The Bar Has Been Raised

his is our 17th annual Insider's Guide to Monterey Car Week. It's your onestop source of info about the what, the where and the when of all the events taking place this week.

No matter how many times we go to Monterey, each year feels different. This year, all the talk concerns a recent hammer price of \$143m. Not for a painting or a sculpture. Or a private island with a jet, two helicopters and a yacht.



1955 300SLR Uhlenhaut Coupe

A car. A famous car, but a car, nonetheless. Mercedes-Benz auctioned one of two 1955 300SLR Uhlenhaut Coupes, setting a new record for the most valuable car ever sold.

With this sale of one of its crown jewels – for a staggering amount – the collector-car market was served two notices.

First, anything may be for sale at some time, at some price. Nothing is off the table.

Second, once you have seen someone spend that kind of money for a car, it legitimizes you or your fellow collectors spending that much or more.

As a rising tide lifts all boats, I expect that we will see 300SL Gullwings, a distant relative to the record-setting Mercedes, earn ever higher bids. More cars should top \$2m, up from the \$1.2m-\$1.5m range that non-alloy cars have been valued at. In fact, don't be surprised if you see such prices achieved during Monterey Car Week, as this trend began even before the Uhlenhaut Coupe sale.

This is just one of the things we will be watching for as we cover all the sales that make Monterey the leading barometer of the collector car market.

Each of the auction companies are back in action, with a new kid on the block as well.

The traditional heavyweights of Gooding & Company, RM Sotheby's, Bonhams and Mecum Auctions have been joined by Broad Arrow Auctions. There will be more high-quality cars on offer than ever before.

In addition, the online sector of the market continues to heat up, with fierce competition among new and established companies competing for consignments and bidders.

Monterey may not be known for its bargains, but it is where you will find more interesting, high-quality collectible cars for sale in one place at one time, than anywhere else on earth.

Like an intrepid tracker, use this guide to help you locate exactly what you want. When you find it, start bidding. If it is truly the car of your dreams, don't put your paddle down until it is yours.



So You Want to Collect Race Cars?

Consider these factors before you cross the finish line

R acing cars are an interesting and occasionally weird subset of the car-collecting hobby, and their desirability and value are subject to a set of axioms that become apparent after you have been in the business for a while. Many match qualities that apply to street collectibles, but some are specific. My purpose is to lay out some of the more basic ones for those of you who might be unaccustomed to this side of the hobby.

Note that I am focusing on just the collector side, not the "weapons" considerations that are more important if you intend to go out and race your toys.

Collector values are all about what makes one car more special than another, thus creating a sort of ranked hierarchy from the extremely valuable to the ordinary. The following are factors to consider.

History, history, history

The entire purpose of building a racing car is to win, and the ones that have won are, by definition, the most desirable. Knowing the complete racing history of a car is crucial.

 Where something won matters: The more important the event, the more important the win.
 Le Mans is the ultimate, followed by the Mille Miglia, then FIA
 World Championship venues.
 Except for Daytona and Sebring, American races don't count so much unless you are specifically collecting those cars.



- Podium finishes count, but not like a win. A win at Le Mans or the Mille Miglia easily makes a car twice as valuable as the same type of car that was a midpack finisher.
- Having a famous driver's wrinkles and sweat stains on the seat can count for a lot, par-

ticularly the icons like Steve Mc-Queen, Juan Fangio or Phil Hill.

 A car's livery (paint job), if it is correct for the history, can be important because it signals exclusivity. The iconic blue and orange Gulf/Wyer colors on a 917 or GT40 can add 30% or more to its value.

Provenance

The unfortunate reality is that virtually every old racing car endured a period in its life when it was considered to be more or less junk.

The lucky few managed to survive forgotten in the back of a garage, but most were flogged in ever-lessimportant events, had engines and gearboxes replaced, and generally rotted away. Some were simply junked (Porsche burned old 917s for fire training). Fifty years later, important cars like the 917 have become insanely valuable, and virtually all of them have been miraculously found and restored to as-new condition. Some are more real than others.

 If you are going to collect, knowing the complete story of the history of a car is crucial, if not for you, then for the guy who may want to buy it later. Dicey history does not disqualify a collectible, but it will affect the value.

- There is a clear order of importance when it comes to originality. Unquestioned right to a chassis number is at the top, followed by original chassis and suspension. Having either the original or an original engine is next, then transmission and other secondary components.
- There is an essential trade-off with racing cars when it comes to untouched original condition, particularly when it comes to bodywork. A racing car that hasn't been bashed multiple times is almost a contradiction in terms. If you can find one that is perfect, it probably never accomplished much in terms of competition.

Matching numbers

The idea of matching numbers started out with Ferraris and has since become sort of an obsession across all marques. It shouldn't be. Ferraris were so conservatively designed and built (at least in the Enzo years) that the original components almost always stayed together. This is the exception. Racers are generally "driven hard and put away wet," so parts were often changed frequently. Having a correct racing engine (or transmission), as opposed to "the" original, is generally acceptable. American racers almost never kept the same engine for more than a season, since they were easier to replace than fix.

Aluminum bodywork

A wise friend once told me, "If a racing car doesn't have aluminum bodywork, it's not collectible." Generally, this is true; into at least the mid-1960s, a hand-built aluminum body was essential to any serious design. Steel was for production cars. Fiberglass and composites took over in the mid-to-late-1960s, but for the

glory years of collectibility, aluminum was the standard.

Design and construction

Considered as artifact characteristics, historic and technical importance signify collector desirability. There are a few subgroups.

 TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATION: Racing cars have always been both the point of invention and the crucible for proving new concepts in automotive design. Pioneering cars are extremely important. The Lotus 25 introduced the monocoque chassis to Formula One and is an icon, while the Lotus 24 is pretty much the same car with a tube frame and maybe half as valuable.

 MECHANICAL COMPLEXITY: Having lots of little parts working together is always more desirable than fewer from a collector's standpoint. The Ferrari 290 MM and 860 Monza are precisely the same car, except the 290 MM uses a V12 while the Monza uses a 4-cylinder engine. (Fangio preferred the 860; when the brakes go away, he said, you can slow it down with the engine.) An 860 is worth about \$6m-\$8m, but the 290 is a \$20m-\$22m car.



Beauty

The fact that a racing car is stunningly gorgeous can override an amazing number of inadequacies for a collector. The Lotus 30 is arguably the worst sports racing car of the 1960s but holds value because it is so beautiful that collectors can't resist. Just don't try to drive one.

Final Thoughts

This is anything but a comprehensive summary but should serve as an introduction. If you are serious, seek out someone involved in the business and ask. There is not a single one of us who doesn't love to talk. •




Rare and desirable, this factory supercharged example of Jean Bugatti's Atalante masterpiece leads the precious metal in the Bonhams sale. One of only 16 "Compresseur" (supercharger) Atalante variants ever produced,

the 57C could reach a top speed of 120 mph in an era when 50 mph was the reality for most cars. The 57C's unmistakable Art Deco lines, designed by Jean Bugatti, were fashioned by the fabled Swiss/ French coachbuilder Gangloff. Its original aluminum coachwork, fitted to only five cars, has been retained, as has its interior, with great measures taken to preserve its original finishes. This stunning matching-numbers motorcar has outstanding provenance as the 1938 Paris Salon exhibition display car. It is now offered from an esteemed European collector, who acquired the car from a long-term owner of 60 years, with factory letters from Ettore Bugatti himself, and a report by respected Bugatti authority Pierre-Yves Laugier.

SLEEPER CAR: 1958 Mercedes-Benz 300SL Roadster

A perennial favorite of car connoisseurs, the 300SL is prone to further increase in value: It's a very well-built car, with iconic styling, beautifully advanced engineering and is usable for many events. This matching-numbers 1958 Roadster is offered from 36 years of singlefamily ownership, with its previous custodian being renowned racing driver Bob Akin. The businessman, who enjoyed a successful on-track career for more than three decades until he retired in 1991, was known for his "speed and style." My pick for one of the star cars for our upcoming auction at the Monterey Jet Center is without a doubt Sir Sean Connery's personal 1964 Aston Martin DB5. Helping Sir Sean source the Aston was one of the most enjoyable memories of my experience in the vintage-car world. His brief to me was to find the best example possible. He was fastidious in everything he researched and acquired, with this car being no exception. Another aspect to the sale of this car is that his longtime friend, fellow Scotsman, and multiple-World-Championshipwinning racing driver Sir Jackie Stewart has offered a personal drive in the Aston Martin DB5 for the winning bidder. Not many cars at auction can boast that.

SLEEPER CAR: 2012 Mercedes-Benz C63 AMG Black Series (Estimate: \$125k-\$150k)

My sleeper pick for our Monterey Jet Center auction is the 2012 Mercedes-Benz C63 AMG Black Series. These cars continue to gain traction amongst collectors for their incredible performance, low production and usability as a modern collector car. The example offered from the Halo Collection benefits from a recent service and was also optioned with the B26 Aerodynamics Package from new. Notably, the addition of a Stage 3 Weistec M156 supercharger boosts power by an additional 289 horsepower to produce over 500 hp and a top speed of about 190 mph.

1957 Roadster is a particularly historic example. The second 300SL Roadster built, carrying body number 750002, this car was produced in March 1957. Originally finished in Elfenbein (DB 608) with red leather upholstery, this car served as the Mercedes-Benz "standwagen" - or show car - at the 1957 New York International Auto Show, introducing this new Mercedes-Benz model to the all-important American market. Remarkably, the consignor's father purchased the 300SL from its original owner in 1975 and it has remained a family heirloom since. Benefiting from recent work by the experts at Hjeltness Restoration, this Roadster is presented in its elegant factory color scheme and shows fewer than 39,000 miles. It retains rare early-production features, important documentation and rare accessories including the original books, toolkit and fitted luggage.


