

It allows the turbocharger to produce an unusually high boost of power – 50% more air pressure than in most turbocharged passenger cars. And with great efficiency. Fuego's turbocharged engine actually has better EPA gas mileage ratings than the fuel-injected engine. See pages 14 and 15. And only Fuego offers an intercooler on a production car in America.

Add to this a great-handling, front-wheel drive package. Topped by a beautiful, aerodynamic body. And Fuego Turbo is one car that demands to be driven as few cars can be driven today.

# AERODYNAMICS

It's a simple engineering maxim. The less wind resistance created by a car, the better its performance and economy. Fuego's low 0.35 drag coefficient is better than that of such well-known performers as Scirocco, Datsun 28OZX, Porsche 928, and the new Camaro.

In designing Fuego, Renault engineers faced a basic principle. Simply put, the driving force produced by the engine on a level road is opposed by two forces - rolling resistance and air resistance. Reducing either force improves the car's performance.


Reducing the air resistance is primarily a matter of modifying the car's shape while carefully ducting the internal airflow needed for engine cooling and cabin ventilation.

To reach Fuego's low 0.35 drag coefficient, the stylist's designs were tested in three stages in a wind tunnel. First, with a one-fifth scale model. Then with a full-scale model. And finally with the actual vehicle. Every component and every line was thought out and carefully refined according to final wind tunnel tests.

What's remarkable is that even with this low drag coefficient, Fuego is beautifully styled. With gentle curves around the striking profile. Across the rear. And along the windshield. The entire front end, from the air dam up to the hood, curves back to guide the airflow around it.

Even the door handles are concealed to eliminate wind resistance. And the wheel openings are tucked tight to the wheels for better airflow. The result is one of the slipperiest shapes around.



And with free arm movement.


You get ample cargo space under the wide-open hatch. Plus storage compartments, map pockets, and two hidden cargo floor compartments.

Other sport coupes may have good looks. But few offer such a well-engineered interior.




Gauges and graphics are easy to read, day or night. Standard are a tachometer, trip meter, and a unique oil level gauge. It lets you check the engine oil level from inside the

## WARRANTY COVERAGE FOR SUBSEQUENT OWNERS

Subsequent owners are eligible for any unused portion of the new vehicle warranty.

### TIRE POLICY

Tires are covered by a separate limited warranty provided by the tire manufacturer.

### **NEW VEHICLE PRE-DELIVERY INSPECTION**

Prior to delivery, every new Renault vehicle has been serviced and tested for handling, braking and overall performance in accordance with the Renault Pre-Delivery Inspection Checklist.

### LOANER CAR SERVICE

If warranty repairs require keeping the vehicle overnight, the servicing Renault dealer will provide a free loaner car subject to terms and conditions in the Warranty and Maintenance Guide.

### TRIP INTERRUPTION PROTECTION

If warranty repairs are required while traveling

100 miles (160 km) or more from home, and "same day" repairs cannot be performed by the servicing Renault dealer, the owner will be reimbursed for extra lodging and meal costs up to \$150.

### **TOWING COVERAGE**

If the Renault vehicle needs warranty repairs and cannot be driven, the owner will be reimbursed up to \$25 to have it towed to the nearest authorized Renault dealer subject to terms and conditions in the Warranty and Maintenance Guide.

# RENAULT POWERTRAIN PROTECTION LIMITED WARRANTY

The vehicle owner must pay for the first \$100 of each valid warranty claim.

Any original equipment part or component installed in a new Renault vehicle (except exhaust components) that proves to have developed perforation from corrosion within 3 years from date of delivery or first use, will be repaired or replaced at no charge.





### TRANSMISSIONS

Fully synchronized 5-speed manual with overdrive. Floor mounted. 4.12: 1 axle ratio. (3.78:1 axle ratio on Turbo.) Optional 3-speed automatic. (Not available on Turbo).

### FRONT SUSPENSION

Independent front with lower A-arms. Upper transverse and reaction arms. Coil springs. Telescopic hydraulic shocks. 19 mm stabilizer bar. Negative scrub radius design provides Fuego with superb directional stability.



### REAR SUSPENSION

One-piece box section rear axle linked to the chassis by a central A-shaped control arm to prohibit lateral movement. Dual trailing arms control longitudinal movement. Coil springs. Telescopic hydraulic shocks. 25 mm tube-type stabilizer bar. Spring and shock rates are set for a firm, smooth, very stable ride on various kinds of road surfaces.

### STEERING

Rack and pinion. Variable power assist. 2.8 turns, lock to lock.

### BRAKES

Disc brakes—front. Self-adjusting, rear drum brakes. Semi-metallic brake pads. Power assisted with 8-inch booster. Safety features include a height sensing pressure proportion valve in the rear brakes to prevent rear-wheel lockup. Plus a dual diagonal hydraulic brake system. And a worn front brake pad warning light.

### WHEELS AND TIRES

Standard 5.0" x 13" wheels on Fuego have P185/70R13 black sidewall, Michelin steel-belted radial tires. Full styled wheel covers are also included. Required on Fuego Turbo and available on Fuego are 5.50" x 14.4" cast aluminum styled wheels. They come equipped with 165/70HR365 Michelin low profile TRX steel-belted radial tires for outstanding traction and cornering. A 155R x 13 emergency spare tire is included in both models.

### ANTI-CORROSION FEATURES

Renault uses modern technology in rustproofing to protect Fuego against corrosion. From galvanized steel to special bonding techniques.


Many exterior body panels are made of zinccoated steel. A zinc-rich primer and a sealer are applied to all major panels where they are to be welded. Exterior panels then get a phosphate coating.

Sealers are applied to critical body seams.

And a primer is used on all body surfaces prior to painting with a chip-resistant acrylic enamel.

Undercoating is applied to the engine compartment and parts of the underbody.
A special vinyl coating on the lower body protects it against stone chips and abrasions. And plastic

inner liners are installed in the front fenders to protect them against road spray. The result is a very well protected body with a limited 3-year no rust-through warranty.



Most turbos have a low engine compression ratio to avoid dangerously high cylinder pressures. The result is substandard power at low rpm's when the car is cruising. Because of its intercooler, Fuego has a high compression ratio with good thermal efficiency at low rpm's. The intercooler is a small radiator that cools and contracts the compressed air on its way to the engine. The higher density of the air allows a bigger charge into the cylinders for more power.



turbocharger can boost air pressure to 11.6 p.s.i.
That's 50% more boost than in most turbocharged passenger cars. Fuego is the only production car available in America to offer an intercooler, similar to the ones used on race cars. The net result in Fuego's turbocharged engine is a 31% improvement in horsepower and a 39% improvement in torque over the fuel injected engine.
