ROPING DIVISION

The Roping Division features the best female ropers in the WPRA competing in team roping (header and heeler), tie-down roping and breakaway roping. World titles are awarded in each division as well as in the all-around category in which a competitor competes in more than one event at WPRA sanctioned events winning more money than the rest of the field.

In 2021, the breakaway roping division was divided into a ProRodeo and co-approval division much like barrel racing in which the world champion was determined by money won at PRCA events only following the conclusion of the National Finals

Breakaway Roping (NFBR) and a national champion was crowned based on co-approved standings following the WPRA World Finals. Please note prior to 2020 the WPRA World Champion Breakaway Roper was determined using money won at any event the WPRA sanctioned. The first WPRA World Champion Breakaway Roper was Becky Berggren in 1974.

This section features the 2022 World Champions as well as listings of past champions not only in the roping events but in the roughstock events of bareback riding and bull riding, when that was offered through the WPRA.

DOMINATING YEAR

Angelone Adds Name to History Books with 2022 WPRA World Champion Breakaway Roping Title

Around Thanksgiving this year, Martha Angelone (pronounced Anga-lone-e) loaded up her truck and trailer and left Stephenville, Texas, for the Nevada desert.

She was missing something, though. She was packed and on her way, but the most cherished piece of her championship puzzle was staying behind. Spots Lil Legend, a 13-year-old sorrel gelding she calls Legend, couldn't make the trip. He was still rehabilitating after colic surgery in September.

"It broke my heart that I had to leave for the finals and couldn't take him with me," said Angelone, originally from Cross Junction, Virginia, but now living in Stephenville, Texas. "He's doing perfectly fine now, but I was only going to have a week to get him ready for the finals instead of giving him more time and getting him ready for the big winter rodeos next year.

"He's old enough, too. These horses deserve the time off that they need, and I

knew I was going to need him for next year. Going out there, I realized I needed to win one check, and I'd win the world."

That's because Angelone was pretty dominant, especially toward the end of the regular season. She won San Antonio; Reno, Nevada; the NFR Open in Colorado Springs, Colorado; and shared titles in Red Lodge, Montana, and Goliad, Texas. She entered the National Finals Breakaway Roping at the South Point in Las Vegas No. 1 in the world standings with \$109,000, then earned \$21,000 over two days to earn her first Montana Silversmiths gold buckle.

"It is my first WPRA world title and I'm going to try to make it repeat as many times as I possibly can," she said. "My goal is to make the NFR and be in the top 15 and set myself up for each year. I feel like how I looked at it this year, I set myself up for a lot better. All of our goals are to win the world. I didn't set that as a goal when I got there.

"I told myself, 'Go place on every calf.' I

didn't really have the horsepower I had this (regular season), but I had a different mindset. How it played out this year had a lot to do with my mindset."

It was a bit of an up-and-down campaign to get her to the breakaway roping finals. She had one big win in the Texas buildings, and that came in San Antonio. That was worth more than \$11,000 and kept her in the game. Once the summer run hit, so did Angelone. While riding Legend, she gathered big checks in a hurry.

At three rodeos spread over a month, from mid-June to mid-July, she collected nearly \$35,000, with almost \$26,000 coming at the NFR Open.

"For me, standing on the stage at the Thomas & Mack after Round 10 was the highlight for my year; that was such a cool moment," Angelone said. "From the wins, the one in Colorado Springs was pretty special to me.

"I won almost \$30,000 there, and I ended

up being the Top Gun winner. It ended up being a cool experience.”

By the time the regular season came to a close, she had built a lead that was almost insurmountable. She was \$37,000 ahead of her closest competitor, Erin Johnson of Fowler, Colorado. By the time the breakaway roping finals concluded, Taylor Munsell of Alva, Oklahoma, had become the reserve world champion. The average title went to Weatherford, Texas, cowgirl Cadee Williams, who finished with a 10-run cumulative time of 31.9 seconds.

“I wasn’t going into the finals trying to win the average,” Angelone said. “Since our finals pays \$5,000 a go-round, I was going in there to see how much money I could win in the rounds.”

She placed six times and also finished with the fastest run of the two-day finale. She stopped the clock in 1.8 seconds to win the eighth go-round and collect the Betty Gayle Copper Fast Time Award from the National Cowgirl Hall of Fame.

“That was cool,” she said. “I’ve always been one that if there’s a roping that gives something away for the fast time, I want to win it. I used to be known as a go-round roper, because I like to throw fast and I like to be fast. It’s really cool that I ended up winning that, too.”

She did it without her main man, Legend. Since he was unavailable, Angelone leaned on Gunna Shock Ya, a 7-year-old sorrel gelding she calls Jesse James. When Legend went down, Jesse stepped up. When it was his time to shine in Las Vegas, he did.

“That horse is a bad cat, too,” Angelone said. “I’ve always said that he might not do what he needs to do, but I need to give him more credit. In the two weeks out there, he didn’t do one thing wrong. He worked absolutely amazing.

“Even this past summer, he was there. I had some girls that their good horses got hurt or they’d fly in and need a horse, and I’d let them ride him. He may spook a little here and there because he’s green, but he’s super easy to ride.”

That made all the difference when it came down to crunch time. It was Jesse’s job through the final month of the regular season, and it was the young gelding’s task inside the South Point Equestrian Center.

“I love that we get to rope in Las Vegas and get to experience the same thing as the boys,” she said. “I know we want to be in the Thomas & Mack at the end of the day, but there are positives to being where we were. There are so many good ropings while we’re out there.”

Like several other breakaway ropers, she stayed in Sin City and took in the jackpots around town, many of which were sanctioned by the WPRA. They helped pad her pocketbook in the process.

Whether she was roping in Las Vegas or Cheyenne or San Antonio or Reno, Angelone had a support system that was the guiding force behind all that she did. Her mother (Carrie Stanovick) and sister (Sarah) have been there all her life, and her boyfriend (Tanner Green) helped out through the struggles that come with rodeoing for a living. He even sent his good tie-down roping horse to California when Legend had surgery.

The Angelone sisters are both all-around cowgirls who compete in all WPRA-sanctioned roping events having learned how

to rope from their late father Vito, who passed away in 2016 from his battle with cancer. The second week of November, the sisters team roped together at the WPRA World Finals where Martha was Sarah's biggest cheerleader as Sarah became the first WPRA world champion in the family, winning the all-around title. Martha finished reserve all-around champion. When the money changed in breakaway roping a few years ago, Martha jumped on the bandwagon and chased the dollars and the prizes available to the women who rope for a living. Sarah isn't as keen on traveling like Martha, so they haven't hit the road together yet. The sisters have gathered great horses and confidence and built a business and their names in the business one run at a time.

As her two weeks in Las Vegas came to a close, Martha was asked to join the other ProRodeo world champions on the stage inside the Thomas & Mack Center, a first in breakaway roping history. Each titlist was introduced to the crowd, then handed their gold buckles before posing in front of their trophy saddles, and the brightest smile may have been Angelone's

Two seasons ago, she stood next to Jackie Crawford when Crawford won the first ProRodeo breakaway roping world title and Angelone finished as the runner-up.

"Ever since that moment, I told myself that I wanted to be standing where I was the day I got the buckle at the South Point," Angelone said. "It became a reality.

"When I rode out of the arena in Colorado Springs, I told myself I had a really good chance to win the world. I loved winning Reno. I loved being the first one to win in San Antonio, but nothing tops how nervous I was when I got on that stage at the Thomas & Mack. I didn't know what to say."

She'll have to overcome that soon. She is the world champion and will always be one, whether she's at a jackpot in rural Erath County, Texas, or on the biggest stages of ProRodeo.

"I have been thinking about how cool it is that I won the world," she said. "I think it will hit me most when I start going places, and the announcers start saying it when they introduce me."

Ladies and gentlemen, world champion Martha Angelone.

Sarah Angelone Adds WPRA World All-Around Title to Resume

The prestige of winning the WPRA all-around world championship is as strong today as it was in 1948, when Margaret Owens earned the first title.

Even with the number of events decreasing throughout the years, the prestige continues. WPRA legends Wanda Harper Bush, Jackie Worthington, Florence Youree, Betty Dusek, Jimmie Munroe, JJ Hampton, Lari Dee Guy and Jackie Crawford have won the all-around

title. In 2022, a cowgirl who grew up in Virginia added her name to this illustrious list ... her name is Sarah Angelone.

Pronounced Ang-a-lone-e, Sarah is the younger sister of Martha Angelone, who won her own world title in 2022 in the breakaway roping. The Angelone sisters, who now both reside in Texas, look to be a force to be reckoned with for years to come.

"Going into the WPRA World Finals, I

really didn't think I would be in contention for that title as I didn't do as many events as the other ladies," said Sarah. "It was on my radar but really went down to help my sister earn points to try to win it, but then as it turned out I won it, and she was second.

"When they announced that I had won, Martha looked at me like, 'What the heck?' but she was happy for me."

Actually, it was Martha's pushing and prodding over the last four years that finally got Sarah to enter the WPR World Finals, and now she has a WPR world title on her resume and her name etched in the history of the WPR.

"This world title means a lot to me, and to have won it just a couple weeks before Martha won the breakaway world title was very special for our family," said Sarah, who graduated from Tarleton State University on Dec. 9 with a degree in animal production, something she

pursued due to her interest in equine nutrition. "We have definitely had a very blessed month with us both winning world titles. It will be something we will cherish forever."

The WPR all-around was crowned Nov. 12 with the WPR breakaway roping world title awarded on Nov. 30, so Sarah will always have bragging rights as being the first Angelone sister to win a WPR world title. The duo also has the distinction as being the first cowgirls from the state of Virginia to win WPR world titles.

"There are rodeos in Virginia, but they are nothing like the ones out (west), so for both of us to have started where we did and now to be world champions is pretty cool," said Sarah, who was the first competitor from Virginia to win a National High School Rodeo Association title back in 2016 when she won the breakaway roping title.

To win the all-around in the WPR requires a member to compete in two or more events at a WPR sanctioned or co-approved event that offers four of the standard events (breakaway roping, team roping, tie-down roping and barrel racing) with equal money of at least \$100 per event. Due to so many specialized events these days, the race for the all-around really comes down to performance at the WPR World Finals. Sarah competed in the team roping, heading for her sister Martha, then heeling for Jessica Remsburg and breakaway roping.

Sarah finished the season with \$8,060,

while Martha was second with \$7,570 despite competing in all the events, including the team roping as both a header and heeler. Sarah won the average in the breakaway roping at the World Finals in a total time of 6.4 seconds on three, while Martha tied for second in a time of

7.0. Sarah then also won third in the average in the team roping heeling for Remsburg roping 2 out of 3 steers in a time of 15.4 seconds.

“Martha and my family are a big reason I am where I am today,” said Sarah. “Having each other has been a key in our success, and I gain a lot of confidence any time Martha is helping me as she has more experience competing in the rodeo world than I.”

Martha has invited Sarah to join her on the road, but that is where Sarah says they differ.

“Martha is a gypsy, and I am the complete opposite,” noted Sarah, who stays busy training horses and competing in breakaway roping jackpots. “I do plan to go to the ProRodeos here in Texas and see what happens but have no plans of joining her on the road.”

A repeat for the Angelone sisters is definitely in play for 2023.

“It would be great to repeat as the all-around champion, but I am sure Martha will have something to say about that,” Sarah said jokingly.

Thompson Wins Third Team Roping Heading World Title

Hope Thompson knows a thing or two about juggling.

The cowgirl has been rodeoing for many years, and recently has learned how to balance more, competing and excelling in both breakaway and team roping.

This year - for the third time in her career - she rose to the top of the team roping on the heading side, winning the World Championship buckle. The victory came after a season of working hard to make team roping as much of a priority as possible.

“My partner, Rylie Smith, that’s what she does (team roping), so I try to split my time

equally and make it as much of a priority as I can to make all the big all-girl WPRA team ropings,” Thompson said.

“The BFI was a big factor this year for us, and of course the WPRA Finals. It’s always a priority to try and add a world championship buckle to your belt! So getting some early wins and then when you win a big one like the BFI (Thompson won that rodeo with Whitney DeSalvo), that gives you a big chance.”

Thompson finished the season with \$21,671, beating out Bailey Gubert, who had \$18,626. And it might have been a great first run at the WPRA World Finals that sealed the

win for Thompson.

“I think it was a toss up going into the WPRA World Finals as to who would win,” Thompson said. “But I think when Riley and I won the first round and got that momentum, it helped. But, you never know. I didn’t have

money figured or know what they had to win or what I did. I just wanted to go in there and having fun and rope each steer.”

In fact, prior to the World Finals, Thompson didn’t even realize that she was leading the standings until her mom shared that tidbit with her. She said it was “pretty special” to learn she was winning the heading race, but then put it out of her mind and focused on her runs.

In the first round, Thompson and Smith had a good steer that they knocked down quickly in 6.2 seconds, enough to easily win the round, ahead of Quincy Sullivan and Abigail Shofner who caught in 6.9 seconds.

The next rounds weren’t as good - Thompson said she might have safetied up on the second round draw and when the steer checked, her rope popped off. So for the final round, she and Smith went at their draw, but Smith missed. Thompson waited to see how the chips would fall and in the end, she had enough for her third world title, winning also in 2017 and 2020.

“I think it was more of a surprise to win this year because I wasn’t entering as much. It’s a complicated learning curve with the team roping and breakaway, knowing where certain rigs are going and where horses are and when the team roping horses need to be brought out and all of that,” Thompson said.

“And to win it again this year but with a different partner than before, that was really cool. Riley ropes breakaway too but her priority is team roping, and she knew what I was juggling and helped me balance my schedule. Having her support and having her back there heeling for me was really great.”

Thompson celebrated - and took a load off - with a family trip to Mexico shortly after

the Finals. She said her parents have hauled her “all over the world doing the rodeo thing, and we’ve never gotten to just go chill and hang out for a family vacation,” so their days in Mexico were a welcome change. She hopes to make the trip a regular thing, a good way to rest and relax before hitting the road once again to see if she can add more buckles to her collection.

Moreno Makes Headlines With Team Roping Heeling World Title

Lorraine Moreno didn't always notice this season whether the team roping events she was going to were WPRA approved or not.

But now that she's got a shiny World Champion buckle, you can bet that she'll be paying closer attention.

Moreno won the team roping heeling world title with \$17,994 in winnings, outpacing Rylie Smith who had \$12,245. The accomplishment of a world title was somewhat unexpected and very welcomed by

Moreno, who calls herself a fierce competitor.

“I wasn't paying that much attention, just going to all girl ropings and whatever, but I guess I got lucky that I won ones that were WPRA approved!” she said with a laugh. “It was so exciting for me to be able to accomplish a goal that I've always worked at, and I want to continue to get more titles and be more well-known for roping.”

Moreno grew up roping. She learned from her dad, and was roping the dummy when she was small. She showed that she had a knack

for the sport, winning her first saddle at age 6 and her first U.S. Roping title at age 9.

She'd been a header to start, but at around 12 she switched to heeling, saying she wanted more of a challenge. Her dad made the switch to header so she could work on heeling, and she continued to perform well in the new position.

She started WPRA events about three years ago and said she didn't know much about them but when a friend asked her to rope with her, Moreno got her membership the day prior and then went in blind.

This year, Moreno started hot by winning

the Patriot in Fort Worth in February, splitting a \$20,000 payday with partner Bailey Gubert. Moreno also did well at the BFI, picking up more checks, and when the WPRA World Final rolled around, she was firmly in the driver's seat for a potential world title.

"When I saw where I was ranked, I thought, okay, now I have a game plan to try and keep that lead. Win some rounds or an average check so I can continue to keep my money up there and win a world title," she said.

The first round was tough. Moreno said their first steer went to the wall and she couldn't get a rope on him. But the second and third rounds were better - she and Gubert finished third in the second round and tied for third in the third round. It left them fourth in the average and most importantly gave her the world title.

"It was so exciting!" she said. "I've never won a title before, so that was really exciting, to hit a goal that I've wanted. When I found out about the WPRA I told myself that I wanted to be a world champion.

"Now I'll just continue practicing and going to ropings and we'll continue to try and do the best we can. Pay attention to what is WPRA so we can keep going to those rodeos and be in the same position!"

Zilverberg Wins Tie-Down Average en route to First World Title

Tanagai Zilverberg has a job to do. Every single day on her family's Lazy Heart Z Ranch in Holabird, S.D., she's up early taking care of the horses. She breaks them, trains them, rides and ropes on them. Her job isn't a nine-to-five. It's a twenty-four-seven, rain or shine. Her job is her calling, her birthright.

Even when she hits the rodeo trail, it's just as much business as pleasure. A trip to the pay window can put a little more diesel in the rig and pay the fees at the next stop, but her livelihood is selling the same horses she rides. Every go-round is an advertisement for the sort of finish she and her family can put on a mount, and she never takes it lightly.

“My life revolves around rodeo and training horses,” said Zilverberg. “When I show up to a rodeo, I’ve taken a day off of riding other horses. If I don’t win, I’ve also lost the day of training on something else that I could sell or is an outside horse.”

Rodeo is her job, and she just can’t give anything less than her absolute best, whether she’s in the round pen, the practice arena or a performance. She’s driven to be the best, to be that all-around cowgirl who can pull a check in any event that puts a rope in her hand.

She qualified for the WPRA World Finals in first place in the tie-down, but also competed in the team roping and the breakaway, her personal favorite event. Her strategy in the tie-down was simple: the slim lead she had coming into Finals meant nothing. Just as in years past, an average win would likely crown the next World Champion.

“In the tie-down, I never really go for first. I just go for solid,” she explained. “If you win the average, you usually end up with the year-end. Just [wanted to] stay solid and hope I draw good calves I can win on.”

Aboard her brother Zane’s calf horse, Mister Mighty Spark (“Barley”), the first round’s draw was middle of the pen, and the pair clocked a clean, 15.9 for third place. Chasing Zilverberg from second in the standings was four-time and reigning world champion Kari Nixon, Freedom, OK, who gained ground with a second-place run of 14.2. Rylee George, Oakdale, CA, won the go with a 13.1.

Her second round draw was even better, and while she may never go for first, Zilverberg’s “solid” that night was 14.1 seconds. It won her the round and increased her lead over Nixon, who finished fifth. Chenoa Vandestouwe, Inwood, IA, was second with a 15.1.

As predicted, the 2022 Tie-Down Championship would come down to the final round. Zilverberg’s 30-flat on two led the way, with Nixon’s 31.7 behind her. But when Zilverberg got her draw for the last round,

she knew she had some extra work to do. He was bigger than most of the pen, and had given girls in the first two rounds plenty of trouble. In an arena a little louder than her horse was used to, it all very nearly fell apart in that final round.

“What happened was, when I roped him, he was off to the left and he ran up the rope a little,” said Zilverberg of her make-or-break

run. “The speakers, they spooked Barley forward a little bit so my rope wasn’t tight and I didn’t have that leverage to get him flanked off that tight rope. I didn’t get him the first time, so I had to flank him again.”

The clock stopped in 22.9. Not the prettiest run, and no final-round check at the pay window, but her second effort saved the average, and won her the 2022 WPRA Tie-Down World Championship. Second place

in the average went to Vandestouwe, who had a stand-out Finals performance, taking checks in all three rounds.

In addition to her championship hardware, Silverberg left Waco with something more meaningful than any title she could win for herself. Her peers at the Finals voted Barley Professional's Choice Most Outstanding Horse of the Finals. He also helped win his rider a check in the team roping, and took fourth place in the all-around barrel race.

Tanegai her parents, Gary and April Silverberg, and brother, Zane worked together over the years to make Barley into such an amazing, all-around horse. The 12-year-old is in the prime of his career, and the honor belongs to him, but it's for the whole family to celebrate and share in.

"I take pride knowing I can take a horse from the bottom, one that's probably never, ever been touched, and eventually make him into something as nice as Barley," commented

Tanegai. "We broke him to ride. We roped on him. We did all the hard stuff with him and now we're winning on him. That's a pretty big deal to me"

All in a day's work for this first time World Champion. Her job is her passion and rodeo is how she earns a living. It's engrained in her, and she'll never stop training horses no matter how much success she finds in the arena.

"I have the horses I keep because they're my number one, go-to-the-rodeo horses, but I have horses that have helped me throughout the years be able to go to places like the Women's Finals and do well that I've sold to people, and they're winning on them now. It's almost more of a proud moment for me than myself winning, just because I put enough time into that horse and made him good enough that somebody else could go on and achieve their dreams with him."
