



CYBERKNIFE SLICES THROUGH THE COMPETITION IN HASKELL

OCEANPORT, NJ - Gold Square LLC's **Cyberknife** (Gun Runner) led home a one-two finish for his sire when he charged up the rail in deep stretch to nip **Taiba** (Gun Runner) on the line while setting a new track record in the GI TVG.com Haskell S. at Monmouth Park Saturday. The victory gave trainer Brad Cox and jockey Florent Geroux their second winner from as many starters in the Haskell following Mandaloun (Into Mischief)'s win via disqualification in the 2021 renewal of the race and put an end to a remarkable streak of four straight graded wins on the card by Chad Brown, who saddled favored **Jack Christopher** (Munnings) to a third-place finish.

Let go at 7-1, Cyberknife broke from the rail and was allowed to settle into stride as longshot **Benevengo** (Gormley) took the field through fractions of :23.50 and :46.96 while shadowed by Jack Christopher. The favorite moved to the lead after three-quarters in 1:09.93, while Geroux aboard Cyberknife was waiting for racing room and Taiba was rallying five wide into the lane. Taiba was first to overtake the tiring favorite, but Cyberknife was slicing through a narrow opening along the rail. The two sons of **Gun Runner** went head-to-head in the final strides with Cyberknife just getting the better of his foe in the last jump. **Cont. p3**

NEST MUCH THE BEST IN CCA OAKS HEAVYWEIGHT MATCH-UP

Repole Stable, Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners and Michael House's **Nest** (Curlin) found herself somewhat surprisingly on the lead early in Saturday's GI Coaching Club American Oaks, but still left little doubt as to who the top sophomore filly in the country is right now as she galloped home 12 1/4 lengths clear of main rival **Secret Oath** (Arrogate) in the Saratoga stretch.


Having seen a three-race win streak snapped when she settled for second as the favorite to Secret Oath in the May 6 GI Longines Kentucky Oaks, Nest was coming off a solid second to stablemate Mo Donegal (Uncle Mo) in the GI Belmont S. June 11. Despite having lost a two-length decision to Secret Oath in their prior match-up, Nest was installed the public's 4-5 pick over the last-out GI Preakness S. fourth finisher.





The final time for the nine furlongs was 1:46.24, lowering the track record set just four races earlier when Highly Motivated (Into Mischief) won the GIII Monmouth Cup S. in 1:46.53. The previous nine-furlong record at Monmouth Park had stood since 1985 when GI Kentucky Derby winner Spend a Buck covered the distance in 1:46.80.

The win, which rewarded the victor with an automatic berth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, was a hometown score for New Jersey native Al Gold of Gold Square LLC.

"This is a very big deal for me personally," Gold said. "I started betting horses when I was a kid and have owned horses for 40 years. You always have fantasies. You want to win the Kentucky Derby and all the big races, but this is one of the ones I really wanted to win. We go to the [Aug. 27 GI] Travers next and we'll see where we are. And we're on our way to the Breeders' Cup."

Cyberknife won the Apr. 2 GI Arkansas Derby, earning a spot in the GI Kentucky Derby. The colt faded to 18th after chasing a hot pace in the Derby, but came back to outnose Howling Time (Not This Time) in the GIII Matt Winn S. at Churchill Downs last time out June 12.

"I think this is his best race to date," Cox said of Cyberknife's Haskell victory. "Throughout the race I thought he looked very professional with the way he handled himself. At the quarter-pole, Florent Geroux had a nice hold of him and he was loaded. He responded well when asked. He flew at the end. I am very proud of him. He was able to settle. Florent took a good hold of him and then made a run up the backside and got him in position along the rail. Florent looked like he had a lot of horse when he turned for home. He was just figuring out whether he was going inside or outside of the leader. It looked like he made the right decision staying to the inside and we were able to hold off Taiba. It was a big effort. I'm very proud of this horse and our whole staff. He's been a challenging horse at times. A lot of the good ones are."

With his third-place finish, Jack Christopher was suffering the first loss of his career while making his first start beyond a mile.

The loss put a stop to a streak of four straight graded tallies on the Haskell card by Brown, who won the Monmouth Cup with Highly Motivated, the GIII WinStar Matchmaker S. with Lemista (Ire) (Raven's Pass), the GIII Molly Pitcher S. with Search Results (Flatter) and the GI United Nations S. with Adhamo (Ire) (Intello {Ger}).

A crowd of 22,138 attended the races on a stifling hot day on the Jersey Shore Saturday, wagering \$1,303,642 on track. All-sources handle totaled \$19,896,954--up from the 2021 figure of \$16,414,535, but off the record mark of \$20,479,392 set in 2020.

Cyberknife is one of five Grade I winners for the Three Chimneys stallion, who has also been represented by this year's GI Preakness S. winner Early Voting and 2021 2-year-old filly champion Echo Zulu.

She has an unraced 2-year-old colt by Tapit named Tapit Shoes--who was purchased by the BSW/Crow Colts Group and trainer Brad Cox for \$300,000 at last year's Fasig-Tipton October sale--as well as a weanling colt by Authentic. She was bred back to Gun Runner this year.

Expected pacesetter **Society** (Gun Runner) was one of the two inside runners to break awkwardly, and Nest immediately to their outside was ridden along by Irad Ortiz, Jr. to seize the narrow lead with **Nostalgic** (Medaglia d'Oro) and Secret Oath not far behind while one and two paths off the fence, respectively. Society was headstrong in behind the leading trio, and snuck up the fence midway on the first turn to take over briefly. **Cont. p7**

Nest put a head back in front after the opening quarter of :24.10 and before the :47.46 half.

Secret Oath was given her cue by Luis Saez to challenge Nest entering the home bend, and the stage appeared set for a throwdown that could very well decide Eclipse honors at the end of the year. But by midway on the turn it was clear that Nest had far more to give, and the bay quickened nicely with a couple of reminders from Ortiz in upper stretch before being wrapped up late.

"My plan was not to be on the lead, but I wanted to break good out of there," Ortiz said. "Honestly, that was the main thing and I tried to break, and she broke clean and I realized the other filly didn't break well. So I said, 'let's go, Plan B.' I was in front and didn't panic. I just let her do her thing. That was [how] the race came up. Everything changed when the gates opened and I just let her do her thing and she did the rest."

A five-length debut romper routing at Belmont last September, Nest was a close third in the Tempted S. that November before making the grade by a neck in Aqueduct's nine-panel GII Demoiselle S. Dec. 4. She resurfaced to dominate Tampa's Suncoast S. Feb. 12, and doubled up by daylight in Keeneland's GI Central Bank Ashland S. Apr. 8 ahead of her Oaks and Belmont appearances.

"It's funny how you spend a lot of time analyzing a game plan and then, as they say, everything can change at the break-which it did today," said Pletcher, winner of a record eight renewals of this event, including one each previously in back-to-back years for Repole (Stopchargingmaria {Tale of the Cat}, 2014) and Eclipse (Curalina {Curlin}, 2015). "The main thing is we wanted to establish some position, get away smoothly and get to the first turn in a forward position. We were able to do that even though everyone wasn't positioned exactly where we

thought they would be. It turned out to ultimately to have those four fillies bunch up together and [Nest] was able to fend off the challenge from Secret Oath and keep going."

Nest and Secret Oath are both likely to return for the 10-panel GI Alabama S. Aug. 20. As for the decision to run in this spot as well, Pletcher said, "We've run a lot of horses in the Belmont over the years, but we've never had one come out any better than she did. She had great energy and she gained weight since that race. She gave us every indication she was ready to run back. Originally, we thought we should wait for the Alabama, but she was just doing too good to bypass this race."

The runner-up's trainer D. Wayne Lukas, Pletcher's former boss, offered: "I think coming in here, shipping in is always difficult. The winner ran a super, super race. She won fair and square. We hung a little bit. We needed, I think, to have been a little tighter on this track. Coming in here and shipping from out of state is tough--it always has been, and I've been here 50 years. It's always been a place where you do a little better if you have an out over it. But the good news is we'll have another shot."

Pedigree Notes:

One of Curlin's 18 Grade I winners, Nest is the third daughter of the two-time Horse of the Year to take the CCA Oaks, joining the aforementioned Curalina and 2020 heroine Paris Lights. She is bred on the same cross with A.P. Indy as stablemate and 2021 champion 3-year-old filly Malathaat, who looks to avenge a narrow loss to Clariere (Curlin) in last month's GI Ogden Phipps S. in Sunday's GII Shuvee S.

Both Clairiere and Paris Lights are out of mares by top broodmare sire Bernardini, and Nest's stakes-winning dam Marion Ravenwood is bred on the same cross as Bernardini, being out of a Quiet American mare herself. **Cont. p8**

Out of GSW/GISP and \$2.5-million FTKNOV seller Andujar, Marion Ravenwood was barren to City of Light in 2021 and was bred to both Quality Road and Curlin for 2022 but a foal has not been registered as of now.

Adhamo completed a straight graded pick 4 for trainer Chad Brown and Flavien Prat while providing his conditioner with a fifth victory and second in a row in the U.N.

A winner of the G3 Prix la Force last April for Freddy Head and Wertheimer and Frere, the bay's final European start was an eighth in Longchamp's G2 Qatar Prix Dollar Oct. 2, but that

didn't dissuade agent Hubert Guy from going to €250,000 to pick him up that same evening at Arqana's Arc sale.

He resurfaced and rallied from out of the clouds to miss by a head in the GIII Fair Grounds S. Feb. 19, was third as the favorite in Churchill's GI Old Forester Bourbon Turf Classic S. on the GI Kentucky Derby undercard May 7, and most recently finished second to speedy stablemate and defending U.N. champ Tribhuvan (Fr) (Toronado {Ire}) in the GI Resorts World Casino Manhattan S. on Belmont S. day June 11.

Adhamo broke sluggishly but settled in midpack on the fence and traveled strongly as Tribhuvan took up his usual spot on the front end, doling out splits of :24.70, :48.86, 1:13.26 and 1:36.35. Adhamo was guided to the outside heading for home as the frontrunner continued on strongly like he might complete his Presious Passion impersonation. Adhamo bore down on his stablemate at the head of the lane and was met with momentary resistance, but he found a final burst leaving the sixteenth pole to settle the issue.

"He didn't break super sharp and I was a little worried with post one. But the pace was fair, a little slow but fair, and he relaxed well," said Prat, who piloted Tribhuvan in this race 12 months ago. "When they slowed it down he was pulling me. I had to be patient and wait to get out. He made a great run in the stretch. When I tipped him out he was ready to go. I think I have won two or three stakes races in a row, but never four in a row like this."

Brown said of the winner: "He's been a little unlucky this year. He's still a little bit of a work in progress. I'm still trying to figure out what his best distance is, and ground and such. I was pretty confident going in to today that if he was able to get out in the clear and with a little bit extra ground to work with that he could run down a horse as good as Tribhuvan, and he did. He's a pretty talented horse. We're still figuring the horse out."

Pedigree Notes:

Adhamo is the second highest-level winner for 2013 G1 Prix du Jockey Club hero Intello (Ger) (Galileo {Ire}) and, like 2018 G1 Prix Jean Prat winner Intellogent (Ire), he's out of a mare by a Green Desert stallion. Invincible Spirit is now the broodmare sire of four Grade I/Group 1 winners (three in the Northern Hemisphere).

Adhamo hails from a typically deep Wertheimer family. He's a half to a pair of stakes-placed runners in France, including 2-year-old and recent Prix Roland de Chambure third Neversay (Fr) (No Nay Never), and his dam is out of a group winner and kin to four stakes performers, including multiple Group 2-winning full-sister Impassable (Ire).

Klaravich Stables homebred Highly Motivated returned to graded competition with an emphatic, track-record setting victory in the GIII Monmouth Cup S. Saturday. Near the back in a compact field, the 4-5 favorite was in hand while improving his position down the backstretch. He rolled up three wide into the far turn, shadowing the move of his stablemate Pipeline, and strode confidently to the lead into the stretch before powering clear to the wire. His final time of 1:46.53 for the nine furlongs broke the track record of 1:46.80 set by GI Kentucky Derby winner Spend a Buck in 1985.

"I felt like the other horse of Chad Brown's [Pipeline] was traveling really well on the lead and I wanted to stay close to him," said winning jockey Flavien Prat. "That's why I moved when I did. Once I got going, I didn't want to stop him at that point. I wanted him to go on with it..." **Cont. p10**

Prat continued, "I guess we traveled pretty well if he set a track record. He got himself into a good spot and he was going well. I just wanted to make sure we stayed in touch with the leader. When I asked him to go he really responded. Every race this year he has stepped up a little more. This was another one."

Highly Motivated, winner of Keeneland's Nyquist S. in November 2020, put himself into last year's GI Kentucky Derby picture with a third-place effort in the GIII Gotham S. and a narrowly beaten runner-up finish behind champion Essential Quality (Tapit) in the GII Toyota Blue Grass S. He was 10th on the First Saturday in May and went to the sidelines for the rest of the year. Back at four, the bay colt was fourth in a sevenfurlong Keeneland allowance Apr. 16 before returning to the winner's circle in a one-mile Belmont allowance May 28.

"In hindsight, the grueling stretch duel in the Blue Grass really took a toll on him," said Brown, who was winning his second race on the Haskell undercard. "Going into the Derby, he didn't run at all. He went to the sidelines for quite a while. It's really taken me this long to get the horse back from that tough, tough race against Essential Quality. He's finally--over a year later--rounding back into that good form. He required incremental steps. I let him find his legs again to find that sharpness he had."

Exiting a bang-up third behind Clairiere (Curlin) and 'TDN Rising Star' Malathaat (Curlin) in the GI Ogden Phipps S. on the Belmont undercard June 11, Search Results gave Chad Brown his fourth victory on the Haskell program and Flavien Prat his third consecutive graded victory--all for Brown--with a thoroughly dominating success in Saturday's GIII Molly Pitcher S. at Monmouth Park.

The prohibitive favorite jumped alertly from gate three, but was outsprinted and settled three deep in the breeze, as Beth's Dream (Jess's Dream) set a moderate early pace from Pennybaker (Medaglia d'Oro). Clocking those two rivals from close range through the middle furlongs, the \$310,000 Keeneland September graduate was poised as they hit the midpoint of the turn and was roused to the lead three wide passing the quarter pole. She quickly opened up as the pacesetters retreated tamely and was always holding last year's GIII Monmouth Oaks heroine Leader of the Band--who was given every conceivable chance with a cushy inside trip--in the run to the wire. Army Wife just outfinished Bonny South (Munnings) for third. After commonly owned stablemate Highly Motivated (Into Mischief) won the GIII Monmouth Cup in trackrecord time two races prior, Search Results's final clocking of 1:40.48 was just 0.29 off the 8 1/2-furlong track mark held by Sharp Azteca. "I'm so appreciative Monmouth had this race," said Brown. "It made it an easy decision to come here with her, and the mile and a sixteenth is a good distance for her. Flavien [Prat] did a terrific job and I really wanted to keep her face clean and not have any dirt in her face from that post. Flavien did execute it really well. I told him just get out of there. If somebody to her outside wants to go, just extract her quick because I think she's tons the best and I don't want to take any chances. Just park her in the center of the track and see if she can do it today, and she sure did. I'm glad it worked out for her."

A gallant runner-up to Malathaat in last year's GI Kentucky Oaks, Search Results made amends with a half-length defeat of Obligatory (Curlin) in the GI Acorn S., but was only third to Bella Sofia (Awesome Patriot) in the GI Longines Test S. before calling it a season. She caught an in-form Glass Ceiling (Constitution)

and was clearly well below her best when a comebacking third in the GIII Distaff H. at Aqueduct in April, but rebounded with a three-length tally in the GII Ruffian S. over a muddy Belmont main track and ran an exceptional race in the Phipps last time, yielding in the late stages after engaging in an otherwise suicidal duel with champion Letruska (Super Saver).

Search Results is one of five Grade I winners--of which three are females--for Claiborne's Flatter, who was lost to the infirmities of old age this past May. Out of a half-sister to Peruvian Group 1-placed Kingdom Road (Arg) (Bellamy Road), Search Results is a full-sister to \$625,000 OBS April purchase Search Engine, a two-time winner this season, and a half to a colt by Nyquist. 

Acquired by Peter Brant after winning her third straight in a listed stakes at Gowran Park in June of 2020, Lemista immediately rewarded her new owner's investment when taking the G2 Kilboy Estate S. at The Curragh a month later. She failed to fire in one more try in Ireland, and resurfaced last May for Brown to be a close second to GISW Harvey's Lil Goil (American Pharoah) in Belmont's GIII Beaugay S. She was third two starts later when piloted by Flavien Prat for the first time in the final GI Beverly D. S. contested at Arlington Park last August, but her season was cut short after that. The dark bay was fourth in the May 14 Beaugay behind stablemate Rougir (Fr) (Territories {Ire}), and third in the GIII Eatontown S. going a sixteenth shorter here June 18.

Reunited with Prat for this, Lemista broke well and was taken in hand to draft in a good spot in third early. She crept closer into the first turn, and was by herself in second with teammate Flighty Lady (Ire) (Sir Percy {GB}) showing the way. Lemista cranked the pressure up after six panels in 1:12.21, and was joined on her outside by Fluffy Socks as Vigilantes Way revved up in behind as the lone potential spoiler to another Brown trifecta. Fluffy Socks looked to poke a nose in front passing the chute, but Lemista was immediately energized by that challenge and ground it out from there.

"I had a good trip," Prat said. "She broke well. I got a chance to get myself in a good position. I was traveling really well and when I squeezed her for a little more she responded. I rode her last year. It seems like she has grown a lot physically. Chad Brown did a great job bringing her back. She ran really well. She has always shown some talent. When I rode her last year she got beat by two really good fillies who went on to win Grade Is. She has always been a nice filly and Chad said before the race that he was hoping for a good run from her."

Brown said, "Lemista doesn't have a great turn of foot and I've

been frustrated when she's been out of position. She ran decent last time when she got dragged to the back of the pack. She just needs to break into position and today I thought for the first time that she had really good forward position. She has a good kick; she's just not going to circle the field. She's not that kind of horse, so I'm very pleased with the trip that Flavien worked out for her. [Fluffy Socks] was a little bit wide, but she was game as usual. She's very consistent. She had a more challenging trip having to lose some ground on that final turn and that was the difference."

Pedigree Notes:

Kildangan Stud's Raven's Pass registered his first graded winner in the U.S. when Lemista crossed the wire in the Matchmaker, a fitting achievement for the English-trained stallion who is best remembered on these shores for winning the 2008 GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The son of Elusive Quality has 14 other graded winners in the Northern Hemisphere from his seasons at Darley's Irish base. Lemista is also one of four stakes winners out of daughters of Arcano (Ire), whose sire Oasis Dream (GB) is responsible for two of Raven's Pass's 38 total black-type winners.

Lemista's dam is a half-sister to French GSW Indian Maiden (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), who is also a graded producer, while Lemista's great-granddam is a half to U.S. champion and GI Kentucky Derby-winning filly Winning Colors (Caro {Ire}). Fourth dam All Rainbows (Bold Hour) is a half to champion Chris Evert (Swoon's Son), who made several significant contributions to the breed, including champion grandson Chief's Crown (Danzig).

Shortmile Lady has a 2-year-old colt by Zoffany (Ire), who was a \$65,000 RNA at Keeneland September last year before bringing €550,000 at Arqana's May breeze-up sale from Oliver St Lawrence Bloodstock. Her yearling Exceed And Excel (Aus) colt was hammered for 50,000gns by Ard Erin Stud at the 2021 Tattersalls December Foal Sale.

She was just 13-10 when third in this race last year, but Robin Sparkles stole Saturday's renewal of the GIII Caress S. at 21-1 while providing veteran conditioner Bruce Brown with a first graded stakes victory.

Having broken her maiden second out here for a \$40,000 tag in 2020, Robin Sparkles had proven a bit of a win machine thereafter, taking five of her next 10 including a one-mile rained-off New York-bred stakes event and capped by a Laurel optional claiming tally in September. She stopped badly as the favorite in Belmont's open Floral Park S. a few weeks later, but resurfaced to take Monmouth's off-turf Politely S. May 21 before finishing third in that venue's June 25 Goldwood S. behind the re-opposing Bout Time (Not This Time).

Gunned to the front by Javier Castellano, Robin Sparkles cleared off to post splits of :21.54 and :44.21. She opened up at the head of the lane, but was saved by the wire late as Souper Sensational closed quickly.

"I really like the horse and the way she did it today," said Castellano, who had never been on Robin Sparkles before. "The horse is a free-running horse. She only likes to go to the lead. She broke so well out of the gate, I took a big advantage and put her on the lead and tried to slow down the pace the best I could. I like the way she finished. She is such a game horse. Today, she put in 100% and Bruce did such a good job."

Brown added, "[Javier], especially on the grass, is one of the best and if you have him, you know you are going to get a fair shot. He rode my good sprinter Spring to the Sky (Langfuhr) and won a few races on him and I told him in the paddock, 'Let's try to do that and get her out there.' She doesn't like to be held too tight, just loose rein and nurse her around there and that's exactly what she did.

"Last year, she had some bad luck and different things going on. She was very in-and-out as far as how she was doing, but she's really come back better and better each start. The last race was down in Monmouth and that was a suicidal kind of pace, but she bounced out of it real good and has been eating the bottom out of the feed tub and doing great. **Cont. p14**

"She's had different things and just different issues. Colds, throat infections and different things going on, so she's really gotten all that behind her and she's coming into her own now."

Pedigree Notes:

Robin Sparkles is the 32nd graded winner for the late Elusive Quality, who is six shy of 100 black-type Northern Hemisphere winners. The Darley stallion died at age 25 in 2018, a year after being pensioned. Elusive Quality had a number of top-class horses, including MGISW Quality Road, who is now one of the elite sires of the sport.

The first graded winner produced by any of her first six dams-which covers the advent of the graded system--Robin Sparkles is a New York-bred. Her dam, My Sparky, was purchased by Hibiscus Stables for \$5,700 at the 2014 Fasig-Tipton New York Saratoga Fall Mixed Sale. My Sparky produced four foals for Hibiscus before passing away in 2018. She was a daughter of champion Dehere, whose 122 stakes winners out of his daughters include champions Will Take Charge and Midnight Lute.

In a race featuring Grade I winners Shirl's Speight (Speightstown)--who is also a 'TDN Rising Star'--and Silent Poet, as well as a number of other graded-winning veterans, it was the lightly raced import Filo Di Arianna, whose optional allowance win earlier this month was only his second victory in three years, that annexed the GII Connaught Cup S. at Woodbine Saturday. In the Connaught Cup, Filo Di Arianna broke straight and true after hesitating to load and quickly outfooted a fleet Silent Poet, who had shot to the early lead. There was no stopping Filo Di Arianna as he held firmly to his advantage while under a snug hold. After ticking fractions of :23.19 and :46.25, he cut the corner on the turn and powered to the easiest of wins. March to the Arch closed stoutly for runner-up honors 2 1/2 lengths back, besting Silent Poet by a nose for the place.

"He's just a great horse and I'm so thankful Mark [Casse] gave me the confidence to be on him today," said Luis Contreras, who was aboard the horse for the first time after Kazushi Kimura, who had the call and was up for the horse's last race, was injured on Friday's card. Filo Di Arianna is now unbeaten in three starts at Woodbine.

Filo Di Arianna kickstarted his career in his native Brazil in 2019 under the tutelage of R. M. Lima and quickly streaked to three runaway wins in seven weeks, including two group events, by a combined 27 1/4 lengths. Named champion 2-year-old colt, he was transferred to the U.S. that same year, but didn't even reappear on the worktab for another 24 months after his last Brazilian start. In June of 2021, the chestnut finally made his first trip to the starting gate in the Northern Hemisphere, staying unbeaten with a 95 Beyer and 2 1/4-length win in a Woodbine allowance under new trainer Mark Casse.

Back to the sidelines, he was next seen in a pair of graded stakes earlier this year--the Apr. 9 GII Shakertown S. at Keeneland and the June 11 GI Jaipur S. at Belmont--but failed to make so much as a dent in either, finishing 10th and 12th, respectively. Casse dropped him back to optional allowance company July 3 for his first start off the turf--over Woodbine's all-weather surface--and he responded with a 6 3/4-length romp and a 102 Beyer. The Connaught Cup win marked his second consecutive victory and first graded win in the Northern Hemisphere.

Pedigree Notes:

Drosselmeyer, winner of the 2010 GI Belmont S. and 2011 GI Breeders' Cup Classic, began his stallion career at WinStar Farm in Kentucky in 2012 and immediately started shuttling to Stud TNT in Brazil for the Southern Hemisphere season. In 2016, it was announced he had been purchased by Stud TNT and would remain permanently in Brazil. Between the two continents, Drosselmeyer has 49 black-type winners, 27 of which are group/graded. The Distorted Humor stallion's most accomplished runner is Jolie Olimpica (Brz), who was Horse of the Year in Brazil in 2019 before shipping north for three graded wins, a Grade I placing, and Canadian championship honors. Both Filo Di Arianna and Brazilian GSW/G1SP Galaxy Runner (Brz) are by Drosselmeyer and out of Northern Afleet mares. The late latter stallion is broodmare sire of 32 stakes winners.

Principessa Capri (Brz) is also dam of G1SW-Brz Culo e Camicia (Brz) (Agnes Gold {Jpn}) and is herself a half to G1SW-Brz Gata y Flor (Brz) (Forestry). The family has been flourishing in Brazil since Filo Di Arianna's great-granddam was shipped there from the U.S. in 1997. The family descends from the Gambetta branch of the breed-shaping blue hen Rough Shod II (GB).

SMALL, BUT MIGHTY, SHUVEE FIELD LEADS SUNDAY GRADED ACTION by Patrycja Szpyra

A lack of competitors doesn't always translate to a lack of competition and the GII Shuvee S. at Saratoga is a case in point, with an abbreviated field of four featuring a pair of titans. Fellow Curlin daughters Clairiere and Malathaat will bring their rivalry to round six in the 1 1/8-mile contest at the Spa; the latter coming out on the better end on four prior occasions. Malathaat will be breaking from the gate sporting blinkers for the first time in her career, likely intended to combat her tendency to wait on her competition, and she has been working with the new equipment in the mornings as well.

Todd Pletcher will be shooting for his fifth victory in this event (Curalina-2016, Stopchargingmaria-2015, Authenticity-2013, Awesome Maria-2011) should their match up here return in her

favor, tying his record with the legendary H. Allen Jerkens for most Shuvee wins as conditioner. Steve Asmussen looks to add his name to the race's annals for the first time after most recently saddling She's a Julie (Elusive Quality) to a third-place finish in 2019. Both Clairiere and Malathaat ran career-high Beyers of 106 last out in the GI Ogden Phipps, and are the horses to beat here, nearly guaranteeing that history of some kind will be made on Spa Sunday.

Crazy Beautiful (Liam's Map) for trainer Kenny McPeek, who's riding into the race on the back of a fruitful summer season. The grey has faced Malathaat on three occasions and never been in winning contention in any of those races, but she's the third millionaire in this field, and those purses didn't come without effort. A winner of Turfway Park's Apr. 2 Latonia S. over the synthetic and second last out June 25 in the Lady Jacqueline S. at Thistledown behind MGISP Army Wife (Declaration of War), Crazy Beautiful will be trying for her eighth lifetime win here. Former \$40,000 claimer Exotic West (Hard Spun) rounds the field from the rail and faces a tall task having never run a number anywhere close to the divisional leaders on her outside.

'Magic' in Del Mar's Cougar II Marathon

MyRacehorse and Spendthrift Farm's GISP **Tizamagician** (Tiznow) makes his 5-year-old bow while trying to win the GIII Cougar II S. for the second year in a row where the 'Turf Meets the Surf.' Super consistent **Dicey Mo Chara (GB)** (Adaay {Ire}) will try to make his first dirt marathon a winning one for his eagle-eyed connections of Red Baron's Barn LLC and Rancho Temescal LLC and conditioner Leonard Powell.

Salty Graded Fields North of the Border

It's Kentucky-vs-European-breds in the turfy GII Dance Smartly S. at 1 1/16-miles at Woodbine. The G1SP **Fev Rover (Ire)** (Gutaifan {Ire}), a 695,000gns purchase by Tracy Farmer from last year's Tattersalls December Mares Sale, heads the field carrying solid European form including two black-type wins as a juvenile, though both at shorter distances, as well as a placing in Group 1 company in the English 1000 Guineas last year.

The formidable partnership of Team Valor International and Gary Barber will try to circle the field with their two classy fillies, namely GISP Wakanaka (Ire) (Power {GB}) and French stakeswinner Keyflower (Fr) (Kheleyf). Charles Fipke's 'TDN Rising Star' Lady Speightspeare (Speightstown) and the Josie Carroll-trained Seasons (Tapit) round out the Kentucky-bred contingent, while Ontario-bred horse-for-course Munnyfor Ro (Munnings) will try to parlay her liking for the track into her first seasonal win.

Before the turf fillies get rolling, the synthetic sprinters will shine in the GIII Hendrie S. with heavy favorite **Boardroom** (Commissioner) slated to take most of the action at the ticket windows. Familiar foes **Amalfi Coast** (Tapizar), conditioned by Mark Casse, and **Artie's Princess** (We Miss Artie) return to continue the rivalry triangle, and MGSP **La Libertee** (Consitution) will try to out-finish her Casse stablemate.

BROWN DUO TUNE UP FOR JIM DANDY

The Chad Brown-trained duo of GI Preakness S. winner **Early Voting** (Gun Runner) and GI Toyota Blue Grass S. hero **Zandon** (Upstart) each put in their final breezes Saturday at Saratoga for next week's GII Jim Dandy S. The former breezed in company with GII Amsterdam S.-bound **Accretive** (Practical Joke) and was

credited with five panels in 1:01.05 (12/30), while the latter covered the same distance in 1:01.95 (22/30) by himself.

"Both horses did really well," said Brown. "Zandon went alone. It was a nice easy work for him. I was really pleased in how he was moving. With Early Voting, I did a little bit more with him today with a workmate. He went fabulous. I was very pleased. As long as they come out of the works well, I'll be happy."

Zandon was last seen finishing third in the GI Kentucky Derby May 7. Early Voting, meanwhile, was last seen at Pimlico and had been working at Belmont Park before Saturday's breeze.

"We wanted to see how he was moving over the track," Brown said. "He seems to be a pretty good horse in that way. It seems he takes his racetrack with him. I never see him train poorly, but it's always nice to get that out of the way and give him a work over the track to see that he's moving well."

The D. Wayne Lukas-trained **Ethereal Road** (Quality Road) also worked Saturday at the Spa (4f in :49.72 {28/48} from the gate over the Oklahoma Training Track) and could go in either the Jim Dandy or the restricted Curlin S. one day earlier on Friday.

"We worked him out of the gate just to sharpen him up a little bit and find out where we're at," Lukas said. "I was trying to get a little better reading on him. His effort was very good today. He went in :49 and change and he actually could have been better than that. I worked him with a 2-year-old colt (Track Mate {Union Rags}) and he kind of waited. It was a good work."

Ethereal Road took the Sir Barton S. on Preakness day and most recently finished sixth in the GIII Ohio Derby June 25.



KING GEORGE GLORY FOR PYLEDRIVER

The heat was on in Saturday's G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth QIPCO S. at Ascot, a "Win And You're In" for the GI Longines Breeders' Cup Turf at Keeneland in November, and there was no hiding place as **Pyledriver (GB)** (Harbour Watch {Ire}) proved ruthless to prevail for the William Muir and Chris Grassick stable and jockey P J McDonald. Sent off at 18-1 with a below-par second in the June 3 G1 Coronation Cup last time tempering enthusiasm, last year's winner of that Epsom prize was always in his comfort zone with an ideal pace scenario tracking the hard-working duo **Westover (GB)** (Frankel {GB}) and **Broome (Ire)** (Australia {GB}).

Sent by that tiring pair passing the two pole, the contest was decided surprisingly quickly and he lengthened clear for an emphatic 2 3/4-length success from **Torquator Tasso (Ger)** (Adlerflug {Ger}) as they opened up an eight-length gap to the slow-starting **Mishriff (Ire)** (Make Believe {GB}). The pair of 3-year-olds, the 13-8 favourite Westover, and **Emily Upjohn** (**GB**) (Sea The Stars {Ire}), proved major disappointments as the last pair home.

"I honestly believed I'd win from two weeks ago," an understandably emotional Muir said. "I didn't care what was in it. I've said I never wanted to cry, but I want to cry today."

ZOUSTAR'S LEZOO NOTCHES LANDMARK SCORE AT ASCOT by Sean Cronin

Marc Chan and Andrew Rosen's 2-year-old filly **Lezoo (GB)** (Zoustar {Aus}), making a swift return after running second in Newmarket's July 8 G2 Duchess of Cambridge S. last time, notched a landmark score in Saturday's G3 Princess Margaret Keeneland S. at Ascot to become her sire's first Northern Hemisphere pattern-race winner in the six-furlong dash.

She had previously posted victories in a June 11 novices' heat over five furlongs at Bath and when upped to six furlongs for Newmarket's June 25 Listed Empress Fillies' S. in her penultimate start. Positioned off the early tempo after a slightly awkward exit from the stands' side stall, the 6-5 favourite made smooth headway from halfway to launch her challenge at the quarter-mile marker and kept on strongly once hitting the front soon after to withstand the late rattle of the hitherto undefeated **Kinta (Ire)** (Sioux Nation) by a length. **Cont. p7**

Back on Dubai World Cup night, a King George win for Pyledriver would not have looked as much of a surprise as it did on Saturday afternoon, with Frankie Dettori locked up on the rail until too late in the G1 Dubawi Sheema Classic. Only fourth but widely considered unlucky not to win there, he looked to have a Coronation Cup repeat in the bag until Hukum (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) intervened and he ended up soundly beaten there ridden from the front by Dettori. This was a return to his previous best when upstaging Al Aasy (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) at Epsom last June and when second in the G1 Hong Kong Vase during a light 2021 campaign. Willie Muir had stated after his G2 King Edward VII S. and G2 Great Voltigeur S. successes at three that he would win one of these "big ones" and while the team at Linkslade Stables have had to be patient, it finally paid off in spades in one of the very biggest.

Westover's race may well have been run before he left the paddock, having got noticeably warm, while Emily Upjohn refused to settle beyond halfway and Mishriff did his now-familiar trick of handing his rivals a few lengths headstart with another tardy break. Pyledriver was the spriteliest away, but P J McDonald was keen to wait on the Irish Derby winner and Broome to come forward and provide him with a lead that the latest Epsom experience proved is vital. Torquator Tasso was the only other rival running his race in behind, but as Colin Keane started to give out the warning signals on Westover turning for home he was too far out of his ground to make a serious impact on the eventual winner. Killing the race with a swift sectional from the two to the one, Pyledriver even had the energy to swerve from the whip close home as he had done when third in the St Leger.

"Today, we smashed them to pieces," Muir added. "I actually wrote the papers for you boys tomorrow. I said 'If Pyledriver wins, the line is a poor bunch of 3-year-olds again. If the 3-year-olds win, a great crop'. They are a great crop, the 3-year-olds. He is just a very, very talented horse and I've never lost faith in him. In our second or third year, we had a horse who came here and won a five-furlong race and we were partying in the car park for ages. When Pyledriver won the King Edward VII a couple of years ago, we would still be in the car park today if we'd been able to but we couldn't because of Covid. This is a big, big moment. It means the world to me."

Torquator Tasso's rider Rene Piechulek, said, "The ground had to be soft for us to win, but he has run a great race on that. The owner and trainer are very happy, in fact we all are. The target is October and the Arc is what it's all about."

Frankie Dettori said of Emily Upjohn, "The trip was too far for her at that pace."

P J McDonald was quick to point to the 5-year-old's currently-sidelined regular rider Martin Dwyer. "I feel so sorry for Martin, these horses are so hard to come by," he said. "It happened to me getting injured when I had Laurens and I know what it feels like and what will be going through his head. He's an absolute gent and so supportive of me. He's helped me out so much over the last week." Cont. p4

He added, "For me, these are days you don't think are going to happen. You work hard and sometimes think these chances aren't going to come and this one came to me by luck. I'm so grateful to William and the team and to this horse. That was as smooth as it can be. The horse filled himself up going up the hill before the turn in and I just sat on him and I knew he was going to take some beating soon after. He was amazing."

Pyledriver may have been unsold at 10,000gns at the 2017 Tattersalls December Foal Sale, but he is the first foal out of a well-connected mare in La Pyle (Fr) (Le Havre {Ire}), who is a full-sister to the G3 Park Express S. winner Normandel (Fr) and a half to the G1 Grand Prix de Paris hero Mont Ormel (Fr) (Air Chief Marshal {Ire}). She is also kin to Lillebonne (Fr) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), the dam of the Listed El Gran Senor S. winner and G2 Kilboy Estate S. runner-up Seisai (Ire) (Gleneagles {Ire}), the Listed Glencairn S. winner Maganimous (Ire) (Mehmas {Ire}), the G3 Irish St Leger Trial-placed Micro Manage (Ire) (Rip Van Winkle {Ire}) and the promising recent Leopardstown maiden winner Thornbrook (Ire) (Saxon Warrior {Jpn}). La Pyle, whose unraced 2-year-old filly Shagpyle (GB) is by Frankel (GB), is a

granddaughter of Lidakiya (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) who produced the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis and G1 Premio Vittorio di Capuawinning sire Linngari (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) and is kin to the triple listed scorer and G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup runner-up Livadiya (Ire) (Shernazar {Ire}).

SIR BUSKER CALLS THE TUNE AT YORK



Kennet Valley Thoroughbreds XI Racing's veteran campaigner **Sir Busker (Ire)** (Sir Prancealot {Ire}) was winless in 20 starts since annexing 2020's Royal Hunt Cup at Royal Ascot and turned back the clock to claim a belated first black-type triumph in Saturday's G2 Sky Bet York S. on the Knavesmire.

The 6-year-old gelding had previously chased the tail of superstar Baaeed (GB) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) when fifth contesting both May 14 G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury and G1 Queen Anne S. back at Royal Ascot and also ran third in the latter contest last year. The 15-2 chance missed a beat at the kick and trailed all four rivals, racing in a smooth rhythm, until deep into this extended 10-furlong test.

Rowed along to close with three furlongs remaining, he was ridden to lock horns with **Dubai Honour (Ire)** (Pride Of Dubai {Aus}) approaching the final furlong and kept on in determined fashion under a drive to deny that rival by a pixel in a thrilling bobber.

"I'm very proud and just so pleased for the horse," said trainer William Knight. "He's deserved that, he's run some massive races over the last couple of years and it's so nice to get his head in front in a big one. He's obviously loved the step up to a mileand-a-quarter and we probably should have done it earlier. I thought it was a competitive race, but I thought we looked a big price this morning if the step up in trip worked. We put him in the [G1] Juddmonte [International] thinking, if he won today, it would look silly if we weren't in it. It's such good prize money and it will have to be seriously considered. He's picked up a lot of money for coming placed in his career."

Pedigree Notes

Sir Busker becomes the 11th black-type winner (sixth group) for his sire, who stands at Cornerstone Stud in Australia and Rancho San Miguel in California. His unraced dam has three winners from five to race, with the York S. winner being the best of them. Cont. p6

Street Kitty's produce record contines with the winning sophomore gelding Fellowship (Ire) (Fullbright {GB}), as well as the unraced juvenile filly Beach Kitty (Ire) (Gustav Klimt {Ire}) and a yearling colt by Soldier's Call (GB). The latter is her last reported foal, and 10th offspring.

The winner's second dam, the winning Fascination Street, is a half-sister to the high class Golden Apples (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}), named the Eclipse Champion Grass Mare in 2002 off the back of wins in the GI Beverly D. S., GI Yellow Ribbon S., and GII Santa Ana S. Also successful at the highest level in the Del Mar Oaks and GII Las Palmas H. as a 3-year-old, Golden Apples would go on to produce the Storm Cat filly Habaya, a winner of the GIII Miesque S., as well as her full-sister, the GIII Lake Placid S. bridesmaid Hatheer.



JUMBLY TAKES THE VALIANT

Not enjoying the rub of the green when sixth in the G2 German 1000 Guineas at Dusseldorf June 12, Emmy Rothschild's **Jumbly (GB)** (Gleneagles {Ire}) had things fall right in Saturday's G3 Longines Valiant S. at Ascot. Sent off the 100-30 second favourite, the homebred daughter of Thistle Bird (GB) (Selkirk) was the subject of another masterclass from Hollie Doyle who had to get her settled after a fizzy start. Quickly compliant anchored towards the rear, she was delivered wide in the straight to produce a heartbreaking rally and deny **Oscula (Ire)** (Galileo Gold {Ire}) in the shade of the post by a nose.

Jumbly, who had signed off at two with a win in the seven-furlong Listed Radley S. on soft ground at Newbury in October, had returned there to be second in the G3 Fred Darling S. on a fast surface Apr. 16 and despite running eighth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at ParisLongchamp May 15 and sixth in the German equivalent, had excuses according to Harry Charlton.

"We always knew she was a genuine filly," he said. "In the French Guineas, she was boxed in and there was a scrimmage and she was only beaten two lengths and at Dusseldorf she was drawn in stall 12 and all the German commentators said you have no chance if you don't get in the first two. We wrote that off and she delivered."

"There are a batch of races at the end of races at the end of August--there are two at Goodwood on the same weekend, there is the [G2] Celebration Mile and the [G3] Supreme, the [G2] City of York and the [G2] Hungerford, which is worth less. They are all in the space of a week. I'm not saying she will necessarily win one, but there is some good black-type to pick up."

Pedigree Notes

Gleneagles's eldest foals are only five, and Jumbly is one of 21 black-type winners for the Coolmore resident. With her Valiant S. tally, the bay is also his 11th group winner. His best progeny are the G1 Prix de Royallieu heroine Loving Dream (GB) and GI Man o' War S. victor Highland Chief (Ire).

The accomplished G1 Pretty Polly S. scorer Thistle Bird took until the age of six to reach her racing pinnacle, but also claimed two editions of the G3 Princess Elizabeth S. and was placed twice at five at the highest tier in the Nassau S. and Prix de l'Opera. She also landed this event when it still held listed status. At stud, the daughter of stakes winner and G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest third Dolma (Fr) (Marchand De Sable) is a 100% producer of winners to runners with five, and Jumbly is her fourth in that lineup. Knocked down to London Thoroughbred Services on behalf of George Strawbridge for 750,000gns at the Tattersalls December Mares Sale carrying to Kingman (GB), Thistle Bird's latest is a yearling colt by Lope de Vega (Ire). That Kingman (GB) colt, Epictetus (Ire), maintained her perfect broodmare record and gained a 'TDN Rising Star' nod in the white and green Strawbridge silks with a 1 1/4-length score in a Newmarket maiden on July 8.

Charlie Appleby sent out Godolphin's subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf and G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains hero Modern Games (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) to garner last term's renewal of Newmarket's Discover Newmarket British EBF Maiden S. and the local operation has another likely sort to go forward after 750,000gns Tattersalls October Book 1 graduate Highbank (Ire) (Kingman {GB}) powered to 'TDN Rising Stardom' with a taking display in this year's edition of the seven-furlong heat. Settled off the tempo in seventh through halfway, the 4-1 chance made eyecatching headway inside the final quarter mile to gain control passing the furlong marker and quickened clear in impressive fashion to account for stablemate Bold Act (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) by 3 3/4 lengths.

"He is a horse that we have got a bit of experience with the family with having had Bay Of Poets," explained trainer Charlie Appleby. "Whatever he did today there was going to be marked improvement.
