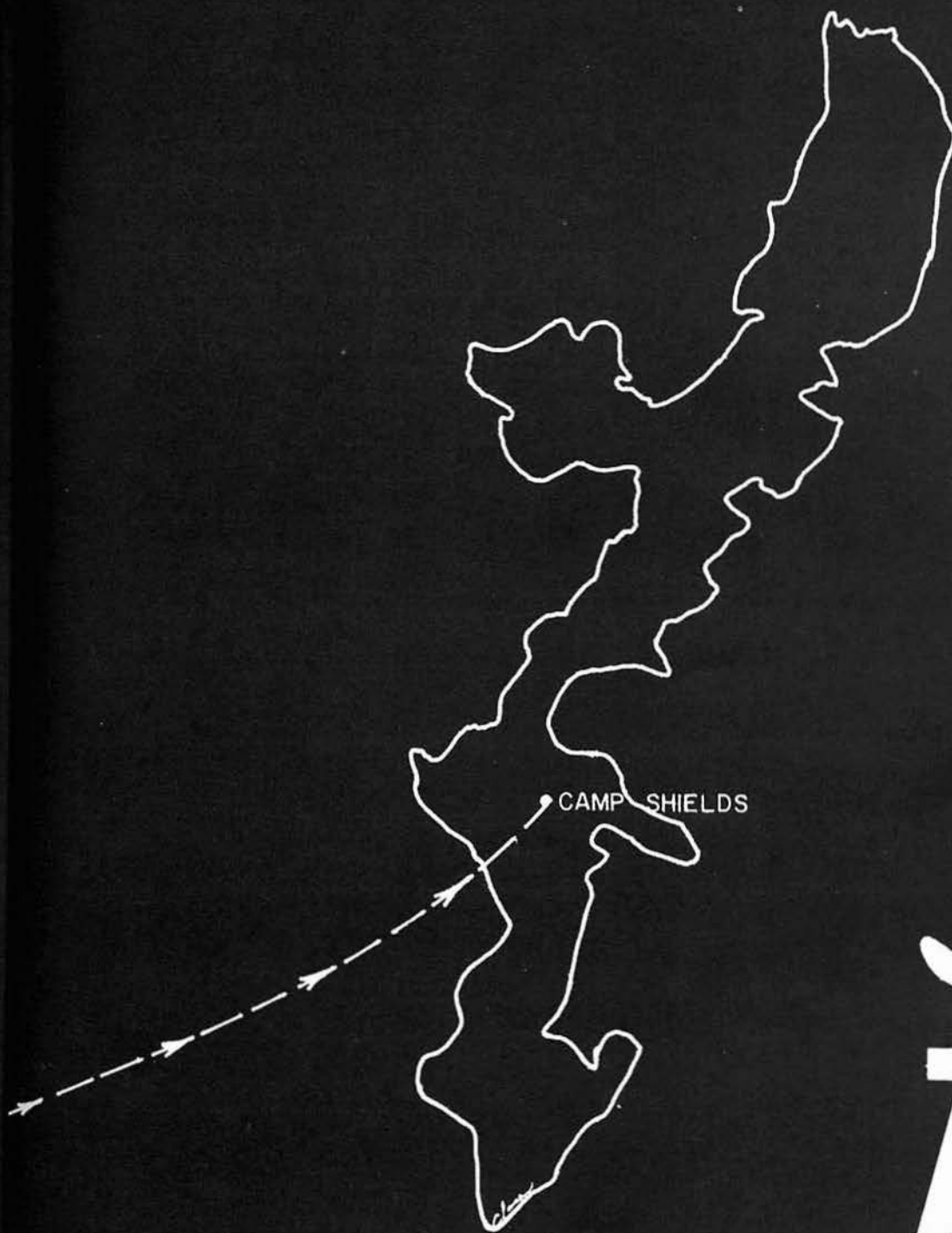

Commander Arthur W. Fort, a native South Carolinian is the sixth Commanding Officer of *U.S. NAVAL MOBILE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION SEVENTY-FOUR* since its recommissioning. He received his commission as Ensign, Civil Engineer Corps, from the NROTC Unit, Auburn University, following graduation with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering. Subsequent education has included attendance at Stanford University (MSCE), the University of Pittsburgh and the Armed Forces Staff College. He is a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Mississippi.

His previous Seabee duty was with *NMCB TEN*, where he served as Operations Officer and Executive Officer during the Vietnam conflict, taking part in deployments to Quang Tri and Camp Evans.

Public Works assignments have included the Marine Corps Air Station, Cherry Point, N.C.;



Naval Ordnance Test Unit, Patrick AFB, FL; and Naval Air Station, Cecil Field, FL, where he also was Resident Officer in Charge of Construction.

Commander Fort has held staff assignments in the Bureau of Naval Personnel; the Bureau of Yards and Docks; Chesapeake Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command; and the Staff of the Military Assistant to the President of the United States. His last assignment prior to assuming command of *NMCB SEVENTY-FOUR* on 30 July, 1976, was head of the Acquisition Department, Northern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command.

Awards include the Bronze Star Medal with Combat "V" and Gold Star in lieu of second award, Meritorious Service Medal, Navy Commendation Medal and the Army Commendation Medal.

Commander Robert B. Bell, Jr., took over as Battalion Executive Officer in October 1975, midway through the European Deployment. CDR Bell was born and raised in Chicago but now calls South Texas home. He graduated from Marquette University in 1961 with a Bachelor of Civil Engineering degree. At that same time, he was also commissioned as Ensign in the Navy's Civil Engineer Corps. In 1967 he received a Master of Civil Engineering degree from Stanford University. He is a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Texas.

Following commissioning and orientation at the Civil Engineer Corps Officer School (CECOS) in Port Hueneme, Calif., CDR Bell reported to *NMCB ELEVEN* where he served as Admin Officer, "C" Company Commander, and Officer in Charge of one of the early Seabee Teams, *STAT 1101*, which deployed to northeastern Thailand in 1963-1964. His next assignment was as Resident Officer in Charge of Construction, Boston Area in 1964-1966, followed by duty under instruction at Stanford in

1966-1967, and an assignment as Assistant Base Development Officer, CINCPACFLT Staff, Hawaii, in 1967-1969. In Vietnam during 1970, he was back with the Seabees as Officer in Charge of CBPACDETRVN, the Seabee Team Headquarters for Southeast Asia. That was followed by a three year tour in Texas as Assistant Public Works Officer, Naval Air Station, Corpus Christi. Prior to reporting to the Battalion, CDR Bell was the Resident Officer in Charge of Construction, Gulfport Area, and was responsible for construction contracts at NCBC Gulfport, Keesler AFB, and the Naval Home.

CDR Bell has been awarded the Bronze Star Medal with Combat "V", the Navy Commendation Medal, the Combat Action Ribbon, and the Meritorious Unit Citation with one bronze star. He has also received the National Defense Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with one silver star, Vietnam Armed Forces Meritorious Unit Citation (Civil Actions), the Vietnam Campaign Medal and Expert Rifle and Pistol Medals.
