



# Powerful, comfortable, mobile — electric

Titan UTV rethinks the electric vehicle from batteries to bucket seats

Innovation is what drives Shane Wilson's business, Titan UTV.

The president of the Hutto-based company is part of the emerging electric vehicle industry. An electrical engineer and avid bow hunter, Wilson welcomes the challenge of building a better vehicle by pushing innovative design rather than relying on what's out there.

He says most electric 4x4 builders have tended to take the ubiquitous golf cart model and modify it for hunters. What Titan has done is to engineer its vehicles from the ground up — beginning with its tubular frame and undercarriage — by using off-road racing technology. Others followed this design in 2009.

His vehicles are designed to meet

the needs of hunters who want that extra power to tromp through fields, mud and brush.

His popular Titan Scout 4x4 Electric Vehicle, for example, is a quiet, powerful vehicle that offers such features as four-wheel independent suspension, an independent coil over shock system, four-wheel hydraulic disc brakes, dual controllers and rack and pinion steering. Its high-output dual motors and controllers generate Best in Class horsepower (up to 54 hp). Speaking of first to market with innovation, the Scout Series will have an optional dual motor-dual controller AC drive system. This offers another maintenance-free solution for customers.

"AC is the way of the future for

electric vehicles, and we wanted to be the first to offer this," Wilson said.

Since his company began making the vehicles three years ago, it has proven to be popular among hunters. So popular that Titan will change its name to Titan EV (Electric Vehicle) in 2010 to better reflect the diversification of its product portfolio.

As of 2010, the company will offer six different models, including the new Explorer Series unveiled recently.

"I think the Explorer will be our best-selling vehicle," Wilson said.

The new Explorer LSV is the first electric vehicle that offers a four-speed transmission. What the manual transmission will do, Wilson said, is offer better maneuverability

on rough off-road terrain.

The LSV has plenty of torque and power. And it's a spacious buggy with four bucket seats, all of which face forward. Plus, it has a rear bed for storage. The Explorer LSV, which can travel about 45 miles per charge in smooth driving conditions, sells for \$14,800, fully-loaded.

The Explorer LSV is available in two-wheel drive, with the release of a four-wheel drive model planned for August 2010.

"But don't let the two-wheel drive discourage you," Wilson said. "This vehicle has more torque and horsepower than any other on the market."

Titan also offers an optional solar panel that can be mounted on the

electric UTV to extend the driving time up to 20 percent per day.

And, because electric vehicles tend to be all about the battery, Wilson will have AGM batteries in all his 2010 vehicles. He is also looking into lithium ion battery technology in his search for more efficient batteries.

# Lazzeroni rifles are powerful, reliable

Company brings advances in ammunition, firearms to big-game hunting

It was a hand-drawn sketch of a cartridge that sparked the birth of the Lazzeroni Arms Company.

In 1994, John James Lazzeroni drew a design of what is now the Lazzeroni proprietary cartridge on a white piece of paper. Based on that sketch, he had a run of brass cases made to his specifications. He liked what he saw and shortly after started his Tucson, Ariz., arms company to produce his long magnum proprietary cartridges.

A year later, Lazzeroni, who had been building custom rifles based upon Weatherby actions since 1988, introduced the Lazzeroni 2000 series bolt-action hunting rifles to handle his new lineup of Lazzeroni calibers.

Today, Lazzeroni makes long magnum cartridges, short magnum cartridges, LazerHead copper bullets and, of course, continues to expand his premium hunting rifle line.

"The goal of Lazzeroni has always been to build the finest bolt-action hunting rifles in the world, shooting the fastest cartridges available in their respective calibers," says Lazzeroni.

"Our product lineup today has evolved into something very special, something that comes along only once in a generation."

One product that has attracted a lot of attention in the hunting community is the Lazzeroni Global Hunter rifle, which is available in six models.

Based on Lazzeroni's standard long-action rifle (the L2000ST), the Global Hunter mountain rifle features a precision CNC-machined 17R stainless steel receiver, a stainless steel, match-grade button-barrel and a super-crisp Jewel competition trigger. The metalwork is finished with electroless nickel to withstand harsh weather. A diamond-fluted bolt shaft replaces the previous helical fluting, and the firing pin is now made out of titanium to reduce weight and firing pin lock time.

What hunters really appreciate is that

this gun weighs about 2 pounds less than its predecessor. The short-magnum model (the L2005SLT), for example, weighs 6.1 pounds. The long-magnum (the L2005LLT) comes in at slightly more than 7 pounds. Both have a new slim line graphite-composite stock and precision-machined aluminum-alloy floorplate/trigger guard assembly.

Whatever the model, these guns — which start at \$4,500 — are superbly crafted firearms that are wicked accurate. For an idea of what to expect from his maximum velocity ammunition, go to [www.lazzeroni.com](http://www.lazzeroni.com) and scan the

ballistics table under the appropriate cartridge.

Lazzeroni has a reputation in the industry for being a perfectionist — not a bad quality for a gunmaker to possess.

Perhaps the strongest compliment that can be paid to a manufacturer with Lazzeroni's exacting standards came from hunter and author Craig Boddington in a 2005 article he wrote for *Rifle Shooter* magazine: "John Lazzeroni's products do exactly what he says they will do ... There is no blue sky — none — in his published velocity figures for his cartridges.

"And, I've never had a problem getting the accuracy out of his rifle that he has stated I should."

**Tahr and chamois:** Hunted April through September, these species rut between about May

and early July. This is when they are in their full winter coats. Tahr and chamois are hunted either on foot or by using the helicopter to access the hunting area on their 100,000-acre concession on the South Island's Southern Alps. Mike recommends that clients who want to hunt on foot out of tent camps budget at least five days for their excursion.

**Ducks:** The season for paradise ducks and Canada geese is from Feb. 20 to March 31 (Limit of 25 on ducks; no limit on geese). The season for mallard, grey, and paradise ducks as well as black swan and pheasant is from the

first Saturday in May to the last Sunday in July. (Limit of 50 on a mixed bag of ducks and five swans.)

Prices for the hunts will vary depending on length of stay and the trophy sought. For a quote on a hunt, contact Mike or Deborah at [info@huntingnewzealand.co.nz](mailto:info@huntingnewzealand.co.nz) or 011 64 3 319 5189.

# Stunning firearms to see and to shoot

Turnbull turns out restored guns that retain beauty, use

Gun aficionados who browse through the pages of the Doug Turnbull Restoration catalog will see images of beautiful vintage firearms: a Winchester Model 1876 Centennial Rifle with delicate checkering and a mottled jewel-tone finish, a Colt single-action Bisley revolver with its distinctive period finish and fancy walnut grips, an elaborately embellished Parker Bros. single-barrel shotgun, plus much more.

After being meticulously restored at upstate New York's Doug Turnbull Restoration, these pictured firearms look much like they would have looked when they were first sold.

Working from a 7,000-square foot building in Bloomfield, N.Y., Turnbull and his talented staff of craftsmen don't miss a detail as they painstakingly restore family heirlooms and collectible rifles, shotguns and handguns.

"Proper metal preparation, coupled with our case-coloring process and bluing techniques allow today's shooter the opportunity to actually see and hold a gun that appears just as it did when it left the factory a hundred years ago," says Turnbull via his company Web site.

Turnbull learned his craft early in life. He grew up working at his parents' Creek Side Gun Shop.

In 1983, he began his firearms restoration business and soon gained a reputation in the industry for his case coloring. As a young man, Turnbull had become fascinated with the brilliant mottled jewel tones on older Parker and Winchester receivers.

He experimented for years to duplicate the original process that would not only yield

those vibrant hues but also harden the parts so they wouldn't wear out from use.

Once Turnbull perfected the case coloring process, he began emulating early gun makers' practice of painstakingly polishing the metal until it achieved sharp crisp edges and perfectly flat surfaces.

It is with that diligence for authenticity that he and his staff arm themselves to tackle their projects.

But, for Turnbull, restoring those vintage Winchester lever-action rifles and Marlin rifles simply so that they could be admired wasn't enough. Turnbull also has designed proprietary 470 and 475 rifle cartridges. The new 475 cartridges can be used in vintage or modern Winchester 1886 or 71 lever-action rifles while the 470 cartridges are for the modern Marlin model 1895 or 336 rifles. These cartridges deliver modern ballistic performance for sportsmen who want to shoot or hunt with their vintage firearms.

The 475 Turnbull cartridge has been used by hunters to harvest such big game as elk, bear, Cape buffalo and elephant.

Turnbull himself set off to Tanzania in 2008 with his Winchester Model 1886 chambered in the 475 Turnbull. He bagged eight different species of African plains game, including a black wildebeest, a gemsbok and a black jackal.

He also used that same rifle and ammo on hunting trips to Montana and Alaska and compiled his hunts on the "Magnum Hunt Club DVD" (\$20).

It is a good chance to see what a vintage firearm coupled with modern ammunition can accomplish.



# Exotic animals, familiar location at Y.O.

## History runs deep at 'America's Original Game Ranch' in Texas

The Y.O. Ranch has been a graceful presence in the heart of Hill Country for well over a century. Since Capt. Charles Schreiner founded the ranch in the late 1880s, six generations of Schreiners have tended this beautiful and rugged land.

The ranch, located 40 miles west of Kerrville, has thrived during good times and has survived the hard times.

It was during one of the not-so-good times that the canny widow Myrtle Schreiner, who took the ranch's reins in 1933, started leasing some of her lands to hunters. In the years since, several other Texas ranchers have followed suit, but the widow gave the Y.O. a healthy head start in building an international reputation as a superior hunting ranch.

When her son Charles Schreiner III took over in the 1950s, he built up a herd of Longhorns, which were then facing extinction, and introduced exotic species of wildlife to the rolling hills of the Y.O. During the 1980s, Louie Schreiner forged the ranch's reputation as "America's Original Game Ranch."

Today, 19 members of the Schreiners, led by managing partner Charles Schreiner IV, run the ranch. They are credited for setting new standards in outdoor adventure and hospitality.

The Y.O., a working ranch spanning 40,000 acres, is home to more than 1,000 Longhorns, the rangy cattle breed that was the foundation of the empire the first Schreiner built. The 60-square-mile



ranch also is the adopted home of more than 10,000 animals, including 50 species of such exotics as antelope, impala, blackbuck, waterbuck, Oryx, giraffe and ostrich.

More than 20 of those exotic species originally found in North Africa, China and Europe can be hunted, as can trophy native wildlife. The Hill Country's Edwards Plateau is home to some of the largest white-tailed deer herds and Rio Grande turkey populations. It is not uncommon to see 50 to 100 bucks in a single day.

It is the availability of these trophy animals coupled with the Schreiner hospitality that attracts big game hunters from across the U.S. and from all over the world. The ranch also attracts Texans who want to hunt exotic species without leaving the comfort of their home state.

Hunters will have access to experienced guides who will help them



enjoy a challenging fair-chase hunt in a politically stable environment. During their visit, they will stay in an 1880s-style log cabin and enjoy Hill Country cooking at the Y.O. Chuckwagon.

Lodging and meal fees are \$160 per day, with the guide fees running \$300 per day plus gratuity. The trophy fees differ, depending on the species being
